## Community award presented to CSJFTC Soldier

A Camp Shelby Soldier received a community award for his service and support to local crime victims during the Backyard Invitational Golf Tournament May 4.

Staff Sgt. Brad Malone, assigned to Camp Shelby Joint Forces Training Center Directorate of Personnel Community Activities, was presented the Jackie Dole Sherrill Community Award 2013 in support and selfless service to the Shafer Center for Crisis Intervention.

The Shafer Center for Crisis Intervention is a non-profit organization dedicated to serving victims of sexual assault and co-victims of homicide and suicide. The center was established in 1983 as the Hattiesburg Rape Crisis Center, after a series of rapes occurred near the University of Southern Mississippi's campus. Since then the center has served hundreds of people in the eleven county region through crisis intervention, counseling, support groups, advocacy and education.

In addition to Malone's connection with

the Shafer Center, the center also serves as one of Camp Shelby's training consults for sexual assault education for all Camp Shelby personnel.

One of the reasons why Malone was a good candidate to receive the award was that he and his wife, Laura, helped raise nearly \$12,000 that will go to support victims of sexual assault, co-victims and suicide. With the assistance of Kohl's, who was a major contributor, the donation can provide more support to the center and its mission.

Also, the Malone's recently hosted the 2nd Annual Bill Shafer Backyard Invitational Golf Tournament, which is in memoriam of Laura's father, Dr. Bill W. Shafer, co-founder of the Shafer Center for Crisis Intervention. The money that was donated to the BIG T went towards the mission of the center.

"Laura and I credit all the success of the BIG T to family, friends and active community business," said Malone. "We feel privileged to help raise money and awareness for such a worthy cause and in memoriam of Dr. Shafer."
