Seatbelt use becomes law

It used to be that the only cost to not wearing a seat belt was the increased risk of injury during an automobile accident; but now, the cost is going up.

Mandatory use of seat belts for drivers and front seat passengers in Hawaii goes into effect Dec. 16. The law will be enforced here by the Provost Marshal's Office, and off-Station by the Honolulu Police Department.

Drivers will be responsible for themselves and front seat passengers 15 years old or younger. Passengers 15 years old and older will be responsible for themselves. The penalty for violating the new seat belt law is \$15 per person, per violation.

There are exceptions to the mandatory policy. Passengers in emergency, commercial, for hire, and mass transit vehicles and type 1 school buses are exempt. So are people riding in a motor vehicle manufactured before 1968, which are not required to have seat belts; or those who have medically certified physical disabilities which prevents them from buckling up.

Also, those who aren't wearing a seat belt because there are more people than there are seat belts will be exempt.

The new seat belt law

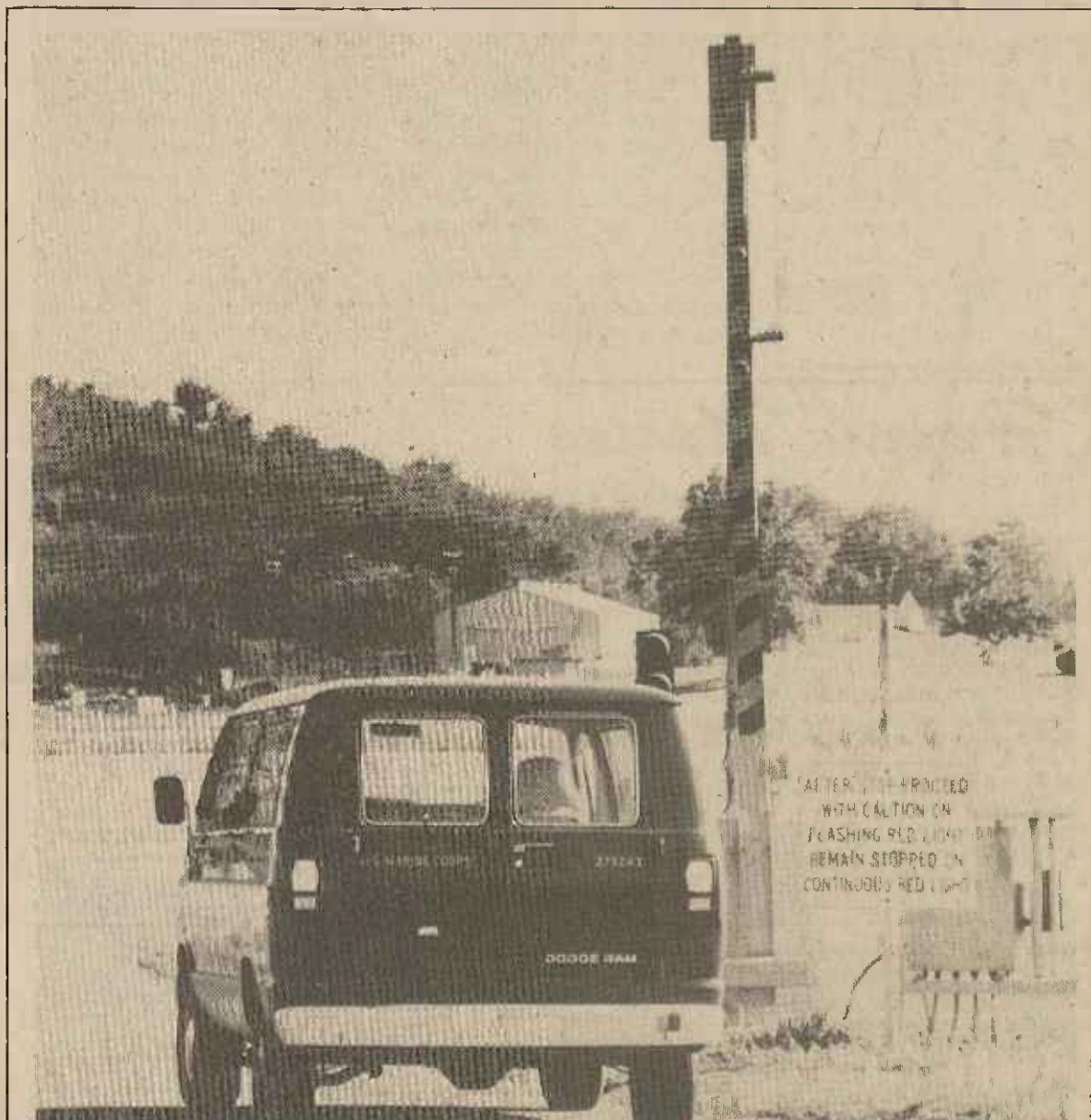


doesn't affect the child passenger restraint law that went into effect two years ago, which carries stiffer penalties.

The child restraint law requires drivers to ensure that children younger than 3 are properly strapped into a federally approved child safety seat; and children 3 to 4 years old are either in a child safety seat or secured by the vehicle's seat belts.

If there are more people than there are seat belts, the children without safety seat belts must ride in the back seat. Exemptions are the same as for the mandatory seat belt law.

Fines for the first offense can cost up to \$100; a second offense within one year of the first can cost up to \$200; and three or more offenses within a year can carry fines of up to \$500 each.

Why people refuse to buckle up

How would it feel to be involved in a car crash at just 10 miles per hour?

Here's one way to find out, without damaging your car. You'll need a 200-pound bag of cement: haul it up to the second floor of a building and toss it out the window. Imagine one of your buddies standing on the ground below and catching the bag as it falls. That's how dangerous a low-speed collision can be.

It is estimated that 85 percent of Americans refuse to buckle up. Military people on the average have a much better record, but many servicemen and women still won't take the time to protect themselves and their passengers.

A fatal automobile accident occurs every 20 minutes in the United States, claiming 43,800 lives in 1984 alone. Federal Safety authorities claim seat belts

could have prevented half those deaths.

Safety statistics show that each of us can expect to be in an auto accident once every 10 years. For one out of 20 of us, it will be a serious crash. For one out of 60, it will be fatal.

B.J. Campbell, director of the Highway Safety Research Center at the University of North Carolina, thinks people don't wear seat belts because they don't think of it.

He says people need to be reminded constantly.

Toward that end, many private sector organizations have established programs to remind people to buckle up, something the military services have been doing for years. And although the services have much better results, they believe it's not enough until 100 percent of the population buckles up.

Department of Defense regulations require all personnel who operate

government motor vehicles equipped with seat belts to wear them. That includes people using their privately owned vehicles on official business.

Still, some people refuse to wear them, a refusal based on misinformation and long-standing myths. Those myths include:

"I don't want to be trapped by my safety belt if the car is submerged or catches fire." You're 25 times more likely to be killed if you're thrown

from a car than if you're trapped in it. The exceptions receive wide publicity, thus reinforcing the myth.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration says only 0.5 percent of all accidents that result in injuries occur under these conditions.

"I don't believe it will happen to me." You've heard and seen the figures. Chances are good every driver will have an accident at least once in their lifetime and chances are 50-50 it will cause injuries.

"I only need to wear them for high-speed driving or for long trip." Remember the 200-pound bag of cement? Eighty percent of all accidents happen at speeds of less than 25 miles per hour. Seventy-five percent occur within 25 miles of home.

Promotion photograph policy changes

Washington, D.C. — Sergeants through lieutenant colonels must submit an official photograph each time they are in a promotion zone, starting with the 1985 promotion cycle.

Under the new policy, official photographs must be forwarded to HQMC within six months of the board's convening date. The new policy was announced in Marine Corps Bulletin 1070, published Nov. 6, and will be incorporated in MCO P1070.12D (IRAM).

In conjunction with this new photograph submission schedule, HQMC internal procedures have also been changed. Photographs will be maintained in their original state until the promotion board is complete. In the past, the photographs were converted to microfiche and seen by board members in the degraded state, which defeated the purpose of the photo — providing the current Marine's physical and personal appearance.

Other portions of the basic order, such as the prescribed uniform, photograph specifications and title board, remain in effect.

Promotion photographs are to be submitted directly to Commandant of the Marine Corps (MMPR), Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps Washington, D.C. 20380-0001.

Pearl Harbor attack commemorated

Pearl Harbor — The National Park Service and the U.S. Navy will conduct a memorial service aboard the USS Arizona Memorial Dec. 7 at 7:30 a.m., to commemorate the 44th anniversary of the Pearl Harbor attack.

The USS Arizona Memorial is the final resting place for 1,177 Navy men and Marines killed during Japanese attack on Dec. 7, 1941, which launched the United States into World War II.

The service will include prayers, wreath presentations, a gun salute and echo

taps. The keynote speaker will be Vice Admiral Kendall E. Moranville, commander, Third Fleet. One minute of silence will be observed throughout the Naval Base at the exact moment of the Japanese attack.

At 7:55 and 7:56 a.m., one long blast of the Navy Shipyard work whistle will signal the beginning and end of the minute held in memory of those who lost their lives. Seconds later, F-4C Phantom jets from the Hawaii Air National Guard will fly over Pearl Harbor in a "missing man" formation.

The Pacific Fleet Band will play the National Anthem while a Navy-Marine Corps color guard raises the U.S. flag on the pole mounted to the mainmast of the sunken battleship. It is the only Navy ship not in commission still allowed to fly the flag. The Most Reverend Joseph T. Ryan, Archbishop of the Military Diocese, will deliver the invocation and benediction.

Flag and general officers

representing the Armed Forces in Hawaii, state and city officials will attend the ceremony, to include Pearl Harbor survivors, and representatives of various veteran, patriotic and civic organizations.

A private sunset service scheduled at 5:30 p.m. aboard the Memorial for the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association will conclude the day's 44th anniversary observances.

CFC news: Marines still in front

The Marine Corps continues to lead the uniformed services in the 1985 Combined Federal Campaign fund drive by collecting almost 87 percent of its \$251,400 goal by the end of the third week.

Collections reported at the halfway point of the six-week drive total \$1,568,787.41, over 61 percent of the projected goal of \$2.56 million.

The Air Force has raised \$237,516, almost 80 percent its goal. The Army has reported its collections of \$375,037, which is 72 percent of its goal. The Navy has attained 44 percent of its goal by collecting \$478,500. The Coast Guard has collected almost \$80,000, over 70 percent of its goal.

After 30 years the Corps bids a fond farewell to SgtMaj Willie F. Trawick

His hair is a bit thinner and grayer, and wrinkles line his face in a few places; but down deep, he's still as young, patriotic and soft-spoken as he was when he joined the Marine Corps.

"If I live to be a 100, it's been the best 30 years I'll have," says Station Sergeant Major Willie F. Trawick, who relinquishes his post to Sergeant Major E.T. Alvarado Jr. during

his retirement ceremony at Dewey Square, this afternoon. The sergeant major officially retires Feb. 28, 1986, with 30 years, one month, and one day of active service.

Trawick joined the Corps in January 1956 in Macon, Ga., although that wasn't his intention when he went to the recruiting station. "I know there's a lot of reasons people join the Corps," he said. "I went to join the Navy, but while I was waiting for

the chief, a Marine master sergeant caught my attention. He was sitting there in dress blues. It was the blues that brought me in.

"Where I'm from in Georgia, I doubt that I'd ever seen a Marine in my life," Trawick added. He was 18 years old, and a lot has happened since. "I know it's been said a lot, but Marines are smarter now than when I came in," he said. "If you had a 53 GT and could sign your name, you were in."

Other changes in the Corps occurred, such as new weapons systems; but the sergeant major believes the new barracks concepts have had about the biggest impact on the Corps. "With three-man rooms, you don't have the direct NCO leadership that open squadbays provided. The camaraderie isn't as noticeable either," Trawick added.

Trawick spent 17 years with the infantry, including a tour in Vietnam with Company L, 3d Battalion, 9th Marines, and one tour as sergeant major of 3d Reconnaissance Battalion in Okinawa, Japan. His duties, however, here have been different than other posts he's held as a sergeant major.

"It's been a learning experience here," he said. "I've worked with numerous committees, and handled problems ranging from base housing disputes, to providing color guards out in the

civilian community. As a battalion sergeant major, you're basically just troop-oriented."

Another function he served in was as senior enlisted advisor to the Air Station's commanding officer, Colonel Robert P. Rogers. Colonel Rogers has been good to work for," Trawick said. "He lets me do my job, and that's important."

Trawick has had a lot of good people to work with, but there's one special person whose been, by his side constantly for the last 24 years — his wife, Faustine.

They met in Eastman, Ga., in 1960, just before Trawick, then a corporal, deployed for 15 months. When he returned in 1961, they married.

Now, with five sons, Trawick has proudly watched his elder sons follow in his footsteps. His eldest son, Michael, is a corporal with VMFA-235, here, while his second son, David, just returned from a hitch in the Navy. His third son, Jeffrey, is in the Marine Corps' delayed entry program waiting to graduate from high school to also follow in his dad's footsteps.

His two youngest sons, Kenneth and Kevin, haven't enlisted yet. The twins will celebrate their eighth birthday tomorrow.

"Michael's never been to my office," Trawick said of his Marine son. "We

respect each other, and occasionally he comes over to the house, but not the office. He's very proud of what he does, and he did invite me to his unit to show me around."

Trawick reflected on his service career, and pinpointed several areas he is especially proud of. "Recruiting was a challenge," Trawick said. For three years he served as the Des Moines, Iowa, Recruiting Station's Sergeant Major in 1979.

In 1981, the Iowa governor asked Trawick to arrange the 1981 Armed Forces Day Parade in Des Moines. The parade was a success, and Trawick learned several lessons on organizing large events, an experience he put to

use since coming here in 1982.

The enlisted Marine Corps birthday balls have been Trawick's best career highlights, he says.

More than 1,300 Marines attended the 1985 enlisted ball, where the sergeant major was honored as the guest speaker.

The sergeant major and his family will return to Eastman soon, where he plans to settle and perhaps opening a garage. He wants to run his own business, but there's an ulterior motive behind it. "Trawick wants to be able to set his own hours, so he can 'get in a little fishing and hunting.'"

Troops to 'gobble' alot of turkey

It takes a lot of turkey to make Thanksgiving and Christmas meals for members of the Armed Forces, government, civilian employees overseas, and their families . . . 3,465 tons to be exact.

These 6,930,000 pounds of food don't include the tons of trimmings, such as mashed potatoes, vegetables, fruits and nuts, according to the Defense Personnel and Support Center in Parris Island, S.C., who purchases food for dining facilities and commissaries around the world. The cost for the turkey is \$1.27 per pound.

\$3,239,745, and 557,073 pounds of hams for \$1,143,741. For resale in Pacific area commissaries,

134,000 pounds of turkey, for \$186,168, and 341,260 pounds of hams, for \$450,310, were purchased by the Center.

For Pacific — are troop dining facilities. 2,842,000 pounds of turkey, with a bill of \$3,700,000, were purchased, along with 1,300,000 pounds of hams, for \$1,600,000. The minced meat and pumpkin pie bill came to \$18,971, for \$2,420, along with 25,359 pounds of fruit cakes for \$40,375.

The European troop dining facilities will be getting 114,400 pounds of turkey, which cost \$127,440. The commissaries will get 1,000,000 pounds of turkey for \$1,274,400 and 15,000 pounds of hams for \$19,530.

For troop dining facilities in the U.S. and other areas, the Center will spend \$11,200,000 for turkey for 1985.

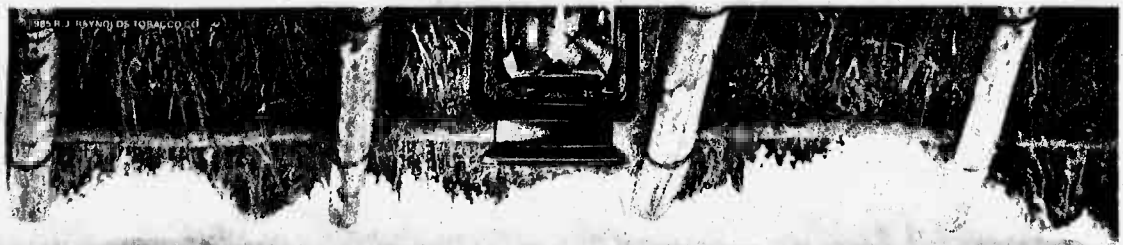

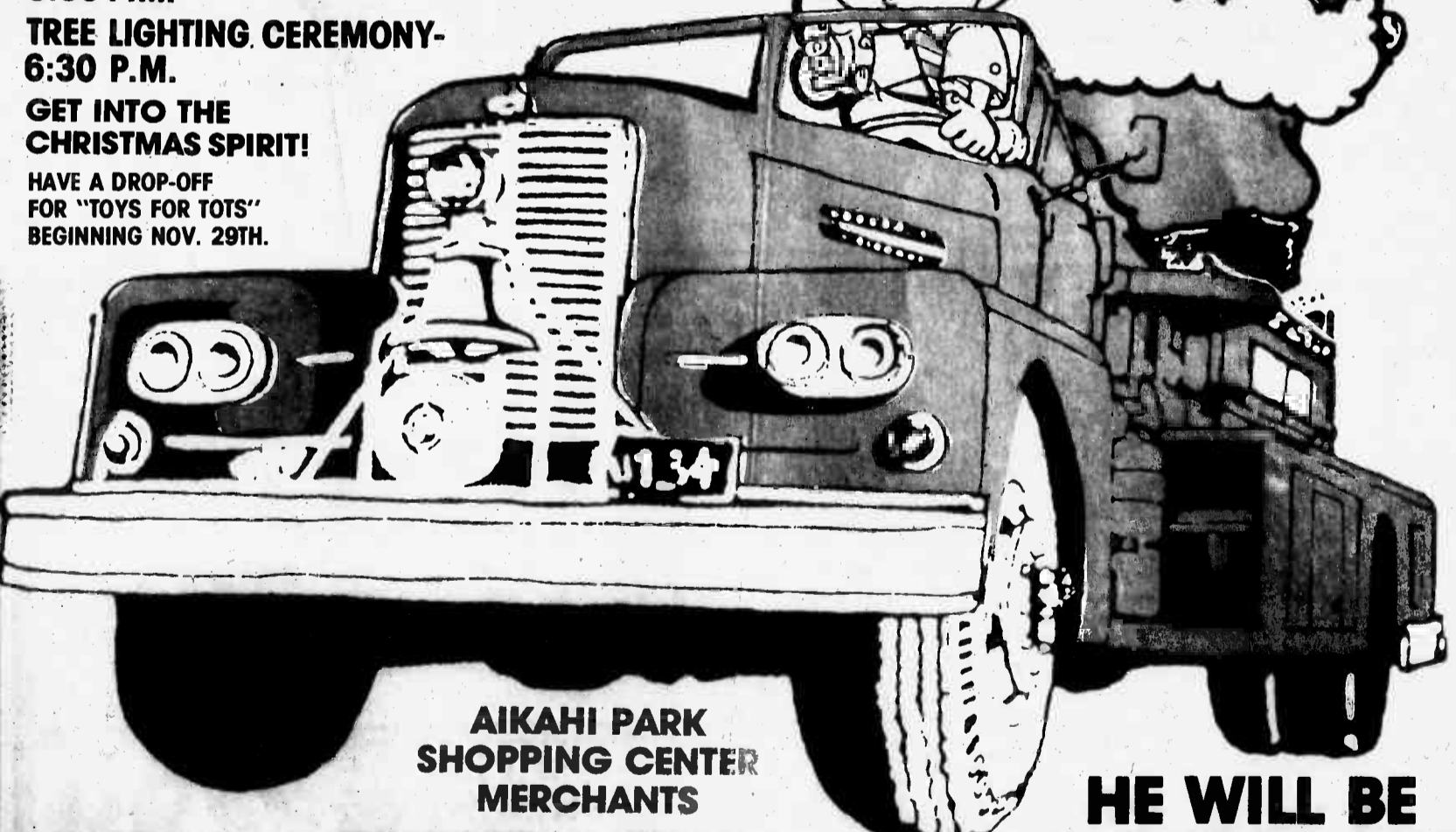

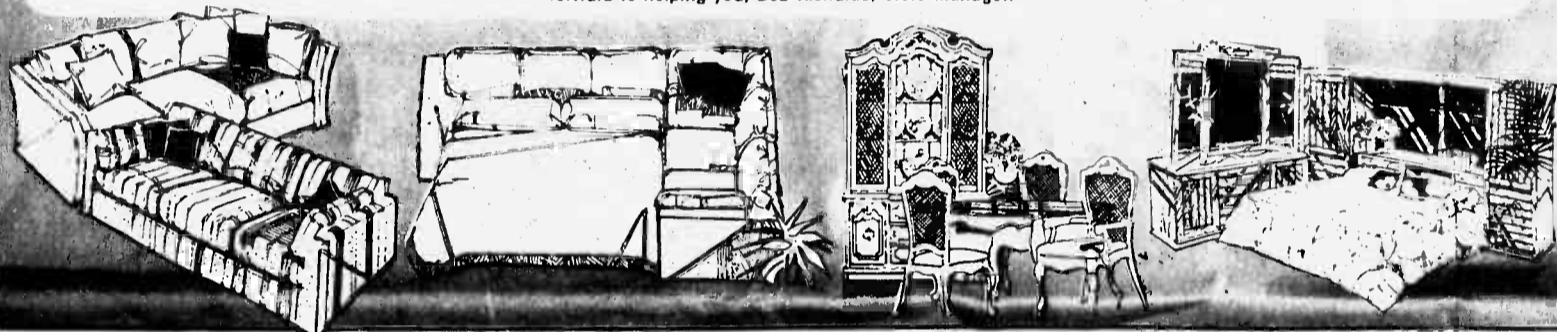

Cowboys representatives were Benny Barnes, Robert Newhouse and Mel Renfro. Sherman White represented the Bills. Sam Gruneisen represented the Chargers, and Dennis Shaw came from the Giants. MacArthur Lane represented the Cardinals, and Joe Danelo represented the Packers.

“Football is a game, but the work the Marines do is serious,” said George Buhler. “I want to make sure the Marines know there's a silent majority who really appreciate what they're doing.”

Buhler, a former offensive guard with the Raiders, and the other NFL stars autographed books, footballs and a vast assortment of paper for their fans here. They also met thousands of Marines by keeping an active schedule that included a golf tournament, football game, tug-of-war contests, breakfast at the

dining facilities here and tours of Marine Barracks, Camp Smith, the Air Station and 1st Marine Amphibious Brigade units, including those at NAS Barbers Point.

A field goal contest preceded the football games here, with former Packers kicking star, Joe Danelo, giving leatherneck kickers a few pointers. Cpl. Brian Dickens placed one through the uprights from 40 yards to win.

Range record broken... again

"It was the best day I've had in the Marine Corps," said Corporal Paul Rapoza of Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron, who recently beat the Air Station's Rifle Range Known Distance course record.
 The day was Nov. 1, and it was Rapoza's "best day" as he fired a 247 with an M16A2. The day was also special because he was promoted, and was also transferred to the Air

Station's Special Services Department where he now works at the mini-gym — a job the avid bodybuilder has wanted for quite some time.
 "I felt like nothing could possibly go wrong on that day," he said.
 Rapoza came inches from a perfect 250. He missed the bulls eye three times at the 200-yard line — once in the kneeling and twice in the offhand.
 "The worst miss was in the middle of the four ring at 9 o'clock," said Rapoza. "I knew I had missed the

three shots because I rushed them."
 After leaving the 200-yard line, Rapoza calmed down and hit 25 consecutive bulls eyes at the 300 and 500-yard lines. This was Rapoza's first time to qualify as an expert. Prior to his record, Rapoza requalified with a 203, 218, and 217. All of his previous qualifications were with the M16A1.
 "I definitely think the M16A2 is a better weapon,"

he said. "It's easier to make windage and elevation changes. The elevation changes are more precise since you can make half-click adjustments."
 For those wanting to shoot their best on qualification day Rapoza has some advice. "Concentrate and relax," he said. "Don't worry about scores. Just keep your full attention focused on firing every round correctly."



Defense cheaters face stiff penalties

Sometimes upholding the law can get in the way of enforcing it.

Take the cases of some defense contractors who have defrauded the government. Investigators might establish that fraud has been committed but can't always establish guilt beyond a reasonable doubt to ensure a successful criminal prosecution.

Government attorneys are reluctant to try a case in court if they don't think they can get a conviction. That's the way our legal system works — and is intended to work.

The offenders, though probably barred from receiving defense contracts in the future, might get off with no penalty other than paying back what they owed the government.

A new set of rules that would allow a variety of penalties to be levied against companies defrauding DoD outside of criminal court proceedings has been proposed.

The Department of Defense has asked Congress to establish an administrative penalty mechanism that would enable them to punish contractors who make false claims or false statements to the department. This administrative procedure would be in addition to, or in lieu of criminal prosecution.

Secretary of Defense Caspar W. Weinberger believes legislation in this area would provide a mechanism for appropriate government response to instances of fraud that occur, but are not now addressed by the government for a variety of reasons.

who operated parts stores on 10 different military bases. He illegally inflated parts prices on each contract. While the total fraud amounted to more than \$50,000, no single base was defrauded of more than \$6,000.

Each case was presented to nine separate United States attorneys and was declined at each office because the dollar value was too low.

Under the proposed legislation, however, this would change. If the Justice Department declined to prosecute the case in court for any reason besides lack of proof, DoD would still have a vehicle to recover amounts otherwise lost.

An administrative penalty mechanism would protect the right to a fair and reasonable hearing for any person alleged to be liable and also would provide adequate due process for all parties concerned.

Under the proposed legislation, federal agencies would not be permitted to process with administrative penalties unless the Justice Department had specifically declined prosecution under the False Claims Act or the False Statements Statute and had approved further proceedings.
