## Volunteers needed for O2 billets

The 11th Counterintelligence Team is looking for a few good men to reenlist for counterintelligence duty.

Marines with MOS 0211 serve in Fleet Marine Force and support billets throughout the Corps. Selected 0211s serve tours with other services and as special agents with the Naval Investigative Service.

In combat, Counterintelligence Specialists conduct operations to locate and destroy enemy intelligence, sabotage and terrorist units, use human sources to gather combat intelligence information; and investigate incidents of defection, espionage, sabotage, subversion and terrorism involving Marines.

They also collect information to locate and recover Marines who have been captured by the enemy.

In garrison, 0211s participate in training exercises and deployments to sharpen their combat skills. They also advise unit commanders on how to protect information against espionage; personnel against subversion and terrorism; and how to protect equipment and facilities against sabotage.

Marine Corps counterintelligence personnel attend the Army Counterintelligence course at Fort Huachuca, Ariz. They can also attend a variety of advanced courses in counterintelligence, counterterrorism, intelligence collection, and security throughout their careers.

Counterintelligence personnel must be able to work alone as they often brief or advise senior commanders on counterintelligence and security matters.

All applicants must pass an extensive, special background investigation board and a personal interview board. Any history of behavioral problems, drug or alcohol abuse is a disqualifying factor.

If you are a male sergeant, have a GT of at least 110, are a U.S. citizen, have a high school or GED diploma, and are looking for a challenging career, you may qualify. Unrestricted lieutenants are also eligible.

## Marines contribute to CFC record total

The 1985 Hawaii-Pacific Combined Federal Campaign raised a record-breaking \$2,644,554, and surpassed the 103 percent goal set for last year's fundraising drive.

Contributing Marine units included the 1st MAB, MCAS Kaneohe Bay, 1st Radio Bn. H&SBn., Camp Smith and Marine Barracks Hawaii. A total of 28 local federal agencies and military organizations exceeded their goal.

Of the total funds raised, \$1,720,000 was earmarked this year for health and service groups in Hawaii, and the remainder went to national and international agencies. All total, 249 charities are benefiting from the 1985 CFC fund drive.

Army LtGen. Charles W. Bagnal, 1985 CFC chairman,

praised the community spirit of all those who contributed, and to the volunteers who made the campaign a success. Citations for outstanding performance were awarded during a recent ceremony, which included the presentation of symbolic checks to the Aloha United Way and other charity groups.

## PCS allowances change

### Compensation acts to impact on wallets

Both the Authorization Act, which was signed into law Nov. 8, 1985, and the Appropriations Act, which was signed Dec. 19, 1985, will impact on Marines' wallets.

Changes in PCS moves were significant, as are other changes. They are:

The Mileage Allowance in Lieu of Transportation for members and their families was restricted to equal federal civilian rates, and a per diem for family members equal to civilian rates was authorized. Family member per diem will be paid at a rate of \$37.50 per day for persons 12 years old and over, and \$25 per day for children under 12. Effective date when these amounts were effective was Oct. 1, 1985.

Temporary Lodging Expense was made an entitlement with an effective date of Oct. 1, 1985. TLE provides \$110 per day, for a maximum of four days, for expenses actually incurred in conjunction with a PCS move to a station within CONUS.

Household Good Weight Allowances were increased for junior enlisted personnel. Members E-1 through E-4, with a family, will be allowed

up to 5,000 pounds. Those without families will be allowed up to 1,500 pounds for both CONUS and overseas PCS moves.

Family Separation Allowance has been increased from \$30 to \$60 per month for those members involuntarily separated from their families. This increase is retroactive to Oct. 1, 1985.

Advance payment of BAQ/VHA to offset the financial impact of moving to a high-cost area was also approved. Implementation procedures are currently being developed.

The requirement to pay surcharge for family members of E-1s through E-4s was eliminated. When family members are autho-

rized to eat in military dining facilities, they will pay the same meal rate as their sponsor.

The increase in Dislocation Allowance from one to two months BAQ, which was in the Authorization Act, was rescinded in the Appropriations Act. Only those personnel who had completed PCS moves and were paid their travel claim prior to Dec. 19, 1985, the effective date of the Appropriations Act, benefitted from the temporary increase.

The VHA "Windfall" provision, that became effective March 1, was also included in the Authorization Act. The difference which occurs when the sum of a member's BAQ and VHA exceeds actual housing costs will be split between the service member and the government. Members will never receive less than the entitled BAQ.

Other program changes include:

Payment of BAQ/VHA beyond 90 days of sea/field duty was authorized for E-7s and above without family members for those members who have already secured

housing at their permanent duty stations.

Restrictions on the student travel program for family members have been lifted. The payment of travel costs for one round trip per year for students is now permitted from the sponsor's overseas location to the college/university.

The flat rate per diem test that was authorized for the Air Force and Defense Logistics Agency in FY85 had been expanded to include all services. The test program will continue until legislation is enacted to implement a flat rate system on a permanent basis.

Procedures to implement changes to the Survivor Benefit Plan have been developed and will be sent to all services. The changes became effective March 1.

Career sea pay rates were increased for officers and incremental increases for sea duty beyond the 12-year point were established. The increased rates are retroactive to Oct. 1, 1985.

Overseas Extension Incentive Pay was increased from \$50 to \$80 per month. This increase applies only to new agreements.

Increases were authorized for incentive pays such as demolition duty, parachute duty and flight deck duty. The increase sent the enlisted rate to \$110 per month, which matches the officer rate. The increase is retroactive to Oct. 1, 1985.



Other program changes include lifting of student travel restrictions, change implementation to Survivor Benefit Plan.

## HMM-265 breaks down helos for training

It looked like someone had taken a gigantic axe and lobbed off the two rotor heads, along with the blades, of the CH-46 helicopter parked by Hangar 102. Behind it, another helicopter sat with miles of wire and

tubing exposed as if someone has taken a knife and peeled the skin back.

But in reality, it was a helo repair shop, consisting of mechanics, avionics technicians, hydraulics mechanics and metal smiths of HMM-265 disassembling three CH-46Es to be transported on a C-5A to MCAS Yuma, Ariz., to be

used in weapons and tactics instruction there.

The mechanics and technicians removed the forward transmissions, rear rotor blades and upper clam shells, the main mounts and all the rotor blades of each helicopter. Once the helos arrive at Yuma, the aircraft will be assembled so they can

be used by the aircrews while participating in gun runs, evasive maneuvering and night vision goggle training.

The flight crews, however, are not the only members of the squadron adding to their technical knowledge. "The maintenance crew," said GySgt. Bruce Mandel, SNCO in charge of the unit's breakdown works, "is learning how and what to break down on the helicopters and the quickest ways of getting the job done."

According to Mandel, the breakdown and loading is important as crews need to know how to do it in case they ever have to get the '46s someplace in a hurry.

The maintenance crew loaded the three disassembled CH-46Es and the transmissions, rotor shafts, clam shells, blades and mounts into the belly of an Air Force C-5A on March 3. The maintenance crew will

help of the Air Force crew, strapped the helicopters and parts into position.

"Some of the crew had doubts as to whether the 46s would fit in the C-5s, but they learned how to fit everything in," said Mandel.

Breaking down the helicopters, according to Mandel, took the maintenance crew five hours per CH-46E while reassembling them will take about six hours each.

"When you take them apart," said Mandel, "you don't have to do anything special — you just take the parts off. When you put them back together, though, you have to put everything on, torque it, and then adjust the part so it's working properly."

On March 4, the maintenance crew and the flight crews of the three CH-46Es flew to MCAS Yuma.

Taking, or threatening reprisal against those who report irregularities will not be permitted, according to

HOTLINE officials. The Secretary of Defense fully endorses the Civil Service Reform Act of 1978, which provided protection against such reprisals.

# Keeping poisons and children apart

**W**ould you play Russian roulette with your child's life? Unless you have secured all poisonous substances, bought a bottle of syrup of ipecac, and placed the number of the nearest poison center by the phone, you may be doing just that.

"Children Act Fast... So Do Poisons!" has been the main slogan for National Poison Prevention Week for 25 years, and it's as true today as it ever was.

Fortunately, said poison prevention specialist Rose Ann Soloway, "Up to 80 percent of accidental poisonings can be treated at home if the parent calls the poison center immediately — and if the parent has a bottle of syrup of ipecac in the home."

Soloway is a registered nurse and spokeswoman for the National Capital Poison Center at Georgetown University Hospital, Washington, D.C. She said,

"Because we're in Washington, we get calls from all over. We've had calls patched through from military base health centers in Europe and Japan — we even got one call from Bangkok." Georgetown's computer lists 35,000 substances with instructions on treating patients who have been exposed to them.

Service spokespersons confirmed Soloway's comment concerning military health centers sometimes patching calls concerning unusual poisons through from overseas — although most calls overseas are handled by the emergency room staff. Both Army and Air Force spokespersons said that in the United States, military personnel and dependents are encouraged to call regional poison control hotlines like the one at Georgetown for poison information.

These hotlines are located around the country, and have toll-free numbers which are advertised in the community, in military clinic pediatricians' offices and in the telephone book. Said one service spokesperson of the regional hotlines, "They are well equipped, and there is no reason for us to duplicate what they can do."

However, both in the United States and overseas, military emergency rooms have the equipment and

trained personnel necessary to treat poisonings — including "unusual snake bites" peculiar to a geographic area.

Although clinics are well prepared to treat poisonings, health professionals hope to avoid this. Said a Navy spokesman, "Our pediatricians make a point of educating parents on how to prevent poisonings."

What is the most common type of dangerous poison ingested by children under five? "Painkillers, including aspirin and acetaminophen, closely followed by cold remedies," said Soloway.

Of course, preventing exposure to poison in the first place is the best way to protect your children — and yourself — from poisoning.

"Most poisoning deaths involve adults and teenagers," said Soloway. Although some of these may be suicide, others are true accidents, resulting from reaching into the medicine cabinet in the dark or without putting on glasses, foolishly taking a double dose to make up for one that's been missed, or mixing drugs and alcohol.

If you have young children, you should not

only poison-proof your own home, but remind grandparents — whose medications are involved in 36 percent of childhood poisonings — of the dangers of poisoning.

Poison-proofing requires effort. It's not only the obvious poisons such as cleaning products, bug sprays and medicines that must be kept away from little hands — so should cologne and perfumes. They smell good, come in pretty bottles, and are usually in the bathroom or the

## Prevention week begins

**T**his year marks the 25th observance of National Poison Prevention Week. "In 1962, the first year the president proclaimed National Poison Prevention Week, 450 children under five died from accidental poisonings in the United States. In 1983, the last year for which we have completed statistics, 55 children died," said Ken Giles, secretary of the National Poison Prevention Week Council.

And, as President Ronald Reagan has noted, ingestions of poison were reduced 80 percent during the same period — from 500,000 to 100,000.

Referring to the reduction in poisonings, Giles said, "We feel those figures are proof of the effectiveness of both child

resistant caps and increased parental awareness. But the decrease in deaths doesn't tell the whole story. There are still one to two million reported exposures to poison ('exposure' is the term used when there is some doubt about whether the child actually ingested poison) every year, and thousands of those result in sickness or even permanent damage if not death."

Said Giles, "Unlike problems such as smallpox that can be eliminated, our job will never be finished. There is a new group of one-year-olds every year, and their parents must be made aware of the dangers involved in careless use and storage of poisonous substances."



Innocent curiosity can be the prelude to tragedy. The best way to protect children from poisoning is to prevent exposure to poison in the first place.

## MAG-24 celebrates 44 years of meritorious service

The air support element of the 1st Marine Amphibious Brigade, Marine Aircraft Group 24, turned 44 March 1 and even though the MAG has only been part of the Brigade since 1968, its history goes back to the hectic months following the attack on Pearl Harbor.

Formed March 1, 1942, at MCAS Ewa, the MAG initially joined Marine Fighter Squadron 211 and 212, but Marine Scout Bombing Squadrons 242, 243 and 244 quickly followed, causing the early detachment of VMF-211.

In March 1942, the forward echelon of the Group arrived at Efate, New Hebrides, to establish an airstrip at Vila. On June 15, 1942, the Group returned to Santa Ana, Calif.

Composed of five scout bombing squadrons, the MAG immediately began an intensive and fast moving

training program to prepare for further combat duty. In January 1943, the MAG boarded ships to return to Ewa. Upon arriving in the Pacific theatre, elements of the MAG served at Midway, Johnston and Palmyra Islands while the headquarters remained at Ewa.

In September, the group returned to Efate to control local air defense. From November to mid-December, the group moved to Banika in the Russell Islands, then to Bougainville. The service echelon began work on the New Piva airstrip and had it operable by early January 1944.

With Japanese attacks on the airstrip increasing, the MAG split into two air base defense battalions to protect it. By late October, the New Zealanders had taken over defense of the Solomons, and Marine units began preparing for duty in the Philippines.

In mid-December, the group moved to Milne Bay, New Guinea, for staging. In January 1945, the forward echelon of the group went ashore under enemy fire to start construction of Mangalden Field. Within two weeks, the field was operable and the first aircraft arrived.

MAGs-24 and -36 combined to serve from the Mangalden area during the Luzon Campaign as part of the Fifth Air Force. In April, the group joined MAGs-32 and 12 to form Marine Aircraft Group Zamboanga. This group

supported missions in Mindanao and Sulu Archipelago and won much praise from the ground forces they supported.

The fighting stopped in August 1945, and one of the last MAG missions was the dropping of the Japanese surrender leaflets to enemy units in the area.

With the war over, the group moved to Guam in 1947 and two years later to MCAS Cherry Point, which became MAG-24's home for the next

20 years. During the Korean War, the group trained large numbers of pilots and crewmen for combat duty.

In April 1968, after 20 years at Cherry Point, the group moved here and remains today as the air arm of the 1st Marine Brigade, providing essential support to Marine ground units and completing our unique air/ground team.

Honors adorning the MAG's colors include the Navy Unit Commendation Streamer, w/Bronze Star; Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Streamer, w/3 Bronze Stars; World War II Victory Streamer; China Service Streamer; National Defense Service Streamer, w/3 Bronze Stars; and the Philippines Liberation Streamer, w/1 Bronze Star.

### From the CG

"Formed March 1, 1942, at MCAS Ewa, Hawaii, Marine Aircraft Group-24 soon saw action in the Pacific Theater during World War II and served as part of the occupation force in China afterward.

Moving to Cherry Point in 1949, the Group came to play an instrumental role in the Cuban missile crisis of 1962. MAG-24 came to Hawaii, place of its birth, in 1968 to become the air arm of the Brigade.

Throughout its illustrious and diversified history, MAG-24 has served both country and Corps as one of the premier Marine aviation units.

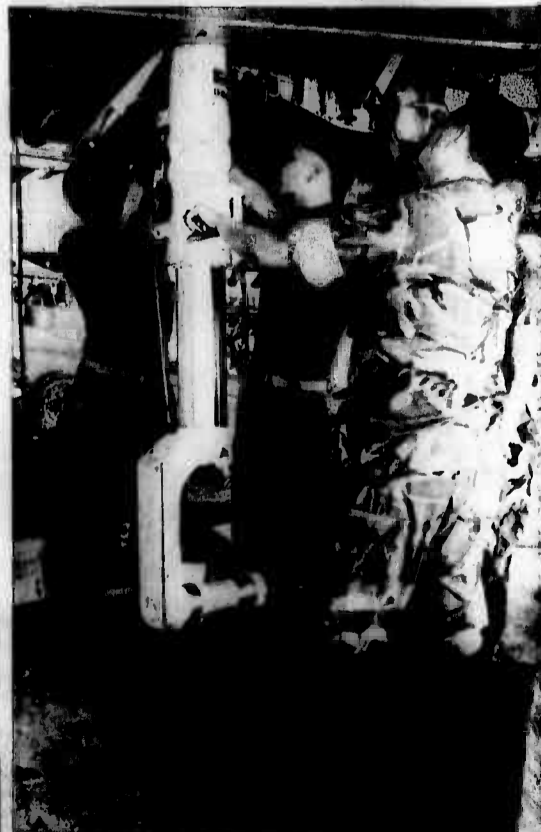

Col. Katherine A. Towle

**First director of WMs dies**

**One of first 3 women officers**

Washington, D.C. — Retired Marine Colonel Katherine A. Towle, 87, who served as the first director of Women Marines in the regular Marine Corps, died March 2.

Towle was born April 30, 1898, in Towle, Calif., a small town named after her ancestors who settled the area in the 1850's. She graduated from the University of California at Berkeley in 1920 and went on to study at Columbia University of New York City.

She was employed as the assistant to the manager at the University of California when she accepted a direct commission to the rank of

captain, in the Marine Corps Women's Reserve on Feb. 25, 1943.

Her first assignment was as the senior woman officer of the Marine Training Detachment, U.S. Naval Training School, New York City. In May 1943, she was assigned to the Special Staff of the Commanding General, Camp Lejeune, N.C., as assistant for Women's Reserve, an assignment that coincided with the opening of the Women's Reserve Training Center, there. While in that post, she was promoted to major in February 1944.

Towle's next duty assignment was as Assistant Director of the Marine Corps Women's Reserve from September 1944 to Dec. 7, 1945, when she was promoted to lieutenant colonel and was appointed as the second director of the Women's Reserve. In June 1946, she returned to her civilian career at the University of California, where she served as the Assistant Dean of Women.

She returned to active duty in October 1948 and

became one of the first three women officers in the regular Marine Corps. On Nov. 4 of that year, she was appointed as the first director of Women Marines, a post she held until her retirement on May 1, 1953.

Towle's award include the Legion of Merit and the Navy Commendation Medal. She is survived by one sister in California.

## F/A-18 Hornet chosen for Blue Angels

St. Louis, Mo. — The McDonnell Douglas F/A-18 Hornet fighter/attack aircraft has been selected by the U.S. Navy as the official airplane of the Blue Angels Flight Demonstration Squadron for the 1987 show season.

Eleven specially modified F/A-18s will replace the squadron's A-4 "Skyhawks" at the end of this year's season. The changeover to Hornets will mark the 17th consecutive year the Blue Angels has flown McDonnell Douglas-built airplanes. Phantoms were used from 1969 through 1973, and the Skyhawks have been flown since 1974.

The Blue Angels F/A-18s

will have a special smoke-generating system, and a new seat harness to help pilot handle the weightlessness caused by some maneuvers.

During 1985, the Blue Angels logged more than 140,000 miles while performing before millions of people at 71 air shows across the United States.

The Blue Angels use tactics taught to every student Navy pilot, but the maneuvers in the air shows are executed with the aircraft flying in extremely close formation.

Six airplanes perform the prescribed sequence of air show maneuvers, including the famous diamond formation in which the planes are 36 inches apart, with their wings overlapping.

The first F/A-18 will be modified at McDonnell Aircraft facilities in St. Louis and test flown next fall. The remaining aircraft will be modified at the Naval Air Rework Facility at North Island, Calif. Pilots will train with the F/A-18s for the first time at El Centro, Calif., in January 1987.

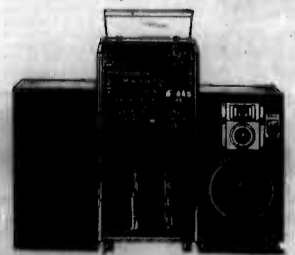

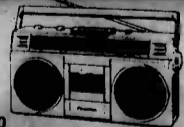

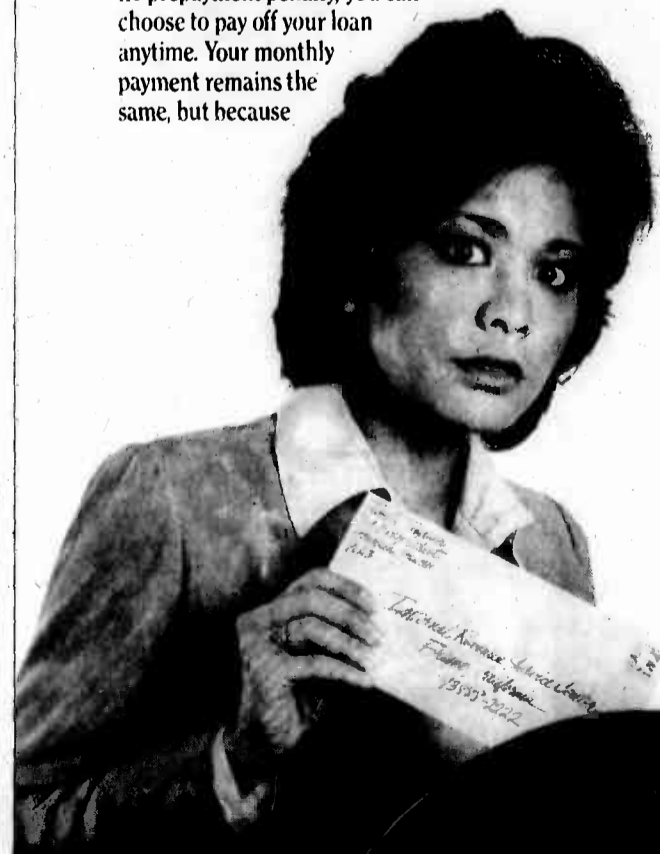

# Poison-proof your children

bedroom where they can be easily reached.

Plants are another common source of poisoning, both indoors and out. "Whenever a child eats a mushroom in the yard it should be treated as a medical emergency," said Soloway. "Some mushrooms cannot be identified as poisonous or nonpoisonous without a microscope."

Carelessness poses its own problems, particularly when you use dangerous products. "Most poisonings occur when the parent is momentarily distracted while using a dangerous product — say the phone rings while you're taking medicine or scrubbing the floor," said Ken Giles of the National Poison Prevention Week Council. In the time it takes a parent to grab the phone, a child could grab the pills or drink the cleaning liquid.

Some precautions to prevent accidental poisonings:

- Keep medicines, alcoholic beverages, cleaning fluids and detergents, rat, weed and insect killers out of reach in locked cabinets — make sure you relock the cabinet after opening it. For storage areas filled with dangerous items, special childproof locks that fit over the doorknob are available.

- Be careful while using poisonous substances if children are in the home. Don't rely on constant supervision.

- Buy a bottle of syrup of ipecac and keep it where you can find it fast. Don't forget to tell your babysitter where it is. Post the number of the nearest poison control center by the phone and call immediately if poisoning is suspected. Don't give syrup of ipecac unless told to do so by the poison center.

- The only exception to the "call the poison center first, treat later," rule is when any substance has gone into the victim's eye, where substances that are otherwise harmless can cause problems. Flush the eye with a gentle stream of water, then call the emergency room for help. If there are two persons present, one can flush the victim's eye while the other calls the emergency room.
- Never tell a child medicine is "candy."

- Keep your purse and the child's diaper bag zipped or snapped — both often contain items such as medicines, cigarettes and cosmetics that are both poisonous and attractive to children.
- Don't keep poisonous houseplants in a home with

small children, or decorate it with poisonous plants — such as mistletoe and holly. If you can't identify one of your plants, take a leaf to a local plant store for help.

- Throw away unused portions of prescription drugs. If you have small children, buy small sizes of

any over-the-counter drugs you take to reduce the chances of a child taking a large amount.

- Keep all dangerous substances in their original containers. NEVER put poisonous substances in empty food or drink containers.



It might look delectable, but a bite of this plant could poison the child.

## Seabees 'Can Do'

### Navy reservists extend mini-gym for more elbow room

The machine-crowded mini-gym here has undergone some changes thanks to the "Can Do" work of Navy Reserve Seabees.

According to LtCmdr. Carl Miller, detachment OIC for Reserve Naval Mobile Construction Battalion-20, headquartered in Columbus, Ohio, mini-gym construction was finished March 7, the

detachment's last day here. The 20-man team began a 67-foot extension of the mini-gym Feb. 24.

According to GySgt. Ted Harmon, NCOIC of Family Self Help, money saved by the Seabee's work on the mini-gym was nearly \$65,000.

"We're very pleased that we'll have all this space — it's been so crowded," said 1st Lt. Scott Lance, Station Athletic officer. "Now it will be a lot more comfortable for people to work out."

In addition to the mini-gym extension, some construction mechanics with the detachment were working at the motor pool rebuilding hydraulic cylinders for a 30-ton crane, said Miller.

These Seabees come from Kentucky, Ohio, West Virginia and Pennsylvania. There are 10 detachments, which make up the Battalion's seven companies.

Engineer Aid 3rd Class George Dabb's reserve job

doesn't drift far from his job in Chillicothe, Ohio, as an engineer for the Veterans Administration. "It's been 16 years since I've been here last, but it's still great. Last I heard, it was 20 degrees in Ohio, so I'm very comfortable right now."

Store Keeper 1st Class Dave Chamberlain is a department head in a VA hospital in West Virginia. According to Chamberlain, who is in charge of supplies, there have been no prob-

lems getting materials needed, and he's had a lot of cooperation from Station Facilities.

Another Seabee detachment will be here through March 24, to build a patio at the Bachelor Officers Quarters. Afterwards, the other detachments will come in at two-week intervals through May 5, and work on prefabricated houses for MABS-24.

"The houses will be used as office spaces for

administration, supply and storage areas. Total costs saved on this construction is \$150,000 on labor alone," said Harmon.

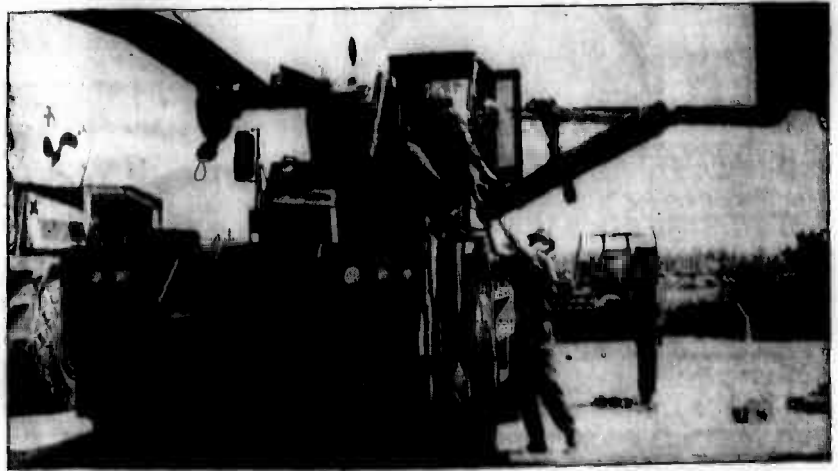
"Seabees do road and steel work, wood construction and rock crushing. We are a self-sustained construction unit. We have our own support, to include cooks, disbursing, and administration sections. We also have a Marine advisor, who helps us get our basic training, such as rifle qualification," said Miller.

# Bodybuilding championship slated

## Open to Marines, sailors

The 3d Annual Armed Forces Bodybuilding Championships, sponsored by the Pearl Harbor Clubs and Special Services, will be held April 19 starting at 7 p.m.

The competition, held at Pearl Harbor's Block Arena, is open to the public and will feature bodybuilders from the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force and the Coast Guard.

According to Rodney D. Gouveia, director of Athletics at Pearl Harbor, everybody will weigh in that morning for prejudging, and will be distributed into four weight classes: lightweight, middleweight, light heavyweight and heavyweight. There will also be a women's division.

During prejudging, each contestant must pose before a panel of seven judges to be evaluated on definition and texture of muscle, body proportion/asymmetry,

individual posing and choreography.

"The women are judged the same as men," said Gouveia. "Only four standard poses are required, with each contestant using various poses to show their best muscle form for the remainder of their routine."

Although the winner of each class is actually determined at the prejudging, the judges have the option of changing their minds before the evening show, when the over-all male and female posers will be selected during a "pose down." As the finalists of each weight class pose to music, the judges will award points to determine the winners.

This year, for the first time, a team competition will also be held. Each service will select its top four bodybuilders during the prejudging, and the groups will then pose

as a team during the finals.

Judges for the competition include Cindy Lee, holder of many local bodybuilding titles; Ernie Santiago, who holds many local and national titles, including Mr. USA; Cathy Chang, holder of national bodybuilding titles and a representative of the National Physique Committee; Mits and Dot Kawashima, promoters of the Mr. Hawaiian Islands competition; Ed Bailey, who is Mr. Armed Forces 1984; and Bill Nelson, head of the National Physique Committee in Honolulu.

Gary Riveria, who took third in the Mr. USA contest and is Mr. Hawaiian Isle 1984, will guest pose, as will the Air Force's Paul Blouin, winner of the first Armed Forces Bodybuilding Championships at Pearl Harbor.

"The first year we had only 20 contestants, with only

three entered in the women's division," he said. "The second year, about 32 contestants entered, including nine women."

Applications are still available for contestants and can be obtained at all military gyms, or at Bloch Arena. Tickets for the competition are available at Special Services outlets on all military bases for \$4. Those who want to watch the prejudging at 9 a.m., can purchase tickets for \$2. Tickets can also be purchased at the door.

## VA benefit checks get new look

Veterans benefit checks will take on a new look beginning April 1. A lightweight paper check will replace the familiar green punched-card check issued by the federal government for the past 40 years.

The change is part of a national conversion to paper checks being implemented by the U.S. Department of Treasury. Over 4 million checks each month go to

veterans, spouses and children in compensation, pension, educational or insurance benefit payments. Biweekly paychecks for Veterans Administration employees around the country will also take on the new look.

The change to paper checks was made because of changes in technology which made the punched-card check system obsolete. The new

check, which has more than a dozen security features, is more difficult to alter or counterfeit, according to Treasury officials.

The check's design features a full-length reproduction of

the Statue of Liberty on the left and a muted close-up of the Statue's head and torch on the right. The check's colors range from light blue to pale peach with the letters "USA" creating a background pattern.

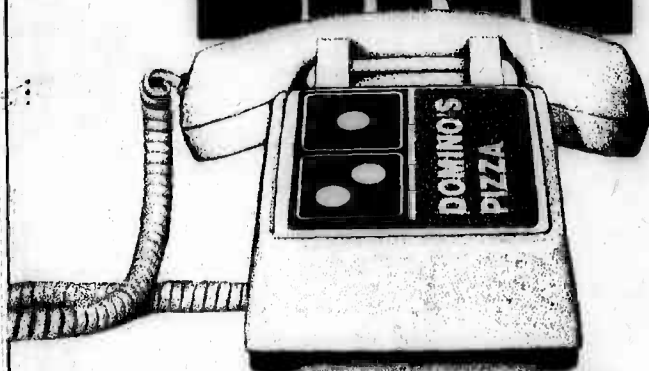

# Families need fire escape plan

Every year, more than 5,000 people die in home fires because they don't know what to do when a fire breaks out in their home.

Every family should have a Home Fire Escape Plan and practice it as often as possible. It is important for each family member to locate and learn to use emergency exits; alternate exits are also important to know.

Make sure windows can be opened and that screens and storm windows can be removed from the inside.

Make sure children can operate locks and know to get out quickly, not to wait for parents to lead them out. If they cannot get out, children should know to wait at the closest designated escape route for help from parents or firefighters.

Everyone should know to stay low and crawl to the nearest exit.

Second floor rooms should have folding ladders for escape through windows. Ladders can be made of light rope or medal ladders can be

purchased from most hardware stores.

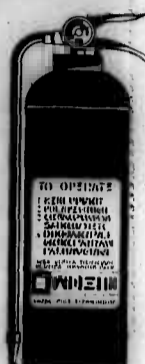
