## New sergeant major takes brigade post

SgtMaj. Harold T. Chapman became the 1st MEB sergeant major when he took the post from SgtMaj. Allan J. Kellogg Jr. in a stirring post and relief ceremony before a sizeable crowd of military personnel and well-wishers at Dewey Square here.

Though Chapman has been at Kaneohe Bay since Aug. 15, it wasn't until Oct. 26 that he officially became the top enlisted Marine in the Brigade when Kellogg, the last active-duty enlisted Medal of Honor recipient in the Marine Corps, retired during the ceremony.

Chapman, born April 29, 1948 in Independence, Mo., reports from the 1st Marine Regiment at Camp Pendleton, Calif. The 1st MEB position is his first time serving in Hawaii.

"I feel super about taking over at the 1st MEB," he said. Chapman expressed some disappointment that he isn't in Saudi Arabia while so many Brigade Marines are, but knows he has an important job here as well.

The 28-year veteran has already seen his share of dangerous environments after serving three consecutive tours of duty in Vietnam. He enlisted in February 1967 and attended Recruit Training at MCRD San Diego.

Following boot camp, he reported to Camp Pendleton for further training at the Infantry Training Regiment and the Basic Infantry Training School. He then attended the Reconnaissance School at Camp Horn, MCB Camp Pendleton.

Reporting in December 1967 to Co. A, 3d Reconnaissance Bn., 3d Marine Division, Northern I Corps in the Republic of Vietnam, Chapman participated in numerous recon operations

and was subsequently assigned as a patrol leader. In 1968, he extended his tour in Vietnam for six months and was reassigned to 3d Force Reconnaissance Company. He was promoted to sergeant in June 1969 and extended for another six months.

After more than two years in Vietnam, Chapman rotated to MCAS El Toro, Calif., for duty as a general military subjects instructor in the areas of small-unit tactics and weapons.

He returned to Vietnam for the second time in August 1970, and was assigned to Co. I, 3d Bn., 7th Marines. When 7th Marines returned to the States in October 1970, Chapman stayed on with Co. H, 2d Bn., 1st Marines. He left Vietnam for the last time in May 1971.

"Basically, after almost three years time-in-country, they told me to leave," said Chapman with a laugh.

For his efforts, Chapman earned the Bronze Star with Combat "V," the Navy Achievement Medal and the Combat Action Ribbon.

After his last tour in Vietnam, Chapman served a three-and-a-half year tour as a drill instructor at MCRD San Diego, where he was meritoriously promoted to staff sergeant and gunnery sergeant.

It was here that he met another young Marine just out of Vietnam: Station SgtMaj. Anselmo Samson, then a staff sergeant. Almost 20 years later, the two are together again here.

Chapman was the junior drill instructor SSgt. Samson, and according to Samson, the two worked well together due to good communication.

"When you're in combat, you learn to communicate a certain way with people," he continued. "There was none

of that transition for us — it made it easier to work with him because of that."

Samson added that as far as Chapman coming to the Brigade, it just shows how small the Corps family is.

"He has a great track record and broad background. He'll be a great asset and give valid input to the command," he said.

Chapman was promoted to first sergeant in October 1979 while serving in Okinawa with 1st Bn., 9th Marines. He returned to the States in March 1982 for duty as the first sergeant of the Inspector-Instructor Staff, 4th Tank Bn., Boise, Idaho.

In two years, after his promotion to sergeant major, Chapman transferred to the 3d Marine Aircraft Wing, MCAS El Toro, to serve as sergeant major for VMA-311 from May 1984 to July 1988. It was on July 26, 1989, that Chapman's career came full circle as he returned to the 1st Marine Division in Camp Pendleton, as the sergeant major of the 1st Marine Regiment.

As far as shaking things up within the MEB, Chapman said he just plans to "fine tune" things a little. He added that while it will be hard to fill the shoes of Kellogg, he's his own Marine, and he'll do his best.

## 'Flying Tigers' sharpen skills in Philippines

**NAS CUBI POINT, Philippines** — The Marines of HMM-262 recently completed repositioning 10 Ch-46Es and four Ch-53Ds from MCAS Futenma, Okinawa to NAS Cubi Point, Philippines. The squadron is currently serving a six-month tour in Okinawa as part of the Unit Deployment Program.

During the relocating of the helicopters, the aircrews were faced with a myriad of challenges. Their first was when the relay legs exceeded the normal endurance of the squadron's helicopters.

To overcome this problem, a Rapid Ground Refueling (RGR) plan was instituted. The aircraft, outfitted with

two internal fuel tanks to extend their range, made two refueling stops to remote Pacific Islands enroute to the Philippines.

Once at Cubi Point, HMM-262 provided section transport for the United States Base-Negotiating Team from the U.S. Embassy in Manila.

The Flying Tigers also helped out when the Filipino nationals of the Baguio and Cordillera Mountain area were in desperate need of earthquake and flood relief.

With local roads rendered impassable and people isolated from any form of resupply, it became apparent that aerial support would be essential. Once the Flying Tigers of HMM-262 received the call, they responded with total cooperation.

The helicopters landed at Baguio with thousands of pounds of staple goods, including rice, and guide to assist with navigation.

Once the cargo was offloaded, passengers needing transportation back to Baguio were flown down the mountain. Thankful Filipino left bushels of fruit and vegetables for the crews before they left for more supplies.

Fourteen villages and 147 flight hours later, HMM-262 had transported more than 65,000 pounds of cargo.

"It was rewarding to help these people and to see the appreciation in their eyes," said Capt. J.D. Panknin, one of the pilots who flew several sorties in support of the mission.

## President speaks to military during Hawaii visit

"The invasion of Kuwait was without provocation. The invasion of Kuwait was without excuse. The invasion of Kuwait will not stand."

That was part of President George Bush's speech as he addressed a crowd of 6,000 at Hickam Air Force Base Sunday. Hickam was the last stop of the President's Pacific Island Summit in Honolulu.

United States military from all branches, DoD civilian employees, retirees, families and more than 180 media representatives gathered at Hickam Air Force Base to get a glimpse of or to photograph our nation's 40th president.

Moments before the presidential motorcade arrived at the platform, the Fleet Marine Force, Pacific band struck up "Hail to the Chief." Waiting to greet him on the platform were Commander in Chief Pacific, Adm. Huntington Hardisty, Hickam's 15th Air Base Wing commander, Col. Don A. Lyon; Gov. John Waihee and Congresswoman Patricia Saiki.

"I will always remember the first time I saw Pearl Harbor, it was the spring of 1944," said President Bush. "Our ship and my squadron were en route to Wake Island. And then, as now, it was an impressive sight."

"The fleet had recovered and the naval shipyard had set the world record for the fastest repair work completed

on battle-damaged ships," he continued. "The country came together. And like you here today, we each knew our duty."

The president said today in the Persian Gulf, the world is once again faced with a "challenge of perfect clarity."

"Saddam Hussein has given us a whole plateful of clarity," he said. "Because today in the Persian Gulf, what we are looking at is good and evil, right and wrong."

He said in one Kuwaiti hospital, dialysis patients were ripped from their machines. Iraqi soldiers pulled the plug on incubators supporting 22 premature babies — all 22 died. The hospital employees were shot and the plundered machines were

shipped off to Baghdad.

What could be the most important deployment of allied military power since 1945, the president said, "the decision for war or peace was not made in Washington, it was made by the men in Baghdad."

The president said the U.N. Security Council has passed eight major resolutions setting the terms for solving the crisis. He went on to say that a majority of the Arab League is supportive, along with the Soviet Union and China.

"NATO's resolve has never been more firm," he said. "Today, it is not Iraq against Kuwait — but Iraq against the world."

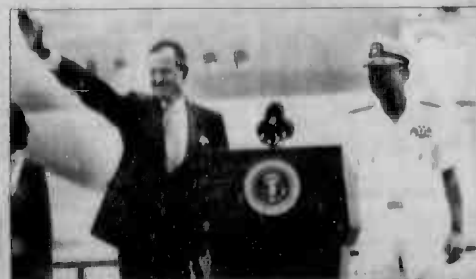
Near the end of his speech, the president stated that

the world is still a very dangerous place and the ones who wear the uniform will always bear the burden. He said he knew something of what they endured, "the waiting, the uncertainty, the demands of family and professional life."

"Not an hour passes that they are not on my mind," he said. "And so, we've come here to thank you for the

important work you do in defending our nation's freedom, in keeping our nation strong."

"I was motivated," said Cpl. Terry Dowell, a tractor trailer operator from Marine Corps Air Station's motor pool. "The president let us know that we're not going to back off from him (Hussein). The spirit of America was moving in that place."

### One dead, three injured in Saudi accident

One Marine was killed and three others were injured in a vehicle accident in Saudi Arabia Monday. 1stLt. M.N. Monroe, Headquarters Co., 3d Marines was killed when the HMMWV he and three other Marines were riding in went over a cliff in Saudi Arabia and dropped 35-40 feet impacting on the ground. The names of the three injured Marines are being withheld pending notification of next of kin. The cause of the accident is under investigation.

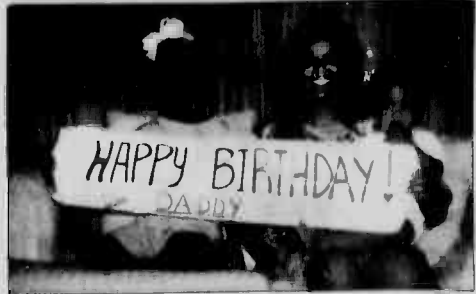

# 12th Marines test howitzer

Saudi Arabia — Like world-class prize fighters poised before a big bout, the Marines from 1st Bn, 12th Marines are confident, well trained and ready to give it everything they've got if the bell rings.

This degree of confidence was quite evident Sept. 16 when the cannoners had the opportunity to bring their brand new M198 howitzers (155mm) to the barren desert of Saudi Arabia.

The guns had previously been stored aboard the sea vessels of Maritime Pre-positioning Squadron 3 and this was the Marines' first opportunity to fire them.

While out there they will check the muzzle velocity on each one of the artillery pieces. This enables them to group the guns accordingly and help them to pinpoint their target accurately.

So far, the only fight these men have had during Operation Desert Shield is with the extreme desert conditions. Daily temperatures reach well

over 100 degrees with up to 80 percent humidity. Men and equipment cannot hide from the desert "powder" that covers everything from skin to bullets. The sun beats down with relentless cruelty, but as usual, the Marines are taking the entire situation in their typical fashion.

"I'm basically getting used to it," said Cpl. Eric O. Gibson of Tuscaloosa, Ala. as he reached up to wipe the layer of dust covering his eyelashes. "I'm makin' it. If I don't think about it, it's not that bad."

Capt. Steve Morgan of Hlubec, Penn. said the desert environment is tolerable once you get into it. "The weather is more miserable in Quantico (Va.) than it is here."

"Things are changing daily here with new positions to be found, fighting holes to be dug and training to be conducted, but one thing remains constant — thoughts of home.

When Sgt. Craig Thebert of Peoria, Ill. was asked what builds his morale out here in this desolate isolation, he immediately pointed to his massive howitzer and said "shooting builds our morale and knowing that the people at home are supporting us."

## Squadron deploys smoothly

Saudi Arabia — "It's quite a logistical feat to move a squadron half-way around the world in a matter of days. It was hard work, but there was lots of teamwork between us and the Air Force, so it went pretty smooth."

These were the words of Ssgt. James Fernandez, a flightline chief from HMM-463 based at Kaneohe Bay. He said it took his squadron five days to deploy from Hawaii to the Middle East. HMM-463 is one of many Marine helicopter squadrons now comprising MAG-16 that was faced with the difficult task of loading up and

moving out to Saudi Arabia.

In any deployment of military forces, the first major step is packing; getting as many items as possible to fit in each container.

That's what the Marines with MAG-16 and many other deploying units did.

The helicopters were flown here in Air Force C-5A Galaxy planes, but even the giant cargo hold of the Air Force's largest transport plane couldn't accommodate the Marine birds without a few alterations and adjustments.

On the medium lift CH-46 Sea Knights, Marine mechanics removed all the blades, rotor heads, forward

transmissions and top panels from the twin-rotor helicopters.

Ssgt. Ronald Brown, maintenance controller for HMM-161, said each Sea Knight takes about four hours to break down and roughly eight hours to build up after being transported.

"Putting them back together is the most important part of the process," said Cpl. John Stone, a material controller from HMM-161. "You have to be careful in getting all the settings and adjustments correct before flying."

In the case of the heavy lift CH-53D or E helos, the process is more complex,

simply because they are larger. Ssgt. William Dayton, who works on the flight line of HMM-462, said the breaking down of a CH-53 Sea Stallion takes approximately 14 hours.

"It's a complex operation, but this squadron has done it before," said Dayton.

Even though packing and loading are complicated tasks when moving a MAG, teamwork and expertise are two main ingredients in getting the medium and heavy helicopter squadrons to where they are now — deployed, operational and combat ready.

## 'First Team' rolls through desert

Saudi Arabia — In a column of heavily assault amphibious vehicles (AAVs), a company of men from 1st Bn., 7th Marines, MCAGCC Twenty-nine Palms, Calif., headed out to the field for the fourth time since arriving here.

They formed a mechanized team of combat-ready Marine infantry prowess. From the battalion's humble arrival, they have set a landmark as being the first Marine grunt unit to go to the field as part of Operation Desert Shield, and according to the warriors, "we're only getting started."

"The First Team," as the 1/7 Marines call themselves, flew into Saudi Arabia in mid-August. After a week of organization and outfitting, they established a defensive position in the desert.

"I'll admit it was tough at first," said 1/7 company commander Capt. Craig Baker of Decatur, Ala. "We had to learn how to do a lot of things differently. The desert is different in many ways."

The first step they took was flipping the clock and learning to operate at night. The scorching sun beat them with 125-degree waves of heat during the day, making heavy work almost impossible.

"We made the best of the cool night hours and slept during the day," said Baker. "Just being out in the field in the heat made the unit tougher, though we have evolved to the point where we can move effectively any time of the day."

In their first four weeks in country, the unit spent three weeks in the sand. The first mission was establishing a defensive position to counter a possible Iraqi invasion of

Saudi Arabia.

"A big concern we had then and still have, is the terrorist threat," said 2nd Lt. John Anderson, a 1/7 platoon commander. "But, we have that covered by keeping the Marines on guard and using the natural discipline they have."

While Anderson is new to the unit — he picked up his unit three days prior to deploying to Desert Shield — he's confident in what his unit and Marines can do. "We have some of the best NCOs of any outfit," he said. "They have a wealth of information that has helped us evolve to the point where the desert isn't going to hamper us."

For their fourth trip to the field, the battalion was married-up with assault amphibious vehicles from 3d AAV Bn., MCAGCC Twenty-nine Palms, Calif.

"These tractors (the Land-ing Vehicle Tracked

Personnel-7-A2) are made to operate anywhere in the world with the proper maintenance," said Ssgt. Kenneth Cox of Broken Bow, Okla., platoon sergeant with the AAV battalion. "We kind of took it easy at first and found out what we had to do to keep the tractors up. Now we know the specific things to keep checking and we can go on forever."

Adapted to the desert and ready for combat, the men of 1/7 are settling into an uncertain routine. "A guy can drive himself crazy trying to piece together everything that is happening," said Anderson. "Besides, that's not our job."

"We're not particularly happy to have to sit here in the desert so far away from home, but we're proud to be here," said Cpl. Christopher Hughes of Bardotown, Ky. "The president has a job for us to do, and from what I see, we're doing it."

## Marine interpreter bridges American-Arab gaps

Saudi Arabia — Not even the 20th century staccato of Marine UH-1H Huey rotor blades washing the pre-dawn stillness off the desert floor is enough to draw the attention of an Arabian camel away from his breakfast. And no modern-day flying war machine is enough to distract a Kuwaiti Bedouin family tending its herd. Living in today's Middle East, even nomads have seen it all when it comes to military hardware.

Circling overhead and guiding their noses into the wind, the pilots set their birds down in a flurry of sand.

Honored that the helicopters had landed just for him, the Bedouin father came out to greet the two Marines who were getting out of the aircraft to talk to the family.

The Marines greeted them, one of them speaking comfortably in Arabic. The nomad was puzzled.

"You're Egyptian," the Bedouin said.

"I'm American," said the Marine.

"No. You're Egyptian." "He couldn't pinpoint my accent," said Cpl. Reid Shihadeh, a translator for the 1st Marine Division commanding general. "Normally, after about five minutes, you

can figure out where someone is from by his Arabic because he uses certain words. I mix Saudi, Jordanian and Egyptian, plus I've lived in the U.S. for a long time."

What the nomad didn't figure was that Shihadeh was a native of Dhahran, a city in Eastern Saudi Arabia.

The Bedouin invited the Marines to have tea with him. But they had no time for that. Their visit wasn't a social call: There was an entire artillery battery waiting for the signal to begin blasting the area with rounds.

"That (waiting for the Bedouins to leave the area) shut us down for four and a half hours," said Lt. Col. Bruce Judge, division weapons employment and training officer, responsible for clearing the firing range every morning before firing can begin.

"You know, a lot of us look at the barren desert and say, 'Why don't I crank off a couple of rounds here? But to them, it's prime grazing land,'" said Judge.

"You have to understand that these are pretty simple people. They've got their whole life's possessions out there and they're not really up on what's going on in the world."

That's where Shihadeh comes in.

"Corporal Shihadeh is the only Marine we have from this area," Judge said. "He's

probably the most effective person we have out here."

Not bad for an anti-tank specialist from 3d Bn., 5th Marines, out of Camp Pendleton, Calif., currently on a unit deployment to III Marine Expeditionary Force. He came over here from Okinawa three weeks ago looking forward to months in the hot sand.

"The battalion didn't really want anyone to find out about me," said Shihadeh, "but division found out about me, and I had two days to pack."

Born in Dhahran, Shihadeh moved to Philadelphia when he was 13. When he was 17, he moved to Austin, Texas, where he attended the University of Texas for three years. Impatient and undecided on his interests, he left school and later joined the Marine Corps in which he has been for the last four years.

"The first time I saw a Marine was as an 8-year-old boy at the U.S. Consulate in Dhahran," said Shihadeh. "I was really impressed. I couldn't believe it he looked like a statue standing there."

Little did Shihadeh know that memory would eventually land him back in Saudi Arabia, doing a job he likes and getting a chance to talk to friends and family in the area.

It doesn't look as if he or his boss, Capt. John H. Ghannam, a native Lebanese

Arabic speaker from San Diego will be leaving soon. "You've got a lot of units out there brushing into locals," Judge said.

The cooperation of local Saudi Emir and people are also helping to make the Marines jobs easier. "A lot of the natives are

glad we're here," Ghannam said. "They're extremely helpful, and everything they do is pro-American."

"I just wish I knew what he's talking about when he talks to them," said Judge of the exchanges between Shihadeh and the Bedouins while clearing the firing range

"It's more than just knowing the language," said Judge. "A lot of Marines speak Arabic and a lot of Arabs speak English. But out there in the desert you can't just wing it. You've got to know how to talk to them and he knows how to do it."

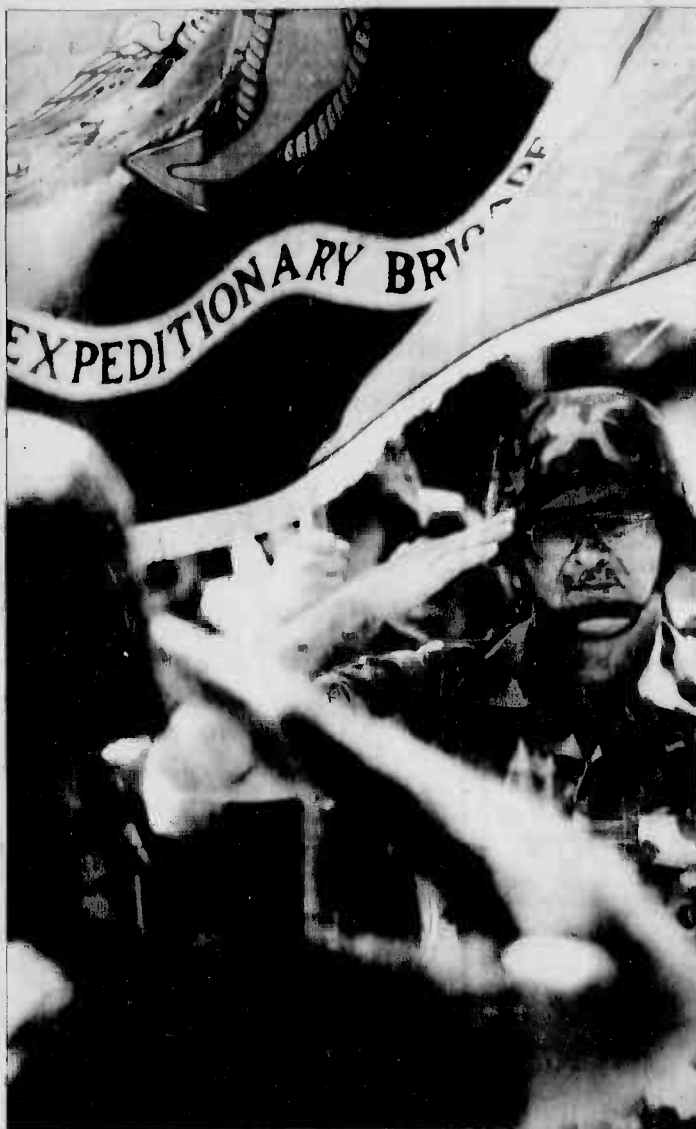

# Last farewell to 'living legend'

SgtMaj Allan J. Kellogg Jr. said he didn't want to go, but his time came.

"Thirty years went by fairly quick," Kellogg told the primarily military crowd that gathered at Dewey Square for his retirement. "I'm on my way out."

As he left, the Corps lost many things. Foremost, it lost a great leader. It also lost its last active duty enlisted Medal of Honor recipient. Kellogg was the only Marine to receive the nation's highest award and go on to serve as a sergeant major of a general level command. The only other Medal of Honor recipient to achieve

the rank of sergeant major was Dan Daly.

"What we have here is a living legend... A true American hero," said BGen. R.L. Phillips, Commanding General, 1st MEB/Deputy Commander, FMFPac. As Kellogg stepped off, SgtMaj. Harold Chapman stepped in to take his place as the Brigade sergeant major.

In recognition of his many contributions to country and Corps, Kellogg was presented the Legion of Merit and a letter from President George Bush. In part, it read: "You have helped maintain the security of the nation during a critical time in its history with devotion to duty and a spirit of sacrifice."

Kellogg summed up his 30 years with a humorous spirit.

"When I came in the Corps we had the Cuban crisis, and as I leave the Corps we have an Arabian crisis," he said. "And in between that, we had a couple of wars and a few skirmishes. You can't beat that."

Having recently returned from Saudi Arabia, Kellogg knows what his Marines over there are going through. After his retirement ceremony had concluded, he took time out to record a video message to them.

As for his personal plans, Kellogg says he will stay here in Hawaii for now, but doesn't have any set plans for the future. In fact, he doesn't quite feel like a civilian yet.

With a family of seven children ranging in age from 4 to 28 and everything in between, the sergeant major will have his hands full, as will his wife, Carol. Carol was also recognized for her contribution to the Marine Corps family during the ceremony.

The milestones in Marine Corps history have been paved by legends. In his 30-year career Kellogg has made some history of his own. He has also trained and led Marines who will pave the Corps' way along the road to the future.


