Playskool's 1-2-3 swing recalled

Owners of Playskool's 1-2-3 Swings should stop using them because the seat restraint can falsely appear to be locked and cause children to fall out, the government said today.

The company is voluntarily recalling 123,000 of the multicolored plastic swings that were sold for about \$25 nationwide between March and May, the Consumer Product Safety Commission said.

The safety agency said 50 consumers have reported children falling from the swings and suffering injuries that ranged from bumps and bruises to a broken nose. The swings convert to three styles: infant swing, chair swing and seat swing. The problem occurs in the infant swing position.

Owners of the 1-2-3 Swing should stop using it and return it to the store where it was purchased for a full refund. Consumers may also contact Playskool at 1-800-752-9755 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. EDT.

Marines continue "Top Dog" awards streak for ninth consecutive year

The Military Police Department, MCB Hawaii, captured the Top Kennel and Top Dog awards, in addition to many others, at the 9th Annual Police K9 Competition, held May 18 - 20 and hosted by the U.S. Naval Security Detachment, Pearl Harbor.

"We had won the Top Kennel award for the last eight years in a row, so the pressure was on to continue the streak," said Cpl. John Skidmore, Kennel Master, MPD, MCB Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay.

The "Top Dog" award is given to the animal that best displays all the abili-

ties necessary to be an effective tool in law enforcement. This year's recipient of the award was Silva, a five-year old Belgian Malinois. The dog and handler, LCpl. Herber Smith, are stationed with the MPD, MCB Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay.

Competitors included teams from the Honolulu Police Department, Kauai Police Department, Pearl Harbor Security Detachment and military police departments from Schofield Barracks, Hickam Air Force Base and MCB Hawaii. In all, 32 police dog teams were entered to compete in a variety of events.

LtGen. Krulak confirmed as 31st Commandant

Headquarters Marine Corps

The Senate confirmed Tuesday evening President Clinton's nomination to be the next Commandant of the Marine Corps.

Lieutenant General Charles C. Krulak, currently the commander of all Marine forces in the Pacific, was approved by unanimous consent after appearing before the Senate Armed Services Committee May 2. In that appearance, Krulak stressed his commitment to ensuring that the Marine Corps remains ready today and in the future. He told the Armed Services Committee that, "the future world will be characterized by crisis and conflict and the nation will require a military force that anticipates

change and adapts to new reality quickly and surely. No matter what the crisis or threat, the nation will have one thought: Send in the Marines!"

In addition to maintaining a warfighting focus for the Marine Corps, Krulak has long maintained that the individual Marine is central to the Corps' ability to win battles. He said, "taking care of our own has long been a tradition of the Corps because people are the Corps' most precious asset." He emphasized that he will concentrate on the consistent, fair, and unbiased treatment of all Marines. Marines, he said, must be confident in their leaders and in the processes — recruiting, classification, assignment, promotion, education, retention, separation — through which their service to their nation is managed. Krulak is con-

vinced that the most important responsibilities the Marine Corps has to the American people are to win the nation's battles and to make Marines.

Krulak emphasized to the Armed Services Committee that the "Total Force Marine Corps," both active and reserve and naval in character, provides a unique capability to the nation. "The Marine Corps forward operating air-ground task forces provide the combatant commanders in chief a crisis response capability found no where else in the world," he said. Krulak will carefully balance the readiness needs of today against the modernization needs of tomorrow, "I intend to take care of our Marines by doing everything I can to ensure they can survive the rigors of combat while also providing for the 'qual-

ity of life' for Marines and their families."

Long a supporter of professional military education, Krulak also plans to increase the use of simulation, virtual reality, models, and various warfighting games to make subsequent field training more effective and develop the intellectual agility, individual initiative, and rapid decision-making capability of every Marine.

Krulak said that because every Marine must be able to anticipate and react to the unexpected, seize the initiative, and take advantage of fleeting opportunities on the battlefield, the Marine Corps of the next century must be a "learning organization." He remarked that, "the foundation upon which we will build this

Housing provides adequate homes for special needs families

Perhaps the biggest concern of families just arriving in Hawaii is finding a place to live. Between the high cost of living here and the limited number of affordable rental units, the search for a new home can be quite stressful.

But imagine how much more difficult that search must be when a family member needs special accommodations because of a medical condition. For someone in a wheelchair, "adequate" housing takes on a whole new meaning.

The Marine Corps Base Hawaii Family Housing Department is often able to help families with those special needs. In 1987, the Exceptional Family Member Program was established to assist family members with physical, emotional or intellectual challenges, especially as they transition to new assignments.

When family members register with the program, they are placed into one of four categories, depending on how much and what type of medical care they'll require. Although enrollment in the EFMP does not automatically allow a family to move to the top of a housing waiting list, the MCBH Family Housing Department now gives priority housing assignments to families in Category 4 and in other medically-justified cases.

"A family member with a Category 4 condition will be given priority to housing automatically," said MCB Hawaii Family Housing Director Becky Ray. "To be assigned to Category 4, these families are faced with complex medical issues and it just makes sense to try to make things as easy as possible for them."

Family members in Category 4 often need modified quarters, Ray said. There are currently four homes at MCB Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay that can be

quickly and easily modified for families with special needs.

"These homes are one-story units with wider doorways that can accommodate wheelchairs," Ray said. "They also have lower kitchen counters and vanities that can be easily adjusted for use by a person in a wheelchair, and the bathrooms have reinforcements in the walls so that we can easily install grab bars."

The housing department won't allow these homes to remain vacant if no families are waiting for modified quarters, Ray said, but residents move into them with the understanding that they may be required to move if a family who needs the quarters arrives later. In that case, the housing department will reassign the non-EFMP family to other quarters and the government will pay for the move and quarters cleaning.

Most family members with special medical conditions don't have such

compelling needs, however. Because of Hawaii's climate and thriving foliage, many people with respiratory disorders such as asthma and allergies are registered in the EFMP here. Those families frequently need to live in an air conditioned environment. Until recently, they had to have medical documentation and request permission to install more than one window-type air conditioner. But because the Base Energy Conservation Policy has changed to allow all families to install two air conditioners, with permission, families need only seek special permission for additional air conditioners if they need more than two in their home.

"We will go to great lengths to help families who have a documented need for assistance," Ray said. "If we need to have quarters modified for an EFMP family, we have no problem with doing that. But each case is certainly differ-

147 U.S. Marines assist humanitarian mission in Trinidad

MCB, CAMP LEJEUNE, N.C. — One hundred and forty-seven Marines from the 8th Engineer Support Battalion are spending their spring taking part in a humanitarian mission to the Caribbean island of Trinidad. The detachment has concentrated on two types of projects since the advance party's arrival March 1, according to 1stLt. Todd L. Amann, Company C executive officer. "We've been working on humanitarian

and civic action projects and engineer-related construction projects," he said. "On the humanitarian and civic action side, we're renovating a community center and building a kindergarten schoolhouse. For construction projects, we're building a basic enlisted quarters, a command center and a one-mile access road for the Trinidadian Coast Guard." The 8th EngSpt. Bn. volunteered for the U.S. Atlantic Command-sponsored mission. Caribbean nations are allowed to request assistance from USACOM twice a year. The requests are made known to different commands and then

units volunteer for any that fit their training schedules, Amann said. "Our battalion volunteered for this mission because it gives us a chance to do a lot of construction work that isn't available at Camp Lejeune," he said. "It's a chance for the battalion to hone our building skills and help out a disadvantaged community at the same time." In traditional Marine Corps style, the engineers have completely sustained themselves while deployed. "Our base camp is made up of 30 tents on the beach," Amann explained. "We purify our own water for drinking. We've

also set up laundry facilities and showers. We eat mainly canned foods we brought from home and MREs for lunch." To keep the Marines up to speed on what's going on back home, the detachment started its own weekly newsletter, said Amann. "We call our paper the Two Palms Journal," he said. "Just like Twentynine Palms, except here we have two stand-alone palm trees right in the middle of our camp. The Marines really seem to enjoy the news." The citizens of Trinidad have been very hospitable to the Marines for

their effort to better the community, according to Amann. "All of the people here are extremely friendly," he said. "They've been very supportive of the Marines throughout our stay." Amann says the engineers have proven their ability to work together and get the job done. "The Marines are doing a great job utilizing skills they don't get to use very often," he said. "They've pulled together to make this happen and have represented the Marine Corps in the finest fashion." (LCpl. Scott J. Metzner, MCB Camp Lejeune)

Leader of "Top Gun" crew is right on target

"Fire!" The lanyard is pulled on the 155mm Howitzer and 105 pounds of high explosives is hurled downrange. The target is destroyed and the members of Bravo Battery, 1st Battalion, 12th Marines hoot and holler in victory. Bravo Battery not only won the direct-fire contest, they also took the overall Top Gun competition. The leader of this winning crew is SSgt. Alfonso Vasquez.

"We had a lot of work to do because a lot of the crew had just arrived here from school," Vasquez explained. "I made sure they got the right training they needed."

His section was composed almost entirely of cannoneers fresh from Fort Sill, Okla. Vasquez is credited for quickly molding them into a highly motivated and effective team.

"Every member of the crew needs to know his job, right down to the letter," he said. "We held a lot of one on one training sessions. Once everyone knew their respective job we practiced as a section until we were satisfied we were ready."

Despite the extremely long hours and frequent battery movements, his section consistently set the pace in safety, speed and accuracy. Vasquez kept his section well informed and spent long hours ensuring that they knew their job, and knew it well. As a result, his section was selected as the Bravo Battery representative for the Top Gun competition.

The cohesiveness and skill of his section was vividly demonstrated as their section won the direct-fire competition. Vasquez and his section set the standard with a second round direct hit in only 65 seconds.

Vasquez did so well at building a team as the section chief his command awarded him the Navy Achievement Medal for his actions during PTA 2-95. This was the third time he has received this medal.

But what led up to this achievement? Vasquez was born in Mexico City, Nov. 19, 1962. In 1970 his family, to include two brothers and three sisters, left Mexico and moved to San Diego, Calif. He graduated from San Diego High School in June, 1980 and immediately joined the Marine Corps.

"From the time I was really little, I always dreamed of being a Marine," Vasquez explained. "The uniform, the challenge, it was what I wanted and needed in my life."

So Vasquez joined the Marine Corps on an open contract and went to boot camp in San Diego. Early on his leadership skills were evident, and he became a squad leader while there.

After graduation, he was given his first duty assignment with the 11th Marines at Camp Pendleton.

"At that time they weren't sending us directly to school," he explained. "I spent a year with the artillery unit before I was sent to the school."

Vasquez spent 6 weeks at the Artilleryman School, Camp Pendleton in 1981, and was returned to his unit.

While at Camp Pendleton, Vasquez also took advantage of the education opportunities and received his associates in business from the National University.

From 1984-85, Vasquez was assigned with the 12th Marines at Camp Foster, Okinawa. After that tour, he returned to 2nd Battalion, 11th Marines in Camp Pendleton.

Vasquez met his wife, Genoveva, in 1983 at Camp Pendleton. And after returning from his overseas tour he married her in 1987. He now has two children, four year-old David, and Annaliza who is eight.

From 1990-1991, he was once again deployed, this time to Saudi Arabia. "We didn't see much while there, and we only shot off a few rounds," Vasquez said.

In 1991, Vasquez was selected for the drill field in San Diego.

"I loved it," he said. "This was my chance to turn a civilian into a basic Marine. It was a big challenge, and I was proud to serve as a drill instructor."

Following DI duty, Vasquez arrived in Hawaii and was assigned to Bravo Battery, 1/12.

When asked about the influences in his Marine Corps career, Vasquez names two.

"My first, and most lasting influence is Chesty Puller," he said. "I read a lot about him, and he has inspired me to always do my best as a Marine. Another influence in my career was GySgt. Gates, who I worked with while stationed with the 11th Marines."

Vasquez explained. "I learned a lot about artillery from him. Many of his teaching skills are what I use today to help others learn about this field."

Vasquez desires to continue in the Marine Corps and advance to First Sergeant and would also like to return to school and obtain his bachelors degree.

Dogs

Smell is one of a dog's most developed senses. Its nasal passages can filter a large amount of air, and its olfactory portion of the brain is proportionately large. In the wild, this enables the animal to detect a rabbit's presence in its underground lair, or to track its prey through the forest. Once trained, this extraordinary ability can be harnessed to detect hazardous or illegal substances, or to track a fleeing or lost individual. Some of the events have been designed to gauge how well the dog has been trained to utilize this ability.

The first day of competition encompassed two events, explosive detection and narcotic detection. Recent events have graphically displayed the urgent need for an early warning against terrorist attacks, and an effective means of curtailing drug trafficking in the United States. Police dogs working as explosive detectors and narcotic detectors have proven themselves an effective countermeasure against these offenses. Teams from MCB Hawaii demonstrated these abilities when the teams of Robb with handler Cpl. Michael Tijerina earned 2nd place in the explosive detection competition, and Rex with handler LCpl. Russell Marubbio captured 3rd place in the

narcotic detection competition. During the next day of competition, police dogs demonstrated another benefit of their keen sense of smell.

On the second day, the scouting competition tested the teams ability to locate a person that may be either lost, or hiding in an attempt to avoid apprehension by the law.

"Every animal, including man, has their own personal scent. This airborne odor will spread out into what is called a scent cone. The dog will pick this scent up, stay within the cone and find the individual," said Cpl. Derek Wiese, a competitor from MCB Hawaii who watched as Silva and handler Smith took 3rd place in the scouting competition.

The final day of competition required precise dog to handler team work, as the competitors participated in the obedience competition and the controlled aggression competition. During the obedience competition handlers were required to give verbal and non-verbal commands, and the dogs were expected to respond without haste. In addition, handlers led their animals through a series of obstacles. The teams were judged on control by how well the dogs negotiated obstacles by command, while avoiding other obstacles. MCB Hawaii's team of Silva and Smith dominated the competition taking 1st place.

The last event of the day judged the handlers ability to release and con-

trol the aggression of his dog. The strength and intelligence of the dog are displayed, as the handler sends his seemingly docile animal racing across a field to detain a fleeing offender. With the bark of a single command, the animal releases his grip on the suspects arm and quickly returns to the handlers side. The team of Roeska and handler Cpl. John Skidmore took 3rd place in this event.

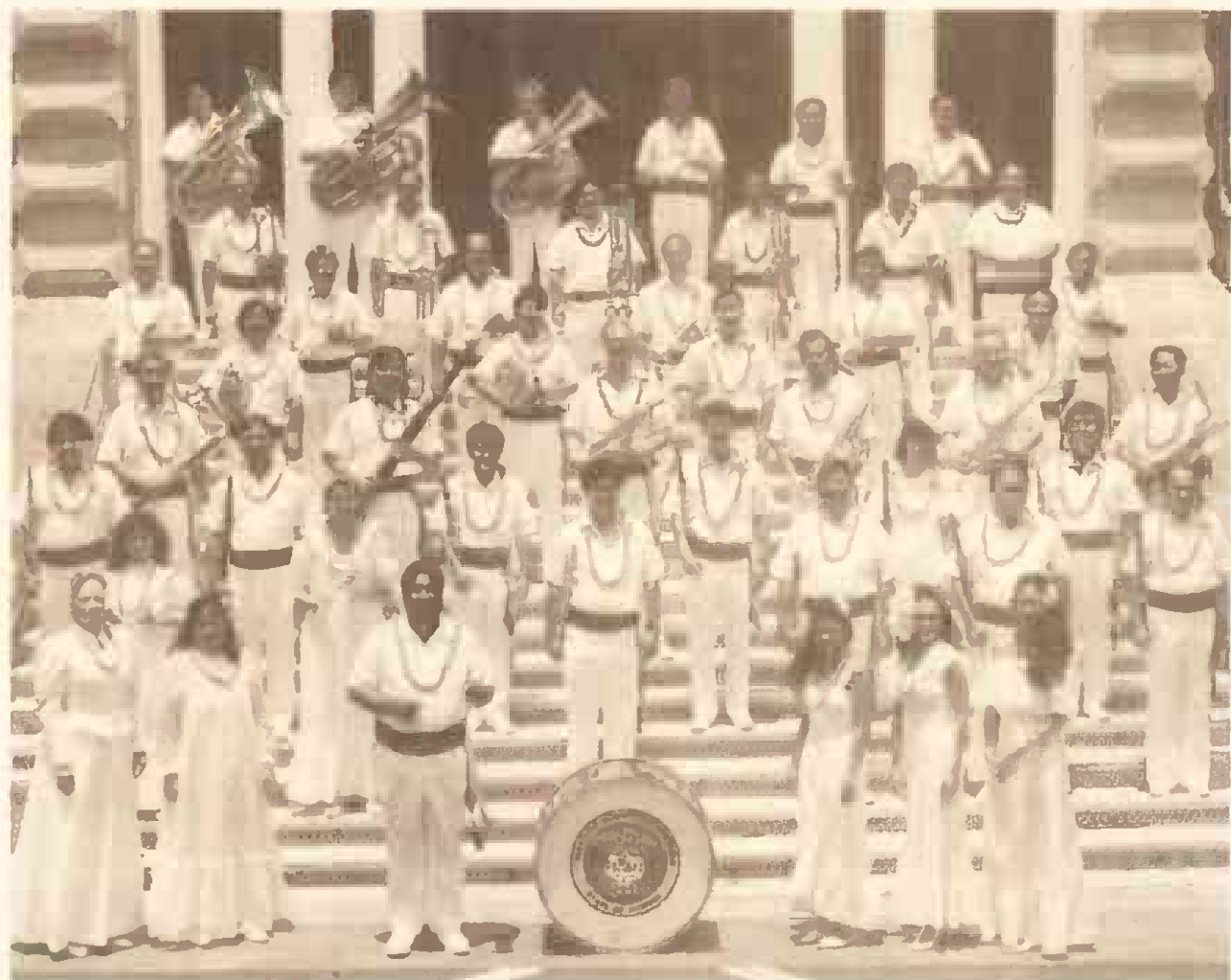

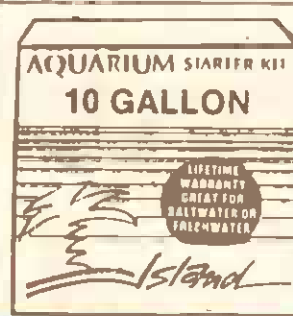

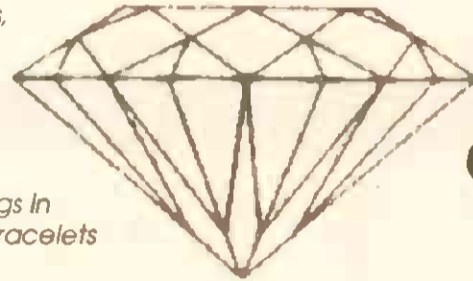

ent and must be considered individually," she said.

For example, modifications to quarters or moves to modified quarters usually aren't approved for temporary conditions, such as a difficult pregnancy, Ray said. But because each case is different, people should not be afraid to come forward when they need assis-

tance.

Service members are not discriminated against because they have exceptional family members, Ray said, and it's impossible to provide help for someone who hasn't asked for it.

"Of course, all EFMP requests must be medically supported," she added, "but help is available for those families who really need it."

To request modifications to quarters under provisions of the EFMP, write a letter to the family housing director stating

exactly what's needed. You'll need to enclose a letter from your personal care physician, either here or at a previous assignment. Before the Family Housing Director approves the modification, the Chief of Clinical Services at the branch medical clinic must endorse the request.

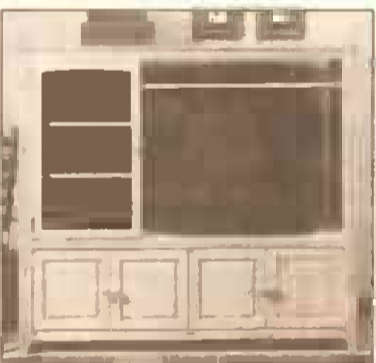

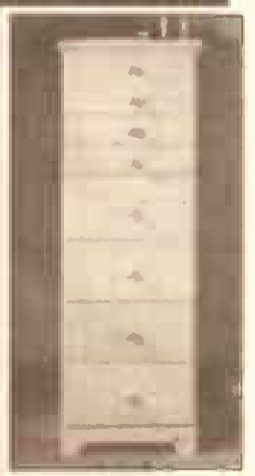

On the HomeFront

A pre-termination inspection offers instruction to make a smooth move

If your family plans to move in the next 60 days and you haven't already filed an Intent of Notice to Vacate at the Family Housing Department, now is the time to do so. When you file the vacate notice, you'll meet with a Customer Service Counselor who will schedule a pre-termination inspection of your quarters and give you a detailed list of cleaning responsibilities and tasks.

Even with the list, most residents have questions. During the pre-termination inspection, a housing inspector will meet with you at your home. The two of you will walk through the house and yard, and the inspector will answer your questions and tell you exactly what you must do to clear quarters.

If you are moving for the government's convenience, which includes most permanent change of station moves, a government-contracted cleaning team will do much of the heavy cleaning for you.

You'll be required to sweep or vacuum all the floors, remove dirt and markings from interior and exterior walls and doors, and clean the appliances.

You must remove soap, dirt and lint particles from inside and outside the washer and dryer, clean the lint trays and then turn off the washer's water supply valve. You'll also need to ensure the dishwasher is free of food particles and soap residue, defrost the refrigerator and remove food particles and water. The oven and stove must be free of encrusted and burned food, oil and grease.

During the pre-termination inspection, the housing inspector will instruct you to remove shelf paper, tape and tape residue, staples, tacks, food, trash and personal items from cabinets, closets, drawers and shelves.

The inspector will look at self-help exchange items, such as burner-drip pans, and let you know if they need to be exchanged before the final inspection. He may also instruct you to perform certain self-help repairs

prior to moving.

Most residents ask if they'll need to remove nails and patch nail holes, said Housing Inspector Ricardo Gonzalez.

"If it's a move for government convenience, we'll take care of any hole smaller than one inch in diameter. If it's bigger than that, it's the occupant's responsibility to repair it.

"We also ask residents to request appliance repairs before they move out, so that the next occupant has a working appliance," Gonzalez said.

"Even if we check an appliance, we can't always tell if it's broken. I could turn the oven on and feel heat, but if the oven's thermostat isn't working, I'd have no way of knowing."

Government-contracted cleaning is not authorized for moves that take place for personal convenience. For example, if you move from government quarters to government quarters due to an increase in rank or dependents, or if you are vacating quarters because your dependents are leaving before the end of your

assignment, you will be required to perform not only the cleaning tasks listed above, but also all the cleaning normally accomplished by the contractor. You will have to thoroughly clean floors, windows, screens and blinds, bathroom and kitchen fixtures, light fixtures and exhaust fans.

During the pre-termination inspection, you and the inspector will also discuss improvements or alterations you made to the quarters.

Normally, you'll be required to remove wallpaper, shelves, lanai covers, dog houses, paneling and any other item you added to the quarters.

In some cases, you may be allowed to leave an item in place. If you've installed an air conditioner, for example, and the in-coming occupant wants to take responsibility for it, your housing inspector can tell you how to obtain permission to leave the item in place.

Next week: The pre-termination inspection continues outside the house—preparing the yard and exterior for moving.

Chiefs upset Wolverines in gridiron playoff battle

It was a minor upset for the first game of football playoffs, Sunday, as the MCB Hawaii's Chiefs emerged victorious over the 3d Marines' Wolverines in their gridiron battle aboard MCB Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay.

After losing by more than 60 points in their last game and by more than 30 points the game prior to that, it was a surprising upset for the Chiefs to come back and beat the number three seeded team, 30-16.

"We had nothing left to lose," said Michael Franks of the Chiefs. "With all the injuries we had during the season, we finally had gotten our people all back together, so we just went out there and played some football."

The situation looked dim for the Chiefs as the Wolverines started off strong in the first quarter.

After getting a touchback against the Chiefs on the fourth play of the game, the Wolverines went on to push their way down the field during their next drive and scored a touchdown with a rush up the middle by Christopher Thomas. Christopher Cutter then caught a pass in the end zone for the two-point conversion.

The Chiefs fumbled on the second down of their next drive and Floyd King recovered the ball for the Wolverines. He caught a pass four downs later to put the Wolverines ahead at the end of the first quarter, 16-0.

Jeffrey Salko of the Chiefs ended a series of fumbles and recoveries by both teams when he intercepted a Wolverine pass and ran for the touchdown in the early minutes of the second quarter.

The Chiefs' defense continued to strengthen toward the end of the half.

Wolverine quarterback, Phil Macon, being pressured in the back field by Franks was intercepted by Kenneth Thomas who ran 15 yards for a Chiefs' touchdown. The half finished with the Chiefs within four points, 16-12.

The third quarter was a defensive battle.

The only break in the defensive struggle was after a fumble by the Wolverines and the Chiefs recovering on the defensive five-yard line. Quarterback Steven Moore then got the snap and plunged up the middle for the only score of the third quarter giving the Chiefs their first lead, 18-16.

The defenses continued to battle until the last three minutes of the game when the Chiefs' offense started gaining ground.

The Chiefs got the ball at their own 28-yard line. Two plays later Moore ran for 13 yards giving the Chiefs a firstdown. Three plays later Moore connected with Donald Hoff for a 35 yard touchdown giving the Chiefs an eight-point advantage with 3:13 left in the game.

The Chiefs defense shut down the Wolverines on the next series regaining possession of the ball on the defensive 19-yard line.

On the first play, Moore ran the ball 19 yards for a touchdown giving the Chiefs their final score and a 30-16 victory.

"The team has a lot of heart and they just brought it out in the field," said Brett Page, offensive coordinator for the Chiefs. "We had a lot of people injured or gone to the Pohakuloa Training Area during the last few games. I think that contributed to the large losses the last couple of weeks."

"We haven't had a lot of practice the last couple of weeks, but we have a lot to work for now," said Franks, as the Chiefs advanced to within one game of the Championship.

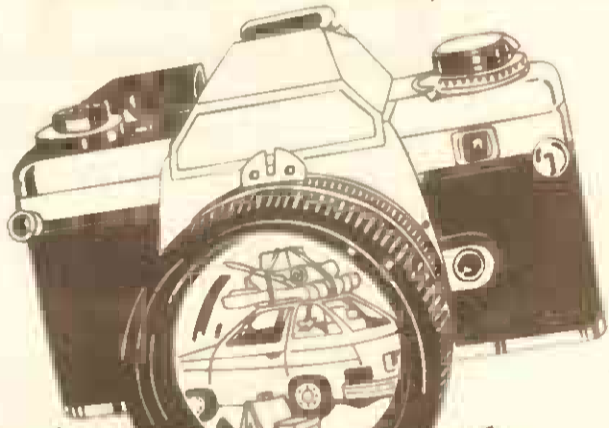
