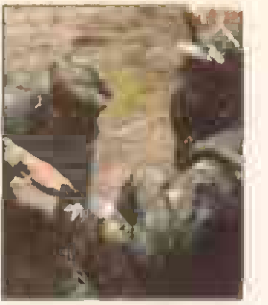

## Navy/Marine Corps Medals presented

Two Marines were awarded the Navy/Marine Corps Medal for heroism at a ceremony at Dewey Square here Wednesday.

Sgt. Jonathan C. Knauth, a combat photographer with Training and Audio Visual Support, and Warrant Officer John F. Kauffman III, retail officer with MWR, earned the medal for their part in a January rescue of a surfer at North Beach here.

"It felt good to receive the award, but that's not what you think about when you rush out there to help someone in trouble," Knauth said about the honor.

A routine winter day of surfing almost became a fatal one for Mike Kleinchek. Only quick reactions from the surfers and lifeguards enjoying the waves that day saved Kleinchek.

Witnesses from the shore saw a surfboard floating in the waves at North Beach with no surfer nearby. Since the surfboard didn't move with the surf back toward the shore, the observers realized the surfer was still attached to the board by his ankle leash, buoying the board in place.

Knauth was the first person from the shore to rush to aid the surfer. He was followed moments later by Kauffman and beach lifeguards. They swam straight out to the swimmer, despite the

strong rip currents and coral reef between them and Kleinchek.

Chief Petty Officer Jonathan Scott Sanders, ship's independent duty corpsman with the USS Salvor, stationed in Pearl Harbor, was already in the water on his surfboard and was the first to reach Kleinchek. After Knauth arrived, he and Sanders held the victim's head above water. Kauffman arrived with his surfboard and they laid Kleinchek on the board.

"I estimate he was underwater at least three to four minutes before he was brought to the surface," Kauffman said in the accident report. "I told them we need to start CPR."

Kauffman said he began mouth-to-

mouth resuscitation while the others kept the victim above water. At this time, they noticed Kleinchek was bleeding from a gash near his right ear.

"Apparently the surf knocked the ridge of the surfboard against Kleinchek's temple, and it also broke his jaw," Knauth said.

The rescuers began swimming back into shore, all the while continuing CPR efforts. Once on the beach, other lifeguards reached the rescue party and began administering oxygen to the victim.

"When we got him to shore he was dead," Knauth said. "There was no

## 13th MEU wraps up Hawaii training

The power of a Marine Expeditionary Unit hit the Hawaiian Islands Dec. 12 when more than 1,000 Marines and Sailors came ashore to conduct sustainment training before heading for the Western Pacific.

Marines and Sailors of the 13th Marine Expeditionary Unit (Special Operations Capable) took their first opportunity to train since their Special Operations Capable qualification exercise in October off the coast of California.

The 13th MEU(SOC)'s Ground Combat Element, Battalion Landing Team 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment, conducted a variety of training on the islands of Oahu and Hawaii, including a helicopter raid, patrolling, jungle warfare and live-fire

shoots.

Elements of BLT 2/1 also conducted tactical air control and fire support training at Pohakuloa Training Area with the MEU's Aviation Combat Element, Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 364 (Reinforced).

MEU Service Support Group-13, the Combat Service Support Element of the 13th MEU(SOC), also conducted live fire and demolitions training at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, Kaneohe Bay and Schofield Barracks.

The 13th MEU(SOC) gained valuable experience in the mountainous jungle terrain here, which offered training opportunities not available in California.

"It's very important that we get time to refresh perishable skills. We tried to make the most of this short training evolution,"

said 1st Lt. Gene Geraci, 28, Surveillance and Target Acquisition Platoon commander from Dublin, Ireland.

Although rough seas prevented the MEU from conducting Landing Craft-Air Cushioned and Assault Amphibious Vehicle operations, training was maximized through the adaptability of the 13th MEU(SOC)'s logistics.

After three days of intense operations, Marines and Sailors ashore commenced to re-embark aboard the ships of the Boxer Amphibious Ready Group.

The 13th MEU(SOC) will continue its deployment by sailing to the Western Pacific and Arabian Gulf to serve as America's force in readiness at the "tip of the spear."

## Team K-Bay gets free history lessons

An informal Hawaii information session call "Let's Talk Story," coordinated by three native Hawaiians, will be held Jan. 9 at 7 p.m. in Classroom 1 at the Joint Education Center.

Let's Talk Story aims to give MCB Hawaii residents a better understanding of the Hawaiian culture, and help build a harmonious relationship with the civilian community, according to Gustav C. Bechert, the coordinator and a speaker for the event.

"Many people who are stationed in Hawaii go home without any knowledge of Hawaii," said Bechert. "Knowing the history of Hawaii will help them better understand the people in the community and what they do."

Two other panelists slated to speak during the event,

Ryan Kalama and Ryan O'Sullivan, were also born and raised in Hawaii.

Kalama, born in Honolulu and raised in Kailua, has studied, taught and consulted about the Hawaiian culture for more than 30 years. He comes from a long line of hula family.

O'Sullivan, who was born and raised in Honolulu, is a long-time school teacher. He has taught at Kamehameha High School and travelled extensively throughout his life.

Bringing these three Hawaii natives to speak to the military community provides three generations of knowledge, according to Bechert. It's the only way to get the whole story about the history of the unique islands.

**Sergeant Major's Corner**

**New PES goes into effect with new year**

Starting Jan. 1, 1999, the new performance evaluation system goes into effect for all sergeants and above throughout the entire Marine Corps. For those of you who don't know it, the report has been completely re-designed from the ground up so it will more accurately assess a Marine's skill and potential.

There will be five areas of evaluation on the new report. They are: mission accomplishment, individual character, leadership, intellect and wisdom.

Listed under the five main areas of evaluation will be 14 attributes in the form of a "performance anchoring rating scale." Each one of the performance anchored rating scales or (PARS) provides a complete descriptor for each evaluated attribute. This will reduce the requirement for written comments by the reporting senior and evaluate the Marine against definitive degrees of performance.

Also included in the new report are a series of checks and balances to ensure that reporting seniors who might be inclined to "inflate" reports cannot do so. The reporting seniors will be monitored throughout his or her career.

The performance evaluation system team out of Headquarters Marine Corps is making its swing throughout the Marine Corps, giving classes to all sergeants and above on how the reports are to be written and the administrative functions that must be followed to submit the new report. I highly recommend that you take the time to attend one of the sessions. The whole Marine Corps is tooling up for this new evaluation system. The more you know about it, the better you will understand how it's written. Remember,

your fitness report is the primary document used by HQMC to consider you for promotion, approve requests for re-enlistments and in deciding your next assignment.

This is not a change to the old reporting process. This is a whole new system.

Now, having said all that, before everyone starts going to "GQ," (General Quarters for you land lubbers) let me offer some advice on how to make sure you get a good evaluation each and every reporting period. This advice was passed to me long ago by many Marines who I admire and respect. It has served me well for the last 28 years. And if you follow it, it will do the same for you. Do your job to the best of your ability. Be on time. Be a Marine in mind, appearance and spirit. Keep yourself in the best possible shape you can. Participate in the professional military education program for your grade and obey all orders, rules and regulations both in word and deed." Ta da! That's it.

If you follow these simple instructions, you will be rated as the kind of Marine that you are — a good one.

Now on the other hand, who should be worried about the new report or any report for that matter? That answer is just as simple.

Anyone who tries to game the system, cut corners, steal, abuse alcohol, use drugs, abuse their spouse or children. In short, those who should be afraid are the "feather merchants," "pretend Marines" and huns that make up the one percent of our Corps and who fail to live up to the standards set by our commanders and to the ethos of our Corps.

Marines, believe me, you concentrate on doing your job, keeping yourself fit, setting the proper example and taking care of your Marines, and you can never go wrong under the old fitness report system or this new one. You do your duty and your fitness report will write itself. In short,

if you give your Corps an honest day's work for an honest day's pay, you will never have to worry about a fitness report.

You won't have to worry because you will know in your heart you have done your best, and believe me our officers who write our reports will know it and mark your report accordingly.

You will never have to worry about someone "taking care of you" because, frankly Marines, you will be taking care of yourself. You will be doing your duty to the best of your ability and that's all anyone can ask for, from the newest second lieutenant reporting senior to the Commandant of the Marine Corps.

By the same token, if you do have some shortcomings noted by your reporting senior, don't fall off the deep end, sulk and brood over it. Work to correct them for the next report. Show your reporting senior you can take constructive criticism and correct those deficiencies. Heck, no one is perfect and we all can improve in some area.

Sometimes we need someone else to point those shortcomings out to us to make us better Marines. On the flip side, don't expect a glowing report if you're late for work, look like a lister bag with lips and spend more time in the commanding officer's office than the first sergeant. You reap what you sow.

Make sure you get to the classes being given on the new fitness reporting system and learn everything there is to learn about it. But don't dwell on it. You are going to be just as "outstanding" on the new one as on the old one.

Just be the best Marine you can and those fitness reports will take care of themselves. Have faith in our Corps and our officers to be the professionals they are. You just do your part and your career is in safe hands. After all, it's your hands that it's in. Someone else just reports it. Semper Par.

# 3/3 defends Ie Shima com site

**IE SHIMA ISLAND, Okinawa, Japan** — Crouched silently in the concealment of tall grass, two forward observers from 3rd Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, watch a group of helicopters making their descent to the Ie Shima airfield.

Once on the ground, three squads of enemy troops egress from the craft and take defensive positions around the landing zone.

The "enemy" was Marines from 2nd Bn., 7th Marines from Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms, Calif., and their mission was to raid a communications outpost held by K Co., 3/3, according to 2nd Lt. Micheal C. Bennett, 3rd Platoon commander, K Co.

"Our battalion sent us out here this week to conduct defense training classes with 1st Marine Aircraft Wing, and along with that we were tasked with being the opposing force for this raid."

Throughout the exercise, the various units involved in Beachcrest were brought up to speed on a lot of infantry tactics they normally don't practice. Bennett said. Classes on subjects ranging from digging fighting holes to perimeter defense were given by K Co. Marines.

According to Cpl. Jeremy Chapman, a

reserve augmentee from Naval Air Station Fort Worth, Texas, the training they received was pretty thorough.

"A lot of these infantry tactics are things that I haven't used since MCT (Marine Combat Training)," said Chapman, an air traffic control radar specialist. "Things like setting up a defensive perimeter and defending an airstrip from assault are absolutely necessary, and I'm glad they were here to share their knowledge."

In this scenario, K Co. Marines seized a communications post and established a defensive perimeter, along with a communications post. According to Bennett, it was 2/7's job to come in and destroy that site, and it was K Co.'s job to delay their progress as much as possible.

That's exactly what Cpl. Thomas H. Dollar and Pfc. Chad R. Suchy, the two forward observers, were doing crouching in the grass when 2/7 landed.

They were one of several two-man teams working forward silent listening posts, and their job was to warn the rest of the platoon of the enemy's arrival.

"They first hit us with artillery and attacked us with AH-1W Cobra helicopters," Suchy said as he explained the scenario. "Then two CH-46 Sea Knight and two CH-53 Super Stallion helicopters flew in and each deployed a squad of

Marines."

"The listening posts ran into a problem when they were spotted by a couple of Cobras. That's when we were flanked by two of their squads, so we fired off a couple of rounds and hightailed it out of there to warn the rest of the platoon," he said.

According to Cpl. Nathan Roberts, 2nd squad leader, Dollar and Suchy did just what the situation called for.

"Our job wasn't to put up a strong defense, but to offer resistance, then fall back to consolidate and defend the site, so we would have as few casualties as possible," Roberts explained. "When Dollar and Suchy were spotted, they took note of the situation and made their way back here. That's what they were supposed to do."

Eventually, the communications site was destroyed. Flanking from both sides, 2/7 closed in on the objective, as K Co. gave defensive fire and fell back. When they reached the sight, two K Co. Marines were there to fight to the finish. They fell to 2/7 and the site was destroyed by a simulated C-4 blast.

"Overall, the raid was a very good experience for the platoon," Bennett said. "The platoon was very professional, and worked very well together. Also, this helps us by letting us do things we don't normally get to do and see how other units perform against us."

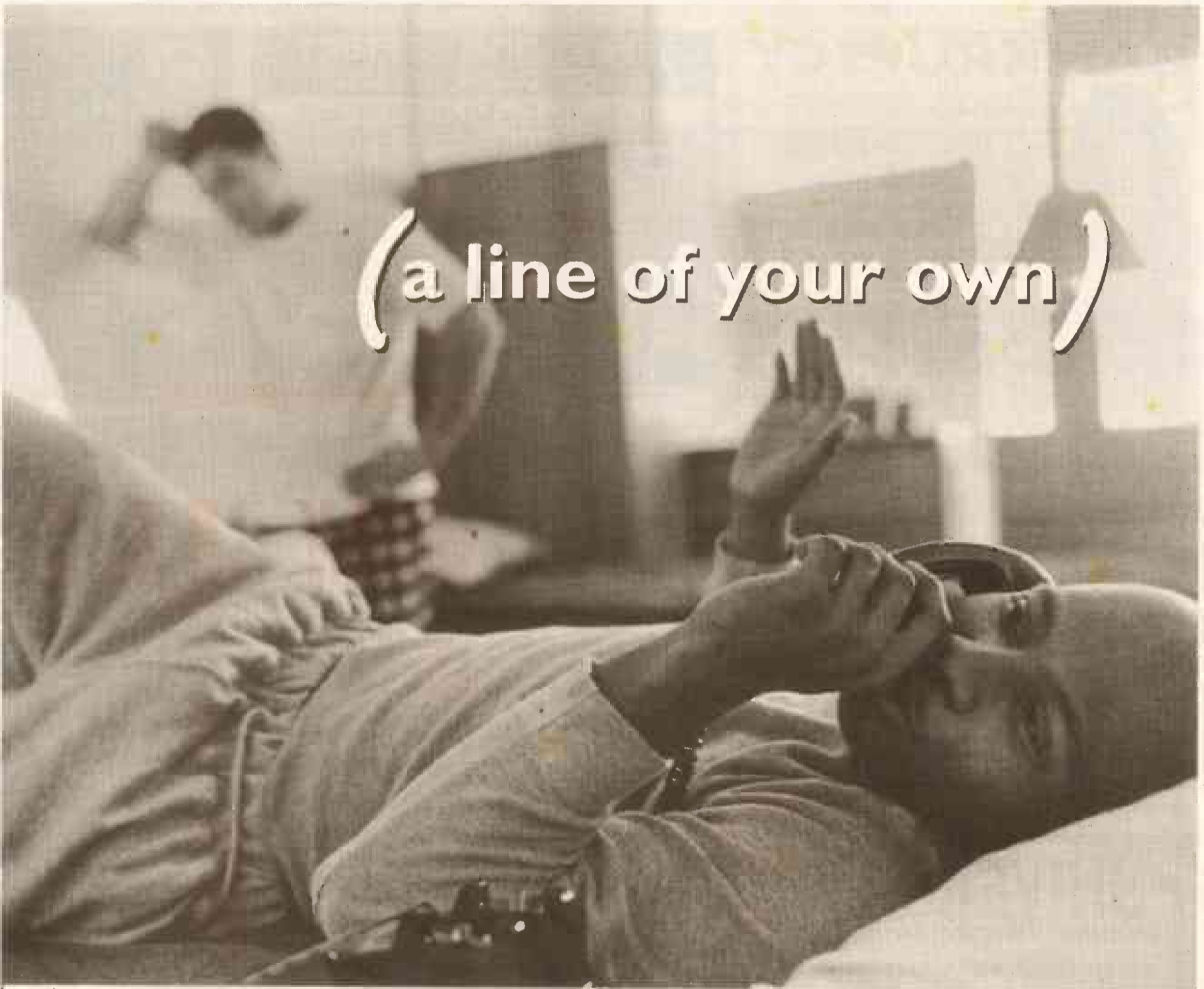

Hard work throughout the year at Anderson Hall gave four food service specialists an opportunity to win the Chef of the Year award Dec. 9, but just one could earn the title.

## 'Operation Mo Toys' draws crowd of nearly 5,000

PEARL HARBOR — The Marine Corps Reserve Toys for Tots program drew a crowd of 4,798 people during the Toys for Tots "Sneak Preview" of the Battleship Missouri Memorial function here Saturday.

"The way it works, is people bring a toy in and get a sneak preview of the ship," said Gunnery Sgt. Maury Reeves, state coordinator for Toys for Tots and communications chief for the Inspector and Instructor staff at 4th Force Reconnaissance Co. here.

The Missouri, which pulled into Pearl Harbor on June

22, was not scheduled to open until late January, but the USS Missouri Memorial Association opened the ship's gangways especially for the event.

"This was a great success for Toys for Tots, and we appreciate the tremendous contribution made by the USS Missouri Memorial Association to help us meet our objective," said Brig. Gen. Arnold Fields, commanding general, MCB Hawaii. "Everyone was very impressed by the battleship and one word seemed best to describe their reaction — awesome."

Marine volunteers from MCB Hawaii were on hand for the event to gather 6,352 toys for Hawaii's deserving

children, Reeves said.

Since the beginning of the Toys for Tots project in a Marine Reserve Unit in Los Angeles in 1947, the program has expanded nationally and has distributed more than 232 million toys nationwide, according to Reeves.

"This sheds good light on the Marine Corps, but that's not why we do it," Reeves said. "It shows that not only do we fight battles in foreign lands to protect the nation, we fight to protect the less fortunate at home too."

"This event wouldn't have been such a great success had it not been for the efforts of News 8 (NBC Hawaii) and Krater 96 (KRTR-FM)," Reeves said.

# 'Holiday cheer' can kill

**CAMP H.M. SMITH** — Every day 45 people die on roads around the country thanks to intoxicated drivers.

Statistics show four Marines or Sailors will be killed during the holiday season because of safety mishaps, including alcohol abuse and intoxicated motorists.

Statistics also show that alcohol abuse and impaired driving rises significantly over holiday periods, with December typically being high on that list, according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

In an effort to prevent alcohol abuse and driving under the influence, December has been proclaimed National Drunk and Drugged Driving (3D) Prevention Month by President William J. Clinton.

The Commandant of the Marine Corps, Gen. Charles C. Krulak has also explained his stance on alcohol abuse and drunk driving in annual All Marine message, 365/98.

"Drinking and driving puts both the guilty and innocent at risk," Gen. Krulak said. "This inexcusable behavior results in more than a tragic and unnecessary loss for the guilty party; it often results in the same senseless loss for the families and friends of innocent victims," he added.

According to the Commandant, there is no magic formula to prevent these deaths. Instead, he emphasized good common sense, based on awareness, preparation, and responsibility.

General Krulak also said the Corps cannot afford to lose a single Marine or Sailor. "While the impact of such loss on readiness is substantial, the cost to family and friends is immeasurable," he said.

Marines here are getting the message.

"This is the first year in a quite some time that I haven't flown home for Christmas," said Lance Cpl. Eric A. Coyle, a warehouse and supply technician assigned here. "But I know there's so much more to do with friends here than just sit in the barracks and drink (alcohol). Marines just have to get out and enjoy each others company and enjoy the holiday spirit," he said.

"It's so important to have a designated driver, not just during the holidays, but all year round. I'd much rather lose a beer than a family member or friend," said Cpl. Jason Stamp, a 22-year-old supply clerk with the systems integration hub here.

In spite of national efforts, reducing impaired driving continues to be a challenge, according to information from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's web site. "Last year, approximately 17,000 Americans lost their lives due to impaired driving-related crashes," said Dr. Ricardo Martinez of the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

An average of one alcohol related fatality occurs every 30 minutes, said GS-13 Donald C. Weightman, MarForPac's ground safety officer. "Traffic crashes cost employers, including military and civilian, about \$55 billion a year, and alcohol is a factor in 41 percent of these crashes," Weightman added.

The Commandant also emphasized moderate and mature use of alcohol if Marines and Sailors are going to drink, but he also wants leaders and commanders to disseminate information on alcohol-free events.

The Mothers Against Drunk Driving organization echoed the Commandant's message about responsible drinking.

"We encourage all Americans to designate a non-drinking driver before the celebrations begin so that we can enjoy (the holidays) without putting lives at risk," said Karolyn Nunnallee, Mothers Against Drunk Driving national president.

"The saying, 'friends don't let friends drive drunk' is a life-saving motto," said Marine Forces Pacific Force Chaplain, Navy Capt. Alan N. Keiran. "In our Marine Corps we have the motto, 'being Marine means caring for my fellow Marines.' Not just caring for our friends or those in our platoon or work center, but any Marine or Sailor we know that needs our help."

Keiran also added, "never, ever drink until you lose control...the cost is always high...the unintended consequences often unforeseen."

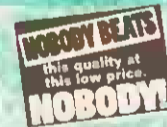

## 13th MEU patrols at Kahuku

**KAHUKU TRAINING AREA** — It's one of the skills all Marines learn. Either in the rear or behind enemy lines, it is something that any leather-neck can be called upon to do — patrol.

Marines from the 13th Marine Expeditionary Unit (Special Operations Capable) had a chance to refresh their basic patrolling skills while conducting training in the Kahuku Training Area Saturday and Sunday.

After being embarked on ships of the Boxer Amphibious Ready Group for more than a week, Marines from G and Headquarters and Service Companies, Battalion Landing Team 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment, began patrolling classes Saturday afternoon after completing a helicopter raid.

The classes worked up from basic patrol formations to more advanced reconnaissance and combat patrols.

Throughout the course of the MEU's work-ups, the only patrolling the company had done was in the desert environment of Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center Twentynine Palms and the sparsely vegetated hills of Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, a far cry from the dense jungles of Hawaii's mountains.

This difference in terrain enhanced the spectrum of environments the MEU is comfortable operating in.

"Our focus in training is usually for operations in the Middle East, but we need to be ready to go if we have a situation in a jungle environment," said 1st Lt. Jason Perry, 29, G Co. executive officer, from Hendersonville, N.C.

The nature of the terrain also lent itself to the development of other intangible skills. Squad leaders were allowed to take their squads out on independent operations to concentrate on developing small unit leadership ability, which can be difficult during a

MEU's work-ups, where large-scale amphibious assaults and special operations are a mainstay.

For some of the Marines involved in the training, any chance to patrol was a welcome change from their normal routine.

"As mortarmen, we are usually training to set up support-by-fire positions and rarely do patrolling. This training does a lot to refresh our basic infantry skills," said Gunnery Sgt. Michael Howard, 34, platoon sergeant for Weapons Plt., G Co. from Orange Park, Fla.

The patrolling training package concluded with force-on-force combat patrols, where squads had a chance to engage each other in mock combat to enhance the overall effectiveness of the training.

"When we get to do something like this in a different environment, you train harder because it's not the same old thing," said Lance Cpl. Michael Martin, 19, a rifleman and G Co. clerk from Dayton, Ohio.

## 13th MEU Marines improvise on Kahuku raid

**KAHUKU TRAINING AREA** — Marines from G Co., Battalion Landing Team 2nd Battalion, 1st Marine Regiment, 13th Marine Expeditionary Unit (Special Operations Capable) performed a helicopter raid in the mountainous Kahuku Training Area Saturday.

The training was part of the 13th MEU(SOC)'s sustainment training conducted here during the first half of its six-month deployment.

In the scenario, the company targeted a host nation communications site captured by terrorists. The Marines' mission was to seize the facility and turn it over to host nation forces, said Capt. Jason Bohm, G Co. commander.

What normally would have been a simple mission became more challenging because of last-minute changes that forced Marines to improvise, adapt and overcome.

One of the CH-46 Sea Knights was delayed in departing the USS Boxer and part of the security element was unable to take part in the mission. This forced the assault team to provide its own security and continue on, said Sgt. Albert Nowicki, a security element squad leader.

For some of the Marines participating in the raid, this was their first chance to break out of their normal support roles on the MEU.

"I'd never done anything like this with a real line platoon. I thought I'd be behind a desk for the whole deployment," said Cpl. Tim Babcock, BLT 2/1 legal

chief.

With Marines from other military occupational specialties accompanying them on the raid, the infantry Marines gained some additional training.

"If you have the same people going with you all the time, it becomes routine," said fire team leader Lance Cpl. Walter Bell. "Having some of the support guys come out helps us as instructors."

After securing the objective and turning it over to the "host nation officials," the Marines made their way back to the extraction point for debriefing; critiquing all the phases of the raid.

"It's never perfect," said Cpl. Alex Moriera, 23, a mortar team leader from Houston, Texas. "We can always stand to improve some, but it's nothing we can't do with some hard work."

# Recon plunges into K-Bay

The Reconnaissance Platoon from the 13th Marine Expeditionary Unit (Special Operations Capable), plunged into the Kaneohe Bay Waterfront Operations training area that 4th Force Reconnaissance Co. uses, Dec. 9.

"The set-up that 4th Force has, has conditions far superior to those we have in Camp Pendleton," said Capt. Travis Homiak, fourth platoon commander with Recon platoon, Battalion Landing Team, 2nd Battalion, 1st

Marine Regiment, 13th MEU(SOC). "It also gets Marines in a different training environment to keep the training interesting."

The platoon trained using the Drager Lar 5 closed-circuit diving underwater breathing apparatus.

"Training with this piece of equipment is important because it's a perishable skill," Homiak said.

The difference between this diving system and conventional open-circuit breathing devices is that the Lar 5 "recycles" the carbon dioxide to make fresh oxygen for the diver.

said Staff Sgt. Kevin Hoyt, platoon sergeant.

"This apparatus is the most clandestine means we have to move into bays and beaches," Hoyt said. "The system allows a Marine to move through the water undetected because no bubbles are made since no air leaves it."

"The system is great for infiltrating an area or insertion for sabotage missions," Homiak said. "When Marines use the system correctly, there's no trace of them being there."





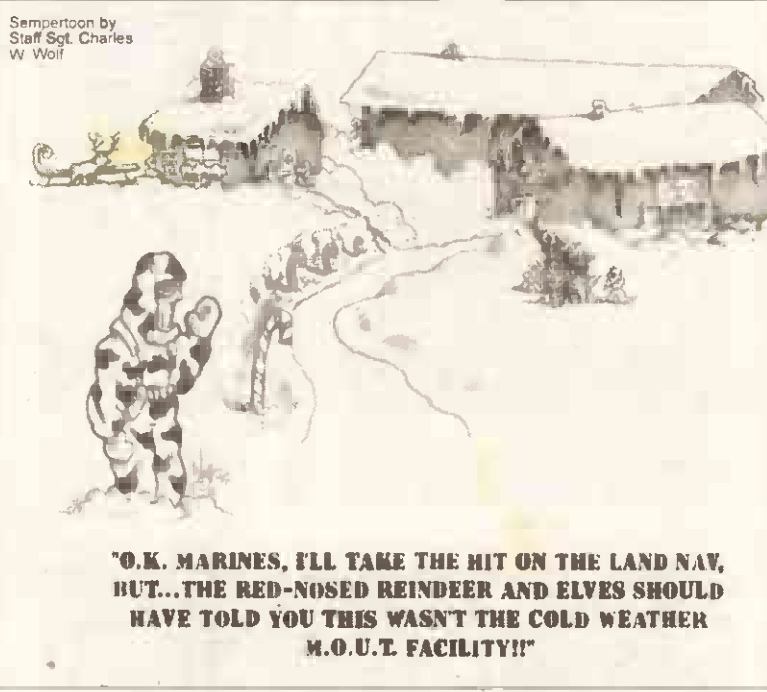

# Scouts learn rifle safety

A group of 30 boys from seven Boy Scout troops on Windward Oahu spent Saturday morning learning firearm safety and firing various rifles and shotguns at the range here.

Members of the Army National Guard, Kaneohe Bay Rod and Gun Club and Honolulu Police Department joined the Scouts and Marine Corps range officials to help teach the boys, ages 14-18, safety precautions and procedures.

"Every young man should know how to shoot a firearm," said Wallace Heyer, assistant district commissioner for the Koolau District of the Boy Scouts. "We teach the boys safety and good sportsmanship so that they learn to treat weapons properly. Most accidents occur when shooters haven't been trained correctly."

The Scouts fired .22 rimfire rifles, AR-15 Special Weapons and Tactics rifles and 12 gauge shotguns at "turkey" shapes on their targets during their training. The top shooters were awarded prizes.

"The younger people listen very well and ask questions," said Staff Sgt. Nathan Bell, pistol line staff noncommissioned officer in

charge at the range. "They're eager to take in the instruction because this is fun for them."

"Teaching anyone respect for guns is important," Bell added. "If you get them young enough, safe habits will come out."

The Boy Scout members were eager to learn and appreciated the teaching style of the instructors.

"This has been fun," said Douglas Guptill, a Scout from Troop 238 in Kailua. "I hate when teachers take a long time to finish the class. These instructors get to the point so we can shoot."

"This was the first time I've shot these weapons," said Josh Lindo, a Scout with Troop 16 in Laie. "Firing the guns was the best part, so I didn't care about whether or not I won prizes."

The instructors matched the teenagers in enthusiasm, recognizing the importance of keeping the lessons fun while emphasizing the safety aspects.

"It's important to give these boys something they enjoy to do while they are learning," said Honolulu Police Department Sgt. Edwin Massey, from the Kailua Police Station patrol division, who said he volunteers a lot of time with the Boy Scouts.

"Target shooting is a safe, fun sport when done properly," said Jeff Lefebvre, a new member of the K-Bay Rod and Gun Club. "I think this is a great chance to show good sportsmanship and shooting ethics to the boys. Volunteering here is absolutely time well spent."

The event participants were grateful for the support of the range and the Marine Corps base in general.

"We use military facilities often with the Scouts," Massey said.

"We've had nothing but excellent support from the military, primarily from the Marines, which is ideal for the kids on this side of the island."

"This is the fourth time we've held the event here and the range officer and personnel have been very helpful the whole time," Heyer said.

Heyer said that in addition to the volunteers giving their time, the ammunition, transportation and prizes for the shoot were donated, so the event didn't cost the Boy Scouts anything.

While the Boy Scouts were awarded gift certificates and other prizes for high scores, the competition was secondary to learning safety in handling firearms.

# Active Reserves option for Marines

*Reserves offers some Marines best of both worlds*

When Marines near the end of their enlistments, they usually see three options — re-enlist, join a reserve program, or leave the Marine Corps altogether.

Marines who leave active duty after finishing their first term of enlistment, however, must fulfill their eight-year contract with the Corps.

There are several programs under which leathernecks can fulfill this obligation — some of these programs give Marines an opportunity to work with a unit close to their hometowns.

But where can they go to embark upon such programs?

The Marine Forces Reserve Transitional Site in building 218 here offers answers to Marines' concerns regarding reserve transition.

"My job is to take active-duty Marines and put them in the reserves," said Gunnery Sgt. William R. Foster, the base transitional recruiter.

There are two major reserve

programs Marines can enlist under, Foster said.

"The first is the Active Reserve program," Foster said. "These Marines work seven days a week just like regular Marines."

What sets Active Reserve Marines apart from regular active-duty Marines, is that they don't usually deploy, said Foster.

"They have all the same benefits as active-duty Marines, though," Foster said.

"The second is the Selected Marine Corps Reserve program," he said. "Under SMCR, Marines join a unit close to their hometown and train within their Military Occupational Specialty one weekend a month and two weeks (straight) per year."

"Reserve programs like these improve MOS credibility in the sense that these Marines may stay with their units for a long time," he said. "Even though they see and work with one another only once a month, they all know how the others think. This makes them a stronger, more efficient unit."

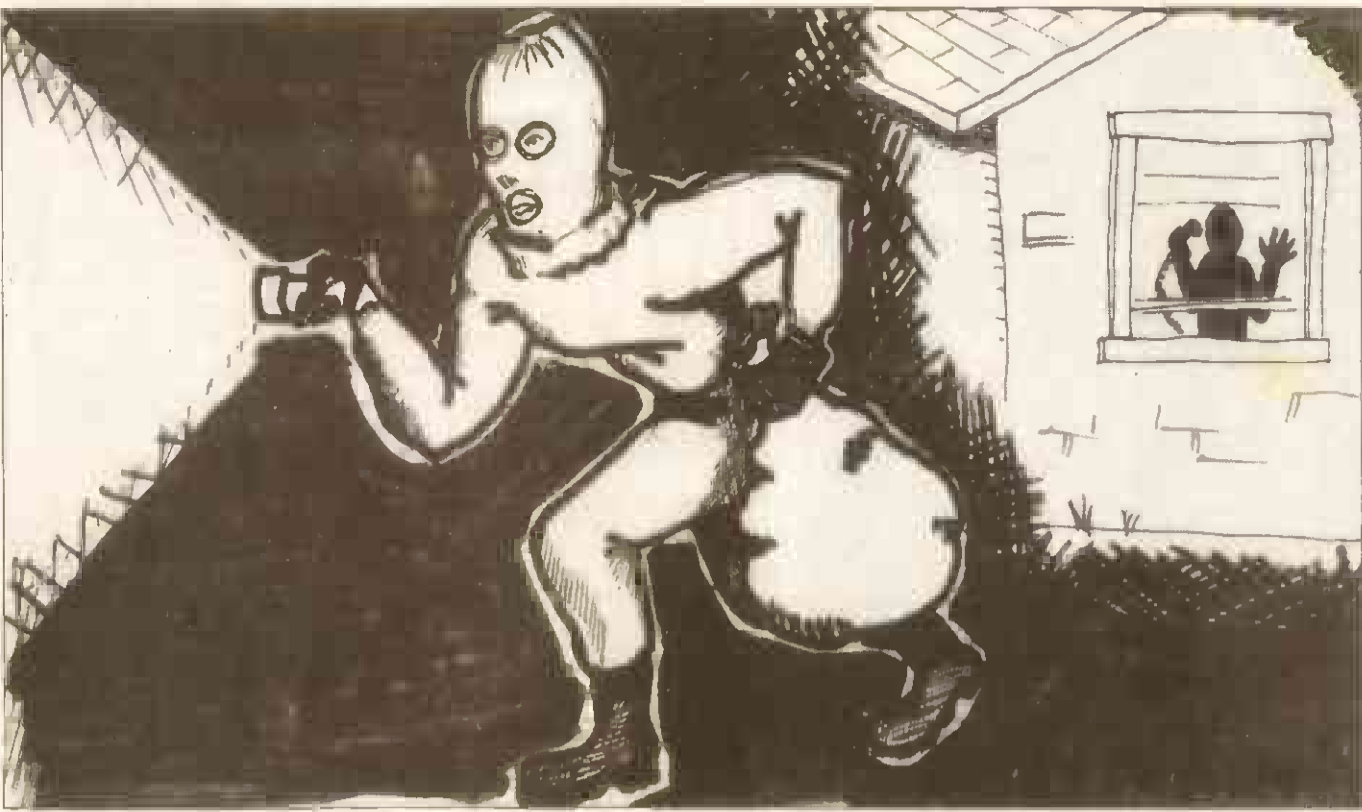

## MPD encourages neighborhood watch

To make family living in base housing safer, the Military Police Department here is asking residents to organize neighborhood watch programs in different residential areas.

These watch programs already exist in areas such as Hilltop Housing and on English, Phillips and Irwin Streets here, according to Sgt. Stephen Smith, the noncommissioned officer in-charge of the Crime Prevention Section at MPD.

"These programs are great because they create community awareness and community involvement," said Smith. "These can't exist without each other. You can be aware, but what good will it do you if you're not involved. You can also be involved, but what good does it do you to not be aware of what's going on?"

"You've just got to do it the old-fashioned way," said Smith. "Knock on doors and talk to people to get them involved."

Once a group decides to form a watch, this is what they should do:

- \* Contact MPD's Crime Prevention Section for training in home security and reporting skills.

- \* Select a coordinator or block captain.

- \* Captains should be aware of new residents and make efforts to involve working parents, elderly and neighborhood youth.

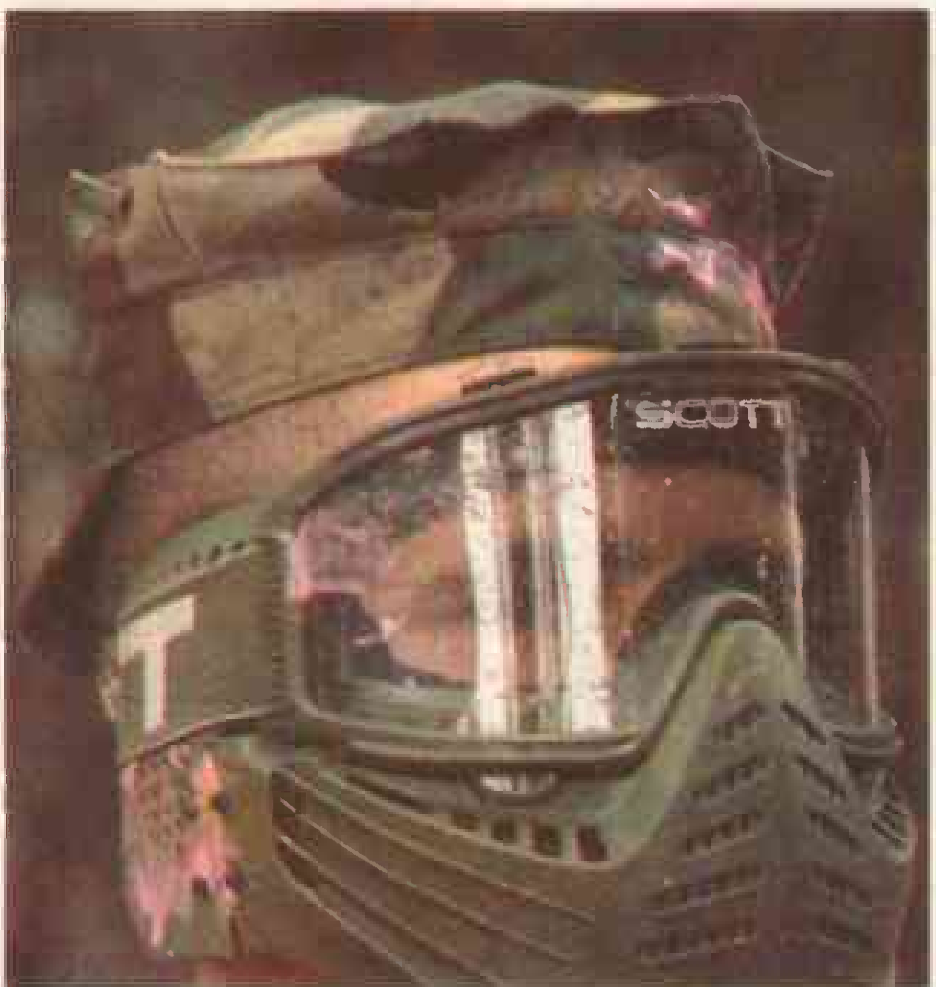

## H&S Co. battles at Bellows

**B**ELLOWS AIR FORCE STATION — Headquarters and Service Company, 1st Radio Battalion, brushed up on various battle skills at the paintball field here Dec. 9.

The squad leader training allowed the Marines to practice skills taught earlier in the week on subjects such as field medicine, cover and concealment.

The course was negotiated by two squads at a time, one to defend a firebase and act as aggressors, the other to overrun and secure the firebase deep within hostile territory.

The paintball field, with its various shack-like structures, added a certain sense of realism for the Marines, according to Cpl. Joshua Pitts, one of H&S Co.'s training noncommissioned officers.

To add to the realism, once Marines got shot, they would be evaluated on the spot to see if the wound would put them out of action. If Marines were hit in the torso or head, they would be removed from the fight, according to Rodney Neill, manager and tactical advisor, of Island Paintball Sports Inc.

Each squad had a corpsman to tend to the wounds, according to Neill.

"This is good because the corpsman could actually see the wound," added Neill,

who was once a Marine.

Most the Marines agreed that paintball is the most realistic training available today, according to Sgt. David Balla, electronic maintenance platoon sergeant.

"This really is good for the Marines because of the rounds flying around them," Pitts said. "You don't get that with blanks or MILES gear. Here when you get shot, you actually know where and from which direction you were hit."

The Marines' reflexes may also have benefitted due to the gun fire, according to Pitts. "The paintballs hurt a little so it forces you to react better," he said.

## IMAX looms large

**W**AIKIKI — Most servicemembers in Hawaii, spend their time doing two things outside of work: trying to see everything on Oahu and talking about visiting other Hawaiian Islands.

Aside from occasional trips to Pohakuloa Training Area on the Big Island, most Marines never see the other islands.

One place most servicemembers do see a lot of, Waikiki, is the home of one of Oahu's only gateways to all the islands without actually leaving here. That gateway is IMAX Theater.

Dubbed as "the next best thing to being there," IMAX motion pictures are shown on a screen five stories tall and more than 70-foot wide. Films such as "Hidden Hawaii," "Ring of Fire" and "Whales" take guests from the majestic sea cliffs of Molokai to the fiery rivers of rock flowing from the Big Island's Mount Kilauca.

"Most servicemembers want to vacation to the other islands, but when they do take vacations, they usually spend that time to go

back to the mainland," said Kimo Collins, manager at IMAX Waikiki. "With IMAX, they can see these places without leaving their seats."

IMAX, which stands for image maximization, doesn't just provide an intense visual experience. Its six-channel digital surround sound system allows guests to hear the action clear as a bell — and feel it. With 44 speakers placed perfectly to saturate the theater with sound, it makes what's on the screen even more lifelike.

Tickets for IMAX presentation can be purchased at MCB Hawaii's IIT Office and are discounted for military members. If the tickets aren't bought at IIT, military discounts are given at IMAX box offices here. Just ask.

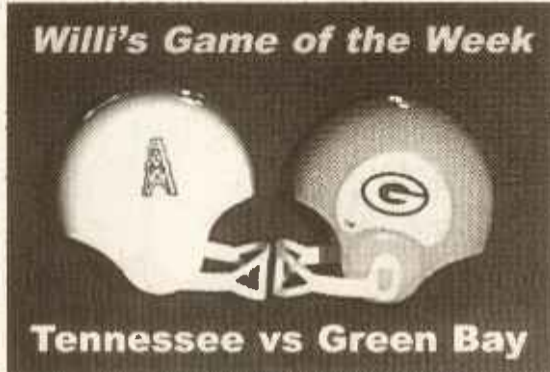
Even the return of instant replay couldn't have made this weekend look any better than a pee-wee football game. Fumbles, interceptions and surprise wins were abundant.

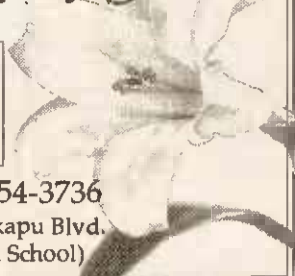

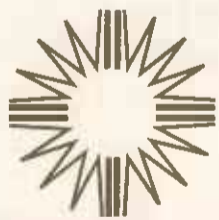

**D**ance students, ages three and older, performed a dance recital at the base theater here Saturday.

The recital, choreographed by the teachers, was performed entirely by the dancers. The presentation showcased 17 performances of various dance forms and began with a solo ballet performance.

The dancers are students of a little-known school here, the Dance Movement Academy, which teaches jazz, ballet, tap, and more modern "hip-hop" dances.

Saturday's recital was, for most students, the first time ever performing in front of an audience, according to Di Rodin, instructor at

the Academy.

"The recital allows the kids to show their work," Rodin said. "We chose to do recitals because there's more effort put in when you have to present your work."

"It's somewhat of an accomplishment to be in front of people and be able to do this," said Sharon Hughes, an adult student with the class, who also said she is fulfilling a childhood dream of dancing. "I always wanted to do this, but I never did."

Although many people may not know about the Academy, students have been tearing up the dance floor since the Academy's opening here two years ago and have held recitals at Pearl Ridge Mall, Aloha Tower and Bay Fest, Rodin said.

Classes range from 6-8 students in size, but even with such a small class, teaching can become hard, according to Rodin, who said she gives each student individual attention while teaching.

"It is so challenging to teach because no one stays (on island) and the students have such a diverse background," Rodin said. "But I guess that's how the military is, you know?"

But Rodin's love of her art shines through in her enthusiasm, and can easily be seen when she speaks of her students.

"I'm very proud of them," Rodin said. "Don't expect a professional performance. They will mess up because they are nervous, but I'm so very proud."

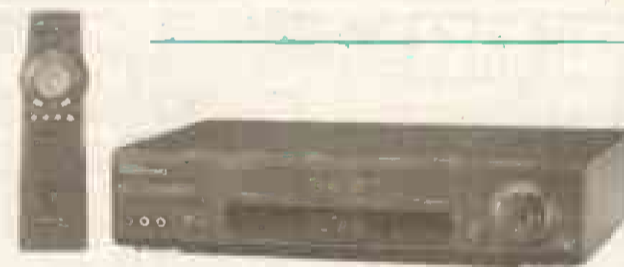

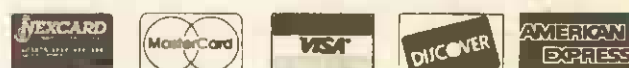
