

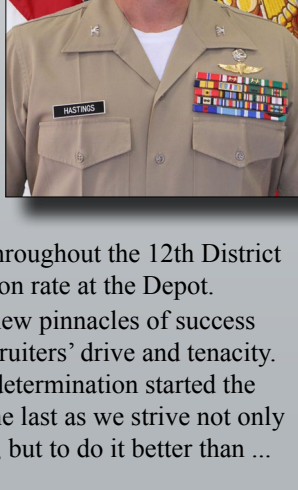

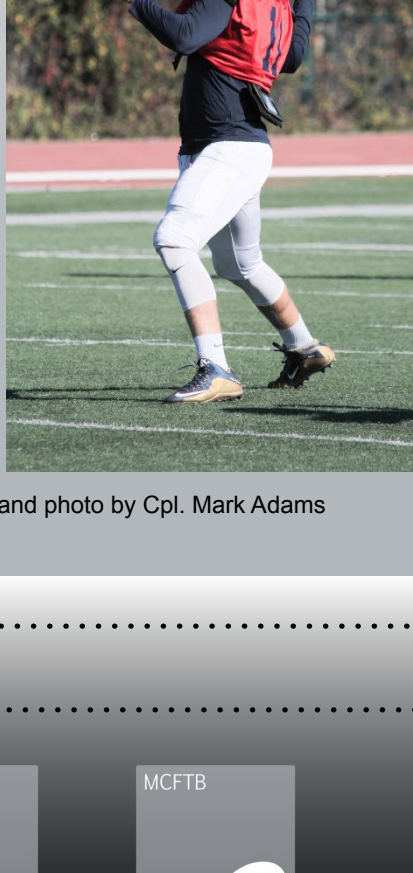


All-American Quarterback Volunteers in Community
