


CAMP SHELBY ESTABLISHED War Department awarded Hattiesburg National Army Camp. 50,000 troops trained from 1917-1920.





NATIONAL GUARD TRAINING Base closed in 1920 and reopened in 1924 for NG training exercises until 1940, including Third Army and the 37th & 38th Infantry Divisions.









NATIONAL GUARD CONTROL MS gained control after WWII. Trained troops for Vietnam & Desert Storm. Annually trained 100,000 through late 1990s.











CENTENNIAL ANNIVERSARY Camp Shelby has trained and mobilized over 1 million troops in all conflicts, but the Korean War, since its establishment in 1917.
