## 'Dagger' brigade Soldier dies at Milford Lake

FORT RILEY, Kan. – A 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division Soldier died June 11 at Milford Lake near Milford, Kansas.

Spc. Xavier Harden, a food service specialist with Forward Support Company D, 5<sup>th</sup> Squadron, 4<sup>th</sup> Cavalry Regiment, 2<sup>nd</sup> Armored Brigade Combat Team, 1<sup>st</sup> Inf. Div., entered the lake from a boat at about 2:30 p.m. and did not resurface. His body was recovered at 5:25 p.m.

Dave Maxwell, commander of 5<sup>th</sup> Sqdn., 4<sup>th</sup> Cav. Regt. "We are supporting and will continue to support Xavier's family through this difficult time."

Harden arrived at Fort Riley in June 2016. He was 23 years old.

"This is a tragic loss for the entire 'Longknife' family," said Lt. Col.

His home of record is Tolleson, Arizona. His awards include the Army Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal and the Army Service Ribbon.

The incident remains under investigation.
