

### **OUR LEGACY**





While 1,200 10th Mountain Division (LI) Soldiers were embroiled in Operation Desert Shield/Storm. those that remained at Fort Drum continued their training. Unlike previous assignments, the division's next mission would have it helping with a disaster brewed by mother nature rather than humans. At 5:00 a.m. August 24 1992, Hurricane Andrew, a category four storm that amassed 175 mile-per-hour winds, slammed into southern Florida. Thirteen people lost their lives, 250,000 homes were destroyed, and damages were estimated at \$20 billion. On August 29, Soldiers from the 1st Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division were sent to the storm-ravaged area in southern Florida, with additional troops following. Six-thousand 10th Mountain Soldiers distributed muchneeded food, ice, water, clothing, medical necessities and building supplies to those who had been displaced.



Providing emergency repairs to homes, setting up tent cities, and clearing debris were three other valuable services performed by division personnel. Most importantly, the division coordinated all disaster relief and humanitarian assistance with both government and non-government entities until civilian relief organizations were in a position to coordinate aid for those afflicted. By mid-October, all 10th Mountain Division Soldiers had returned to Fort Drum. Hurricane Andrew was the first realworld test for the division, and it had learned many lessons that would become valuable in the near future.

### HELOCAST AT SACKETS HARBOR

Helocasting is an airborne technique used to insert a small amount forces into an area of operations. The small unit is flown by helicopter above a body of water that is used as an insertion point. Once there, the aircraft assumes an altitude just above the water's surface and maintains a slow airspeed. Team members then exit the aircraft, enter the water and swim to shore.



## LFS RIFLE MARKSMANSHIP INSTRUCTOR COURSE


