The Way Ahead...

The Army National Guard's only Security Force Assistance Brigade, which will be headquartered in Indianapolis, is recruiting soldiers in traditional and full-time Guard positions.

INCENTIVES

- * \$5,000 one-time only Assignment Incentive Pay for enlisted soldiers
- * Special Duty Assignment Pay level one for all soldiers assigned to the SFAB
- * Possible additional SDAP based on your MOS
- * Additional Skill Identifier opportunities
- * Additional schools and training opportunities
- * Broadening assignment within your career field

REQUIREMENTS

- * You must have a minimum of 240 on your APFT with a minimum of 70 in each event
- * Currently possess a secret security clearance and maintain it
- * Have a PULHES of 111221 or better
- * Key Leaders must have completed key developmental assignment in their current grade
- * Pass a background screening with no derogatory information

VOLUNTEER

- * Complete a 4187 and make sure it is signed by the first O5 in your chain of command
- * Attach your last DA 705 and DA 5500, if needed, and last three years of NCOERS
