The UH-60V is not a newly built aircraft, but is a modification of existing UH-60L or "Lima" Black Hawks with a "digital" cockpit. It replaces the analog displays and systems with digital multifunction displays. It is nearly identical to the UH-60M, which are newly built Black Hawks.
