DIESEL RESTRICTIONS IN BELGIUM AND THE NETHERLANDS, BANS IN GERMANY

Many capitals in Europe will probably ban diesel between 2024 and 2030. At the moment, there is no diesel ban in Belgium and The Netherlands, but there are some restrictions. In Belgium, Brussels has instituted a low emission zone, or LEZ, since Jan. 1, 2018. In The Netherlands, the reduction of air pollution has been a priority for years. Currently, Germany is the only country worldwide with diesel bans. The city of Stuttgart, for example, has already banned diesel cars with the emission standard 4/IV and lower. [\[READ MORE\]](#)
