The World War II-era U.S. flag belonging to 10th Mountain Division Artillery has not been displayed at its headquarters since the unit deactivated in 2004. Now, the colors are back home at Fort Drum. During the DIVARTY WWII Colors ceremony Jan. 22 at the Commons, retired Maj. Chuck Thompson, former DIVARTY personnel officer, returned the flag back to his unit and explained how it came into his possession. Thompson recalled that, once deactivated, everything related to DIVARTY was quickly packed and moved out of the headquarters so that the newly activated 3rd Brigade Combat Team could move into the building. He was designated as administrative commander, and he said that most of the unit's symbolic items were shipped to the Institute of Heraldry. However, the flag was returned to him.
