GOT YOUR BACK TRAINING TO BE HELD APRIL 23-24

On April 23 and 24, there will be GOT YOUR BACK training, which is an interactive conversation that integrates the research on sexual predation and bystander intervention into a discussion about sexual violence. The training addresses how sexualized language, and a tolerance for coercive cultural norms contribute to an environment that allows perpetrators to offend against both female and male victims, and avoid accountability. Training will be held:
