1945: PFC Thomas Atkins awarded CMH Luzon, Philippines.

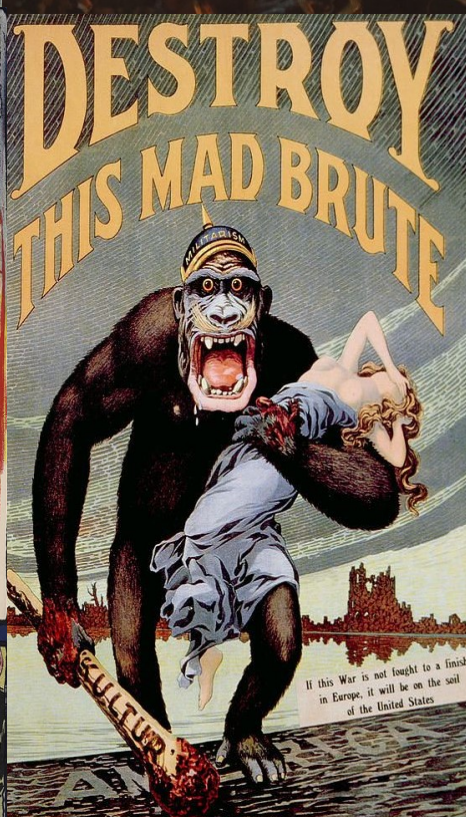
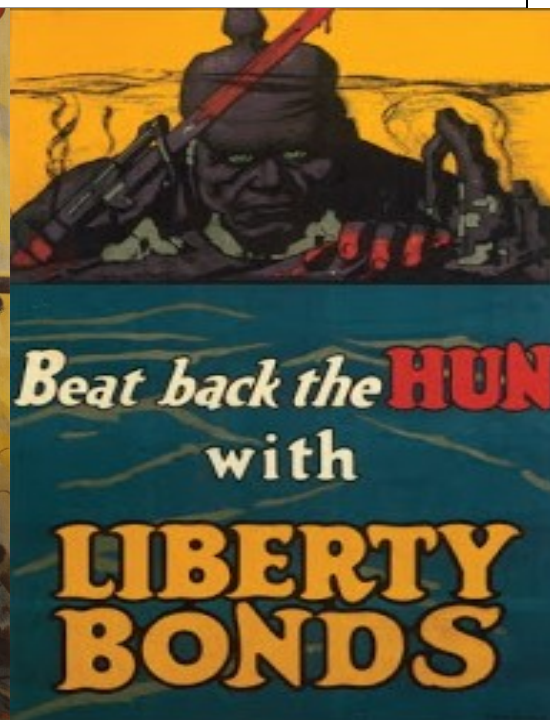
1951: Operation Ripper launched by United Nation Forces.
