# ACC-RI's LOGCAP contracts support for COVID-19 response

ROCK ISLAND ARSENAL, III. — Adjusting to a new normal while supporting the Army's COVID-19 requirements has been a challenging but very rewarding experience for two Army Contracting Command-Rock Island employees assigned to the Logistics and Civil Augmentation Program (LOGCAP) IV mission.

Lindsay Weindruch, procuring contracting officer, and Serina Allingham, contract specialist, have been working hard – from their telework sites at home – to support five current requirements.

Specifically, they are handling quarantine sites at Fort Bragg and Fort Bliss, where Soldiers and civilians returning from theater are isolated for 14 days. They are also supporting a U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command (TRADOC) requirement providing overflow housing for displaced Soldiers at Fort Benning and Fort Lee.
