NAVEUR-AF military postal service (MPS) customer,

The region's military postal offices have recently seen an increase in customers attempting to mail humanitarian relief supplies using their personal mailing addresses.

Please be advised that military post offices **will not accept or deliver materials** donated for humanitarian aid purposes.

This is because mailing donations via the MPS is prohibited per the Military Postal Service Agency's Military Postal Manual.

Instead of sending humanitarian relief items via MPS, donations can be made through the humanitarian relief agencies of your choice.
