The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has paved the way in complex construction environments for almost a century. Shortly before World War II, Congress and the War Department approved the transfer of military construction responsibilities from an overtaxed Quartermaster Corps to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.



Today, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Transatlantic Division continues its legacy through its two districts, the Transatlantic Middle East District, headquartered in Virginia, and the Transatlantic Expeditionary District, which combined the Division's contingency operations assets as one optimized command, headquartered in Kuwait.




