CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURES

Bldg. 1997/Aeon Gate Bike Racks:

One-way road near Aeon Gate, behind Bldg. 1997 closed until Oct. 12, to replace bicycle racks at Aeon Gate.

Bldg. 4300 (CDC) Painting

Until Oct. 28, the exterior will be painted on weekends. Some parking stalls will be used for equipment storage during the week.

Replace Steam Piping: Partial road and parking closure on Fechteler Road (day work) and partial road closure on Rickert Drive (night work) until Nov. 7.

NEX Parking Lot Repaving:

Until Nov. 8, phased closures of the NEX parking lots will take place for new paving and painting of the lots.

Ikego Club Takemiya

Closed for construction until Nov. 30.

Building C21, Command Hill:

Parking will be reduced during the demolition and reconstruction of Building C21 until March 2019.

October's community briefings on completing Emergency Evacuation Program Packages (EEP) are canceled. EEP packet bi-weekly briefings will resume Nov. 2.

I.C.E. COMMENT

Interactive Customer Evaluation (I.C.E.) allows DOD customers to rate products and services provided by DOD offices and facilities worldwide. Your comments and input are used to improve the products and services available to you.

Comment: I have heard that the Housing Office will no longer supply off-base residents with appliances such as washer, dryers, dehumidifiers, or refrigerators. Is this true? Will we receive more money to purchase these items out in town?

Response: Unfortunately, this year the CFAY Housing Office has ran out of dehumidifiers to issue, and

new residents needing them were placed on a waiting list. Everyone on that waiting list will receive dehumidifiers as soon a large shipment of dehumidifiers on order arrives. The CFAY Housing Office continues to provide appliances - specifically a refrigerator, four-burner gas stove, washer, dryer, conventional microwave oven and transformer - to off-base residents for free

if their landlords do not do so. There is currently no plan for the Housing Office to cease providing these loaner appliances.
