Big Red One starts Danger Ready 2

FORT RILEY, Kansas – Soldiers of the 1st Infantry Division began the initial stages of Danger Ready 2, part of an ongoing series of exercises designed to prepare Soldiers for the culminating multinational Warfighter exercise, on Fort Riley, Kansas, Oct. 23, 2023.

Elements belonging to the 1st Inf. Div.'s Headquarters and Headquarters Battalion, Sustainment Brigade, Signal Company and Division Artillery, conducted preliminary systems checks in anticipation of the exercise start.

Over the next ten days, the exercise will include multiple movements to test the unit's ability to break down and rebuild training sites all while

partaking in a simulated combat scenario.





Getting Started

FORT RILEY, Kansas – After headquarters elements relocated to a hanger at Marshall Airfield, Operations at Danger Ready 2 continued on Fort Riley, Kansas, Oct. 25, 2023.

Under the quiet hum of the generators on site, information technology specialists, military intelligence professionals, geospatial imagery analyzers, alongside fire and logistics support officers constructed a network of advanced warfighting capabilities.

Elements from across the 1st Inf. Div. worked in tandem with one another to enhance the capabilities of the division.

“Combat readiness for the Soldiers has improved because now they have an actual scope of what LSCO, which is large scale combat operations, look like,” said Sgt. 1st Class Tyler Robinson, a senior movements noncommissioned officer assigned to the 1st Inf. Div. Sustainment Brigade,

1st Inf. Div. “So now they’re able to plane and get themselves ready for when that day comes when they have to go overseas or whatever location that we need to go to.”

The series of Danger Ready exercises, a preparation for the upcoming Warfighter exercise, were developed to engage Soldiers of the 1st Inf. Div. in a real time combat simulation which focuses on perfecting the art of synchronizing time and space in a hostile environment where large forces are engaged with one another.

The training events will continue to build upon one another as the division implements more sophisticated orders of operation.
