The boards will consider TAR and SELRES Sailors. Mobilized Individual Ready Reserve personnel are considered under the SELRES requirements for advancement.

Additionally, the Senior Enlisted Marketplace (SEM) policy which was initially announced for E-9s has expanded to include eligible AC candidates for E-8.

- Talks to your rating detailer
- Requests release for special program recruiting duty
- Tell detailer where you want to go recruiting



2 RELEASE APPROVED

- Detailer approves release request
- Negotiate orders to a Navy Talent Acquisition Group (NTAG)



3 APPLICATION

- Detailer sends application info
- Sailor submits the recruiting screening and special duty forms



4 SCREENING

Screened by command and found fit for NTAG



5 ORDERS

Orders to Navy Recruiting Orientation Unit (NORU) and a report date to an NTAG



NAVY OFFICE OF SPECIAL TRIAL COUNSEL

As of Dec. 27, 2023, the Navy's new Office of Special Trial Counsel (OSTC) is fully operational. OSTC is a worldwide prosecution organization that handles legal cases involving serious personal violence, including sexual assault. It is staffed by Special Trial Counsel – expert, specialized, and independent attorneys – who decide whether those cases go to court-martial and then prosecute them. The establishment of OSTC, as well as implementation of other military justice reforms, will support fairness for all Sailors.
