PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENTS

18



- Executive Order 14063, Use of Project Labor Agreements on DoD Construction Projects
 - Requires PLAs for large-scale, \$35 million or more, Federal construction projects
 - The rule will help ensure that large Federal construction projects are completed efficiently and on-time, while also supporting high quality jobs
 - Limited exceptions will be granted and must be approved by the Senior Procurement Executive
 - Effective date on or about 22 January 2024




ENERGY RESILIENCE CONSERVATION INVESTMENT PROGRAM (ERCIP)










Floodwall Butressing

Metro Louisville Flood Protection System


