# MAYPORT RECEPTION

**G**eorge Washington made its first port visit during Southern Seas 2024 in Mayport, Florida, April 29. This port call was the first stop for George Washington as the ship circumnavigates South America on its journey to Yokosuka, Japan.

During George Washington's first week at sea, air department and embarked squadrons with Carrier Air Wing (CVW) 7 began cyclic operations, launching and recovering aircraft on the flight deck. These evolutions improve the ship's proficiency and mission readiness.

While pierside in Naval Station Mayport, Rear Adm. James A. Aiken, commander, U.S. Naval Forces Southern Command/U.S. 4th Fleet, hosted a formal ceremony aboard the ship where he welcomed local community leaders and distinguished guests to celebrate the Southern Seas 2024 deployment. He spoke on the significance of this deployment and its purpose of building friendships and partnerships within the 4th Fleet area of responsibility.

"It's the opportunity to be able to operate at sea with partners and allies," said Aiken. "We're going to build on the partnerships we've developed over so many years."








