## [Soldiers and Civilians of 114th SIG BN Hold a Golf Scramble](#)

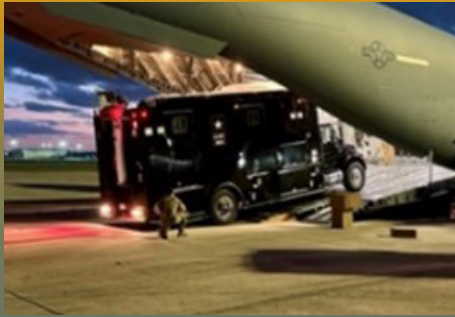
