The goal of Platoon Leaders Course (PLC) is to:

- 1) Prepare candidates for a paid summer internship at Marine Corps Officer Candidate School (OCS) in Quantico, VA.
- 2) Provide a job offer as a Marine Corps Officer upon completion of OCS and earning a bachelor's degree.



- Full-time and part-time opportunities (Active or Reserves)
- **Guaranteed** Pilot and Law routes



- 6-week or 10-week summer program
- Candidates receive competitive pay
- Room & board and travel expenses covered as well



- Tuition assistance available after completing training during college
- Commissioned officers are eligible for full-tuition coverage for post-secondary education
