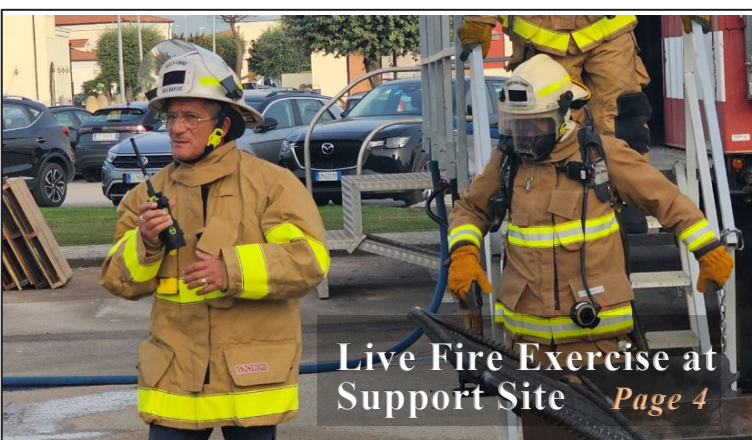

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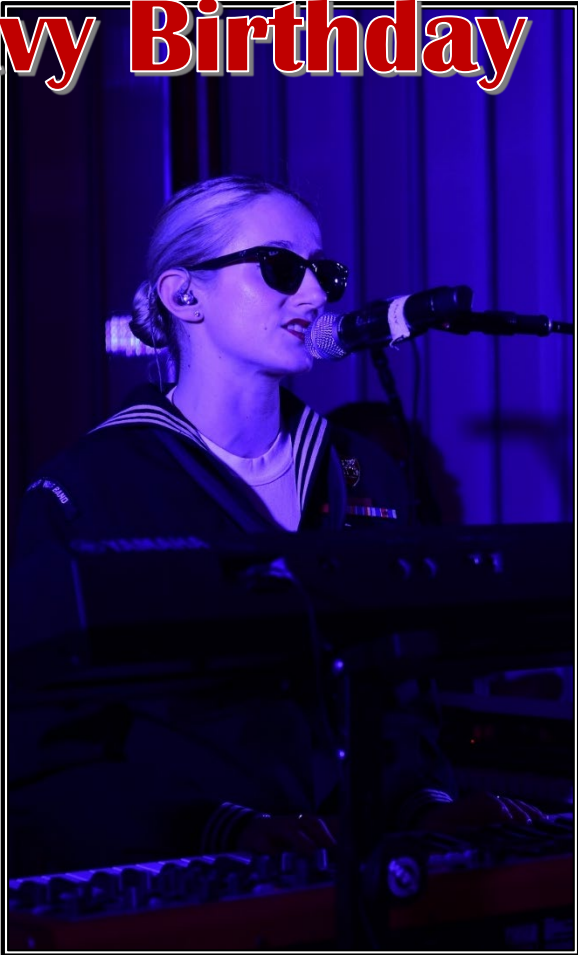
Naples Area Fêtes 249th Navy Birthday

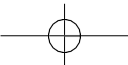

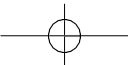

Off-Base Housing:

Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments Only

Electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around to pay a deposit.

NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic payments for all security deposit transactions for off-base housing. This change will affect tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel concerned paid security deposits in cash at the time of lease signing. However, Since June 2024, this cash payment requirement was discontinued for new tenant personnel. All security deposits are now paid to the landlord electronically. This change ensures that personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at any other U.S. or oversea base.

Electronic payments removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. It is more secure than carrying cash around and more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash.

Furthermore, electronic payment will reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs. It is the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other oversea station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

Starting in Fall 2024, NSA Naples housing began the process of returning all security deposits paid in cash back to tenant personnel with leases signed prior to 10 June 2024. This process is anticipated to occur over the next 9-12 months starting with the most recent lease agreements on file. To complete this process, each tenant personnel concerned will be required to sign three documents:

An acknowledgement (if applicable) that they currently reside in an area designated by Italian authorities as a Campi Flegrei “Red or Yellow Zone.”

A lease amendment which modifies the “Security Deposit” and “Arbitration” clauses.

An acknowledgement that their security deposit is currently held in the GSF and that it will be returned to them electronically. They will also acknowledge to provide the returned security deposit to their landlord electronically within five (5) days of signing the lease amendment.

The housing office will be contacting personnel concerned and their landlords to obtain the signed acknowledgement letters and lease amendments. Failure to properly fill-out and sign all three documents, and/or provide the security deposit to the landlord may result in the termination of the lease agreement and possible legal action taken against the individual by their landlord.


Although this maybe an arduous undertaking by tenant personnel concerned, their landlords and the installation, the benefits of going electronic should encourage all parties to work methodically together to ensure a smooth transition.

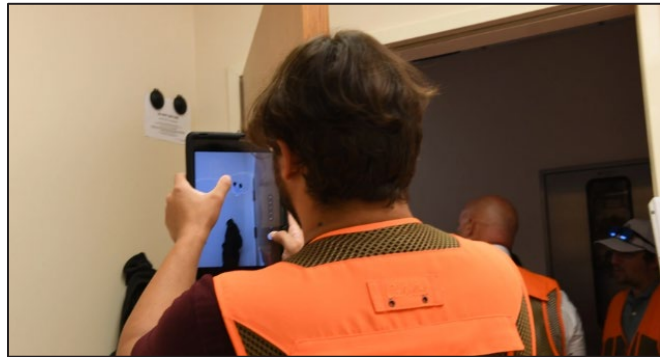
The housing office will contact all concerned to **sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process** and go electronic.

Radon Management at Naval Support Activity Naples

NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled facilities.

NSA Naples is currently conducting radon testing as part of the NAVRAMP. Radon measurement devices were deployed from 5-23 August 2024 by qualified environmental contractors in non-residential rooms and buildings and unaccompanied residences across the installation.

To ensure accurate testing results, DO NOT remove, disturb, or cover the devices during the testing period. It will take approximately 15 months to collect and process the survey data (around November 2025). NSA Naples will notify the community once results are received and it will be posted on the installation’ official website.

What If Testing Reveals My Office Space/Residence has Elevated Radon Levels?

The health and safety of all is top priority. If the radon testing identifies elevated radon levels at any actionable level in your space or residence, the installation will immediately notify tenants. Although radon exposure is the second-leading environmental cause of lung cancer death (after tobacco smoke), the benefit of screening for lung cancer has not been established. Currently no effective, community-wide medical screening tests are recommended for the medical prevention or early diagnosis and treatment of radon induced lung cancer.

The U.S. Preventive Task Force Services does now recommend annual low dose chest CT scanning in asymptomatic adults aged 50-80 who have a long smoking history regardless of any radon exposure. If you ever received notification that your home or office space had elevated levels of radon above the EPA and Navy action level (4 picocuries per liter [4 pCi/L] or higher), or have health concerns about exposure to radon, please contact your medical provider.

Current Situation of Radon Management for On-Base Housing, Government Owned/Controlled Units
NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program. That is, they are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested like in the case of non-residential rooms, buildings and unaccompanied residences stated above.

Current Situation of Radon Management for Off-Base Housing
Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense. The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

RPC1 Explained!
As mentioned earlier, NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 in accordance with the NAVRAMP.

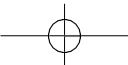
Does RPC1 means all buildings at NSA Naples have high radon levels?
No. RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L). During the last radon testing (2022-2023) which focused on residential buildings owned or leased by the Navy, radon was detected at concentrations over 4.0 pCi/L in four (4) out of 291 units tested. Note that the RPC1 classification is not related to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA).

The EPA and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) state there is no safe minimum level of radon exposure, however at 4.0 pCi/L they recommend mitigation. The NAVRAMP takes that recommendation a step further, requiring that Naval installations implement and complete mitigation measures within a two-year timeframe for levels between 4 and 20 pCi/L. It is important to understand that radon levels can fluctuate over time and with changes in the environment and the building itself.

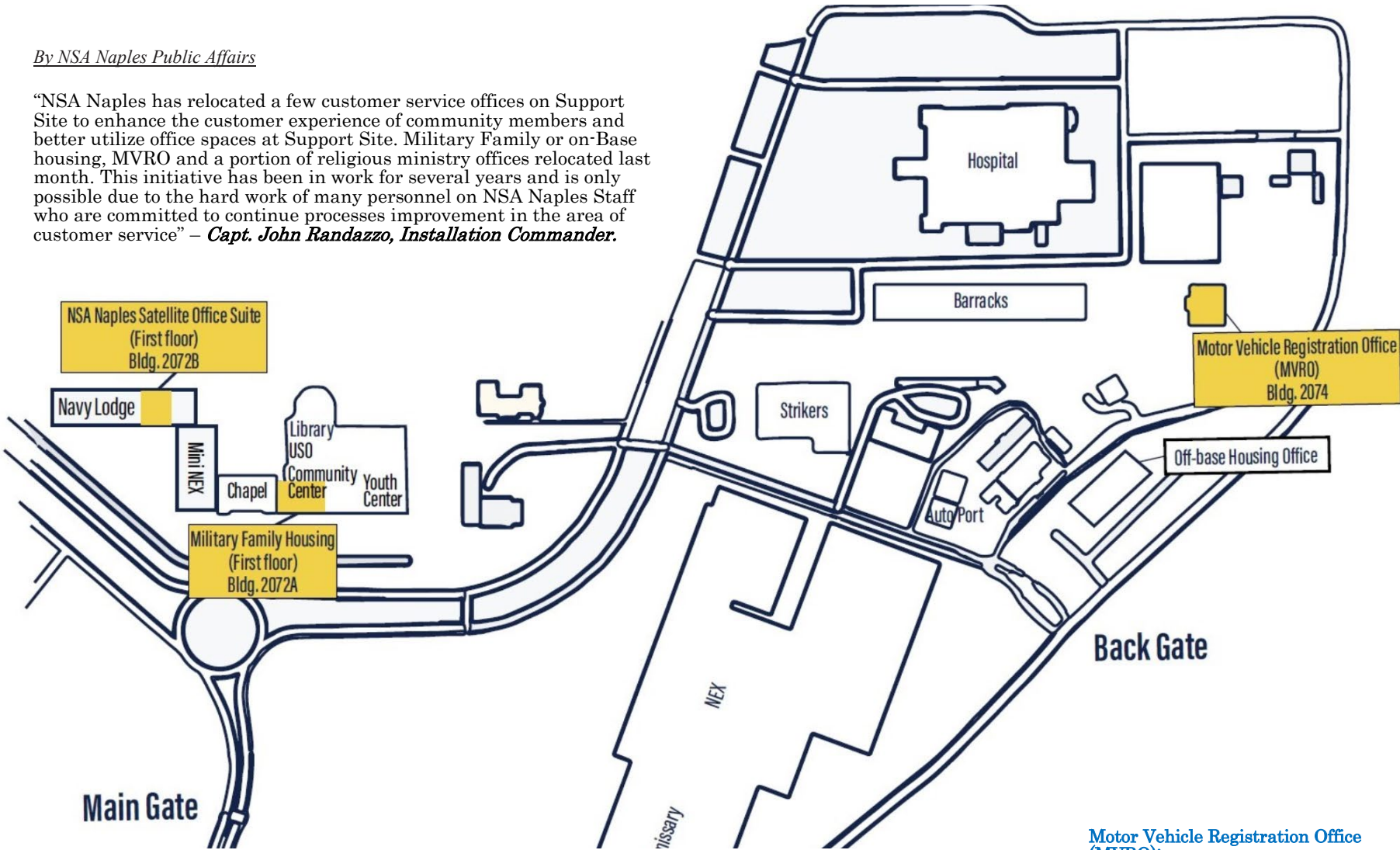
Enhancing Customer Service Experience

Base Housing, MVRO, Others Relocate Offices

This initiative has been in work for several years and is only possible due to the hard work of many personnel on NSA Naples Staff who are committed to continue processes improvement in the area of customer service.

“NSA Naples has relocated a few customer service offices on Support Site to enhance the customer experience of community members and better utilize office spaces at Support Site. Military Family or on-Base housing, MVRO and a portion of religious ministry offices relocated last month. This initiative has been in work for several years and is only possible due to the hard work of many personnel on NSA Naples Staff who are committed to continue processes improvement in the area of customer service” – **Capt. Military Family Housing:

Effective October 8, 2024, the On-Base Housing Office moved to the 1st floor above the Community Center on Support Site Village Forum (building 2072). This is a more centralized location with better facilities that allow our housing counselors to sit down with residents in an office and discuss their needs. New check-ins staying at the Navy Lodge will have easier access to on-base housing. Off-Base housing (Economy Housing) location remains unchanged.

Religious Ministry (RELMIN):

To facilitate the on-base housing office move, some of the Religious Ministry (RELMIN) staff moved to the existing RELMIN spaces in CAPO or to existing spaces inside the Chapel on Support Site. Religious Education, chaplain staff offices, and the chapel remain in the same place at the Support Site. The four religious education classrooms and the fellowship hall remain unchanged. The RELMIN staff will still have dedicated counseling spaces on both CAPO and Support Site. Whether you are at the Support Site or Capo, rest assured you will continue to receive spiritual services as usual. We acknowledge this will impact some groups and clubs, but we are committed to supporting, please work with your applicable group sponsor to work through any friction.

NSA Naples Satellite Office Suite:

By the end of November 2024, NSA Naples will establish a small satellite office on Support Site in the former MVRO spaces, 1st floor of the Navy Lodge. This office will be a small “hotel style” to support all NSA Naples Departments. This will give command leadership and key staff a working space at the Support Site to support mission requirements and better serve the community. This also ensures the command leadership can seamlessly conduct business (meetings, office calls, administration) at Capo and Support Site at any time.

Motor Vehicle Registration Office (MVRO):

Effective October 28, 2024, Support Site MVRO relocated to the former Military Family Housing office (On-Base housing) at building 2074 located between the Auto Shop and the Vehicle Processing Center (VPC). ***MVRO Support Site will open to the public at the new location at 0745 on Nov. 4.*** Note that both Capo and Support Site MVROs will be closed on Friday Nov. 1 for the Italian Holiday. Relocating MVRO to building 2074 will be a huge benefit to you the customer due to this standalone building having a better office space and a dedicated parking lot which allows the team to better serve those registering vehicles. Its close proximity to the VPC, Scrap lot and Auto Shop, will make vehicle registration and safety inspections a lot easier as they are short distances from each other.

Travel Around Europe:

EU To Launch Two New Border Management Initiatives

Ensure all your travel documentation, including official and tourist passports, is valid.

The EU is preparing to launch two new border management initiatives that will affect travel to Europe: the [Entry/Exit Systems \(EES\)](#) and the European Travel Information and Authorization System (ETIAS). The EES will become operational first and the ETIAS will follow.

The EES is a biometric system that replaces the requirement to stamp non-EU nationals’ passports. Traveler’s fingerprints and/or a facial photo will be recorded in the system at border controls. The ETIAS, once activated, is a “visa-like” travel authorization for travelers to enter 30 European countries for a short stay (up to 90 days). It will be a new requirement, not taking the place of any existing process. Required personnel must continue obtaining Missione Visas before PCSing to Italy.

What you can do to prepare: Ensure all your official documentation, including official and tourist passports, is valid; renew passports that will expire within 6 months of your PCS or any travel planned; take all your official identification and orders with you when you travel; and plan for longer travel processing at airports or other transportation hubs since registration with the EES occurs at the external border of the EU countries using the system. Be proactive and know when your Sojourner’s Permit expires, and ensure you start the renewal process well in advance to allow for the Italian Immigration Office process.

At this time clear guidance has not been released for future travel requirements into and in the European Union under the ETIAS. The Department of State and EUCOM officials are working with EU officials to deliver guidance on what will be required of our personnel stationed in an EU country to travel on either official business or personal leave once ETIAS is operational.

ETIAS is not replacing or taking away the requirement for Sojourner’s Permits. Dependents and members of the Civilian component are still required to obtain a Sojourner’s Permit and to renew it when required.

Furthermore, dependents of active-duty members, U.S. Government civilians and their dependents, and contractors are still required to obtain a Mission visa in their Official or No-Fee passports before entering Italy. Command sponsors need to be proactive in notifying their onboarding personnel with dependents about:

- 1) The requirement for a No-Fee Passport and Mission visa before PCSing
- 2) The Sojourner’s Permit requirement upon arriving into Italy.

Sojourner’s Permit holders need to be proactive in checking the expiration date on their permit and applying for renewal in a timely manner. The RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office can assist in answering questions about the application and renewal process.

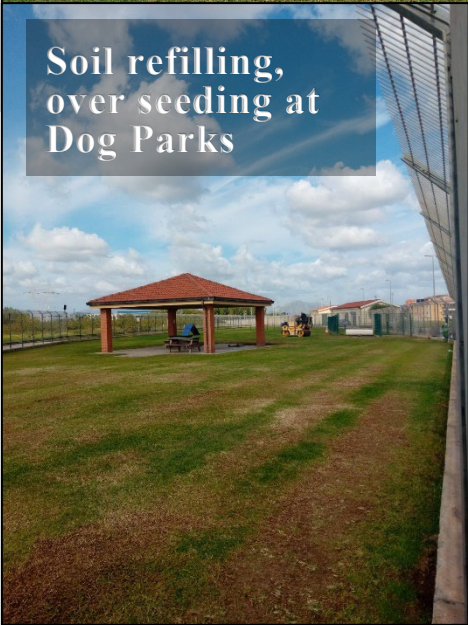

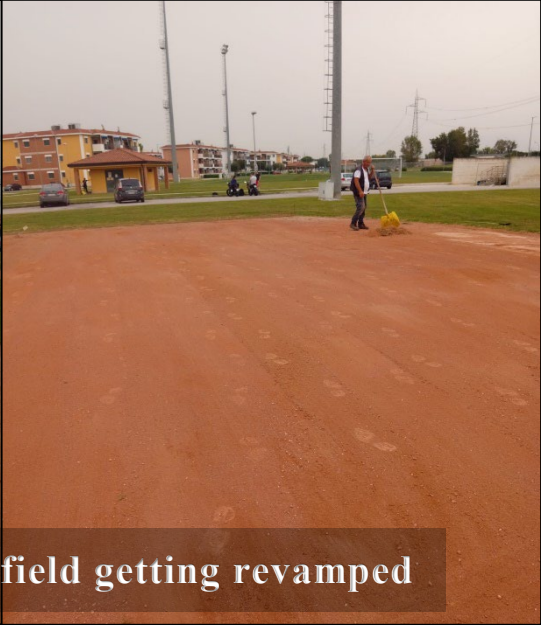

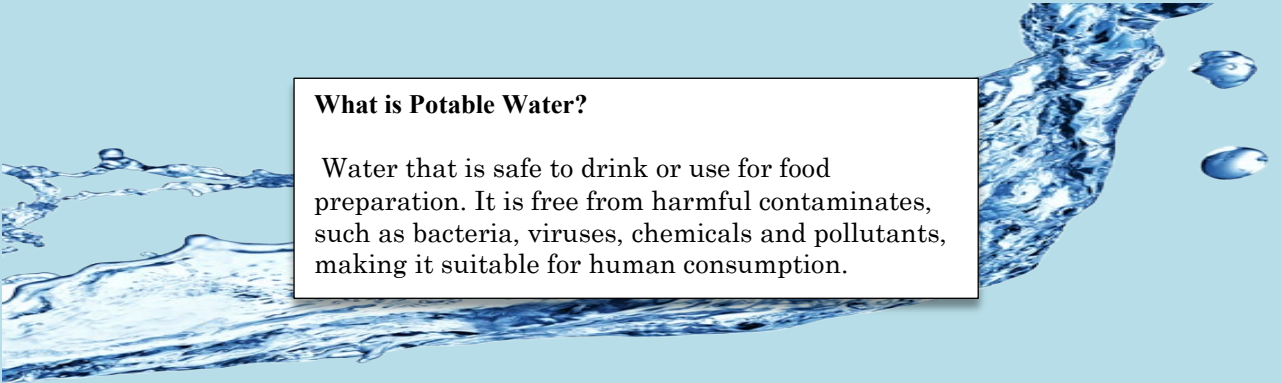
Housing Bits

Navigating Portable Water in the Economy

If you’re renting a property, understanding how potable water is supplied is crucial. Your rental unit must be connected to city water—**alternative sources, like wells, are not permitted. Failure to comply will result in the immediate termination of the lease agreement.**

As part of the lease agreement, the landlord is responsible for providing potable water each month, and receipts must be obtained from the tenant as proof of delivery. The landlord will determine how the water is supplied, either through bottled water or by installing a water cooler system. Only service providers approved by NSA Naples are allowed, including:

- Acqua Minerale San Benedetto S.p.A
- Acque Minerali d’Italia S.p.A
- Culligan Vicenza AAFES Water Plant
- Gran Guizza S.p.A
- San Pellegrino S.p.A (Acqua Vera & Levissima Plant)
- Spumador S.p.A



What is Potable Water?

Water that is safe to drink or use for food preparation. It is free from harmful contaminants, such as bacteria, viruses, chemicals and pollutants, making it suitable for human consumption.

Water will be provided based on family size, with four liters per person, per day, as per NSA Naples guidelines. This water is intended for both drinking and cooking purposes.

Key Responsibilities:

- The landlord will arrange the first delivery of bottled water or install the water cooler before your move-in date. Future deliveries will be coordinated between both parties.
- If a water cooler is installed, the landlord is responsible for its maintenance and any necessary repairs.
- According to Article 1456 of the Italian Civil Code, if the landlord fails to provide water, the lease will be terminated. Tenants can vacate the premises by giving 30 days’ notice via registered mail.

The Housing Service Center (HSC) can mediate for missed water deliveries for up to 30 days. However, tenants must notify HSC immediately if any violations occur. Please note that no monetary compensation is allowed in place of water, and no other agreements for water substitution are valid. Both the landlord and tenant are responsible for ensuring this agreement is upheld for the duration of the lease.

Preventive Maintenance Inspection (PMI)

What is a Preventive Maintenance Inspection (PMI)?

A Preventive Maintenance Inspection is a proactive process aimed at preventing and addressing potential maintenance issues in residential properties before they become a serious problem. Here at NSA Naples we do the PMI’s in spring and fall.

Will you enter my home when I am not home?

At some point, we’ll be completing a PMI for your home. You don’t need to be there, but if you have pets, please make sure they are safely secured so we can enter. If your pets are running loose we will not enter the home and will reschedule the PMI. If we stop by and you’re not home, we’ll leave a “Unit Entrance Notification” on your door to let you know we were there! Our Quality Assurance team from housing will also be attending the PMI’s.

What do you check during a PMI?

You can now use our new handy-dandy PMI checklist by simply scanning the QR code! This will show you exactly what we’ll be checking during the PMI. We want to make sure nothing is overlooked, so if we happen to miss something, we’d love to hear from you. Feel free to give us a call or send us an email to let us know!

Fall PMI November Schedule

We want to remind you of the importance of being home or ensuring your furry friends are safely tucked away in kennels on the scheduled PMI day. Our maintenance team will be conducting a PMI on the listed dates. They must enter all the homes listed. Scheduled maintenance helps keep our community in top-notch condition, ensuring your homes are comfortable and running smoothly. By completing these routine checks, we can address any potential issues before they become major headaches. Remember, your cooperation is invaluable in maintaining the quality of life we all enjoy here. It is a collective effort that keeps our community thriving. So, let's work together to keep our homes happy and healthy!

All About Mold

The most effective way to combat mold is to control the moisture in your unit.

The most effective way to combat mold is to control the moisture in your unit. There are two simple methods to achieve this:
1) Remove moisture from the air with dehumidifiers.
2) Increase air flow in the unit to increase evaporation.

The emphasis for dealing with mold focuses on visual inspection and determining the source of the moisture (e.g. water intrusion, plumbing leaks, etc.), and other contributing factors (e.g. temperature, humidity, ventilation, sanitation, etc.). It is important to correct mold and moisture problems as soon as possible through remediation and/or removal of mold contaminated materials within 24-48 hours, cleaning the surfaces, controlling the moisture source, and drying the area completely. A mold's ability to result in health effects and symptoms will vary by the genus/species. No one knows how many species of mold exist, but estimates are 100,000 or more. Individual susceptibility to mold varies widely depending on the species and amount of mold. Therefore, mold sampling and culturing are not reliable in determining an individual's health risk.

Due to these factors, according to the Navy and Marine Corps Public Health Center, there are no federal health standards for what are "unacceptable" levels of mold in the indoor environment. Therefore, there is no health standard to which mold sampling results can be compared. Further, since most people are allergic to more than one allergen, and most homes have multiple detectable allergens (e.g. pet dander, pollen, dust mites, air fresheners, candles, lawns, plants, trees, etc.), sampling for mold alone is also not a reliable factor for determining health risk. All mold issues, regardless of species, are treated the same: control the moisture source and remediate the contamination. Mold sampling results do not change this, nor do they provide a reliable indication of health risk. Fortunately, mold is something that can be combatted!

What is Considered an Emergency?

EMERGENCY CALLS - These services are issued when conditions exist that endanger the resident or cause damage to the unit and requires response on a 24 hours per day basis. Response is required within one hour during working hours and within two hours during other periods. If after-hours please contact the after-hours phone number at +39 338-946-2227

Examples of emergency calls:

- (1) Gas leaks
- (2) Smoke detectors not working
- (3) Water or sewer line breaks causing flooding
- (4) Severe roof leaks causing interior damage.

Whether you’re cooking a whole bird or a part of it such as the breast, you should take special care to prevent food poisoning. Follow the six steps below to safely store, thaw, handle, cook, and reheat your turkey.

Store Turkey Properly: Frozen raw turkey should be stored in the freezer until you are ready to thaw it. Make sure your freezer is at 0°F or below. Don’t store a turkey in a place where you can’t closely monitor the temperature, such as in a car trunk, a basement, the back porch, or in snow.

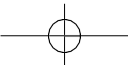

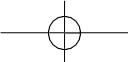

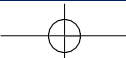
