#### CFAY Creates a Landing Page for Personnel and Family Members Affected by the Installation's Power Outages

ommander, Fleet Activities Yokosuka (CFAY) recently created a landing page on the command's official website for personnel and family members affected by the installation's power outages.

The webpage, https://cnrj.cnic.navy.mil/Installations/CFA-Yokosuka/Operations-and-Management/Public-Works/ Power-Outage-FEB2025/, provides the required documents affected members will need will need in order to process claims and reimbursements.

The forms include the latest Commander, Navy Region Japan policy concerning payment of Temporary Lodging Allowance (TLA), CFAYNOTE 7220 on Special Circumstance Temporary Lodging Allowance Due to Utilities Outage, Personnel Claims Packets with guide, and a flow chart intended to help minimize confusion.


Before beginning any claims processing, it is highly encouraged to view the Special Circumstance TLA Flow Chart by visiting the link above.

Special Circumstance TLA is authorized for all affected personnel and family members who did not secure lodging. Special Circumstance TLA helps recover costs associated with meals and incidentals. Contact the CFAY Navy Housing Office for more information.

Interim TLA is authorized if the family secured lodging and on an authorized day. Families who meet this criteria should bring their lodging receipts to the CFAY Navy Housing Office to begin the filing process.

All TLA requests will ultimately be submitted to the member's Command Pay and Personnel Administrator (CPPA). Contact your Chief or Command Master Chief for more information.

Personnel who had food spoil or lost during the power outage should first choose the How to Fill a Claim Packet FAQ link and then select the Personnel Claims Packets link. Region Legal Service Office Western Pacific's Yokosuka Legal Assistance Office staff can help fill out the paperwork. Once complete, claims are filed with Personnel Claims Unit Norfolk.



#### Special Circumstances TLA

- Q: What do I need to include in the package?
- A: You need these key supporting documents, or KSDs:
  - Fully itemized zero-balance Lodging Receipt
  - Record of Emergency Data/Dependency Application (RED/DA) (pen and ink or updated printout)
  - If applicable, Certificate of Non-Availability (CNA) from Navy Lodge
  - Receive TLA Request and Claim form from Housing Service Center.
  - NPPSC 7220/5 from your CPPA.
- · Q: What if I didn't use lodging but I incurred expense like eating out?
- A: Submit a SC-TLA Request with supporting documents
  - Record of Emergency Data/Dependency Application (RED/DA) (pen and ink or updated printout) Receive TLA Request and Claim form from Housing Service Center.

  - NPPSC 7220/5 from your CPPA.
- · Q: When will I receive my payment?
- A: Once HSC approves your SC-TLA package, your CPPA routes it to TSC Yokosuka, who will process your payment within 72 hours.



#### **CPPA** Instructions

- · Q: I am a CPPA. How to I process an SC-TLA claim in Salesforce?
- A: Use the following parameters in case submission:
  - Subject Format: SC TLA YOKO RATE LAST, FIRST (Command Name)
  - · Request Type: MILPAY · Problem Code: TLA · Routed to: TSC YOKOSUKA
- Ensure member submitted all required KSDs including CFAY Authorization for SC-TLA (CFAYNOTE 7220)
- Ensure case is SUBMITTED (not initiated)



#### **CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURES**

**Yokosuka:** Due to maintenance, vehicular traffic at Carney Gate will be secured from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., March 7. Pedestrian traffic will not be affected.

- Vandegrift Lane: Full road closure until October 2025.
