NAVY MEDICINE TRAINING SUPPORT COMMAND (NMTSC)

Equipping Sailors with superior medical skills and resilience, while ensuring the success of joint global operations and safeguarding warfighting readiness.

- NMTSC is an Echelon IV command located at at Joint Base San Antonio (JBSA) Fort Sam Houston, Texas that provides operational and administrative control over Navy staff and students assigned to the Medical Education and Training Campus (METC) and other medical programs in the San Antonio area.
- Provides education and support to 500+ staff and 5,000+ initial entry ("A" School), advanced technical ("C" School) and professional students per year.
- NMTSC oversees three detachments that support the clinical phases of "C" schools:
 Navy Enlisted Training Elements (NETEs) Camp Lejeune, Portsmouth, and San Diego.

- Hospital Corps Basic (HCB) is the largest "A"
 School in the U.S. Navy.
- In FY24, the school graduated more than 2,400 students.

NMTSC ADVANCED TECHNICAL FIELD AND PROFESSIONAL PROGRAMS

HCSC Program

NMTSC's Hospital Corpsman Strength and Conditioning (HMSC) Program is a physically demanding course of instruction designed to prepare candidates for entry into one of three Navy-designated specialties: Search and Rescue Medical Technician (SAR / L00A), Special Amphibious Reconnaissance Corpsman (RECON / L02A), and Deep-Sea Dive Medical Technician (DMT / L27A).

In CY24, the program graduated 81 students.

- NMTSC provides administrative and academic support for 7 unique officer programs:

 - Army-Baylor University Doctoral Program in Physical Therapy (PT)
 - Inter-service Physician Assistant Program (IPAP)
 - Tri-Service Orthodontic Residency Program

- The PT program is ranked among the leading PT programs nationally and is the highest-rated program in the country without an associated Ph.D. program.
- The Tri-Service Orthodontic Residency Program holds the distinction of being DoD's original and only Tri-service dental and orthodontic residency.
- Inter-service Physician Assistant Program (IPAP) provides the Department of Defense with highly skilled and compassionate physician assistants.
