


Figure 1: Remnant of structure previously requested to remove (note picnic table and water tank under tarp)




Figure 3: Near mauka boundary along internal road




Figure 6: Closeup of unauthorized structure




Figure 9: Near internal road - Unauthorized structure




Figure 12: From track area - note unauthorized structure shown in Figure 11 in background of photo




Figure 14: Structure next between track and structure shown in Figure 13 (White panel truck used to store equipment)




Figure 15: Near back of track - trailer used as scorekeepers office - facing Kahuku direction
