

Other:		X		Army hires a landscape contractor to control the vegetation. The grass is kept at no more than three (3) inches high for areas inside the South Firebreak Road as noted on the attached map. The landscape contractor has the workers on the property every day working on the vegetation control.
				Per the Army, there is no live fire training on the property since 2004. Army also obtained clearances from Federal Aviation Authority for all sort of training that requires air space clearance. For some type of training, e.g. laser guidance, it could happen at night time.
				Ammunitions were brought onto the leased land by the training units. The ammunitions will not be stored on the property other than the training periods and will be accounted at the end of each training exercise.
	:			Training units will be briefed by the staff of the training ground about the safety protocol as well as the cultural aspects/sites. Some areas will be roped off with seibert stakes to stop any training unit from entering such areas.
				Traditional Hawaiian cultures groups will be allowed to access to the cultural sites inside the training ground. However, they will be guided by specialized personnel on explosives from the training ground management during the entire duration of the stay by the groups. Other than certain dates in the year, e.g. Makahiki, the number of each group's visit allowed on the training ground is limited to a few to make sure enough explosive specialists can accompany the groups.
				Note: DLNR was also allowed to visit the area set aside by the President to the Army. Some photos attached to this report are taken on the Presidential Executive Order area.



Typical topography of Makua Military Reservation










Portion of the Presidential Executive Order area
