## **NETCOM Announces Transition to Army Unified Directory Service to Enhance Capabilities for Soldiers**

NETCOM has launched the Army Unified Directory Service (AUDS), a cloud-based solution set to unify all unclassified Army directories and streamline device management across global operations. By September 30, 2025, all unclassified end-user computers will migrate to AUDS, enhancing security, mobility, and user experience through features like VPN-free access, global system mobility, and single sign-on.
