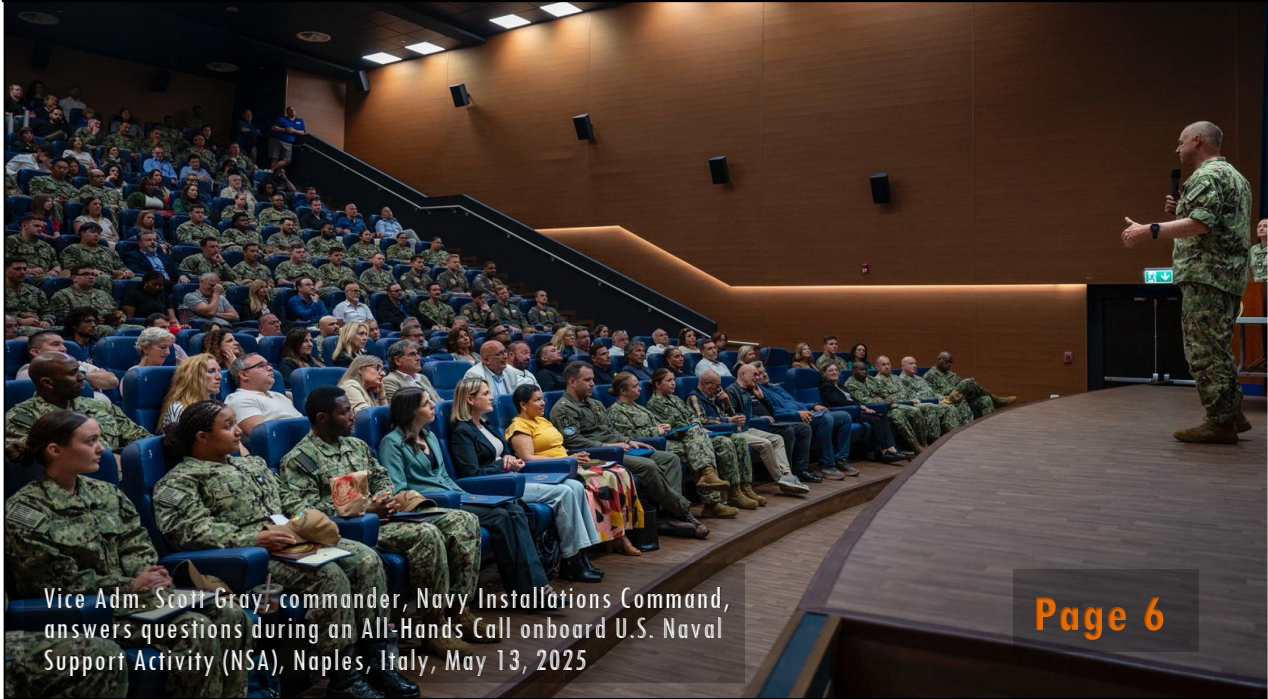

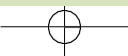

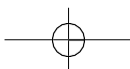

Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change will ONLY affect tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.

The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

Your Questions Answered

[What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?](#)

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

[Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?](#)

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

Radon Awareness: Know the Health Risks of Radon

On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.

Radon can build up to harmful levels in any home or building anywhere in the world.

People can be exposed to radon in their:



Homes



Schools



Workplaces

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

Radon can build up in the air in any home or building, whether it has a basement, is sealed or drafty, or is new or old. Take action to reduce the risks of radon in your home by opening windows and using fans to circulate air. This increases airflow and mitigates the buildup of radon.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense. The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units. RPC 1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).

NSA Naples Sailors Recognized for Heroism



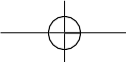

In-Focus: Air Quality in Naples

Checking Air Quality Outdoor

The website hyperlink below provides real-time data on Naples’ Air Quality Index (AQI) to help residents understand pollution levels and potential health implications. AQI is a measure of air pollution on a scale where higher numbers indicate poorer air quality. The AQI levels are divided into categories: Good (0-50), Moderate (51-100), Poor (101-200), Unhealthy (201-300), Severe (301-400), and Hazardous (401-500).

The dashboard displays AQI readings across various locations in Naples, showing areas with higher pollution. Additional insights like health recommendations (e.g., wearing masks, using air purifiers) and historical AQI trends are also included, helping residents make informed decisions about outdoor activities. This is not an endorsement of this website, but an effort to keep our community here in Naples informed on the environmental conditions where we live.

Air Quality in Naples – Sources

Vehicle emissions are among the primary contributors to Naples’ air pollution. The city’s dense traffic and reliance on cars and motorbikes result in high levels of NO₂ and other harmful pollutants that affect air quality, especially during peak travel times.

In addition, less frequent, natural events, like wildfires in Naples, contribute to air pollution and environmental damage.

Addressing these issues requires coordinated efforts between local authorities, industries, and the community to reduce pollution and to mitigate its long-term environmental impacts. It is also important to note the U.S. Naval Hospital Naples does not test or monitor the outdoor air quality across the region.

What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

Introduction

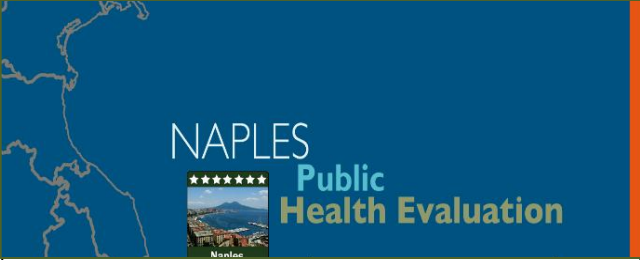

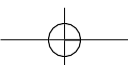

Vice Adm. Scott Gray, Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC), completed an official visit to U.S. Naval Support Activity (NSA) Naples, Italy, May 14, underscoring the base's increasing strategic value as a forward-deployed operational platform supporting the fleet and NATO allies.

The visit allowed Gray, who oversees 10 regions and 70 installations, to engage with the NSA Naples team that supports over 8,000 military community members and more than 50 supported commands stationed onboard the installation.

Gray, a former commanding officer of NSA Naples, commended the crew during an all hands call, highlighting their hard work in providing air and port operations, emergency services, and essential quality of service programs to ensure stability for the fleet, joint, and allied forces operating in the European, African, and Central Command areas of responsibility.

"I want to extend a special thank you to our uniformed personnel, U.S. civilians, and, most importantly, our local [Italian] nationals, for their dedication to keeping the base operational," Gray said. "We must continue developing better ways of doing business in order to meet critical warfighting functions and ensure that every dollar spent yields maximum benefit to our warfighting and warfighters."

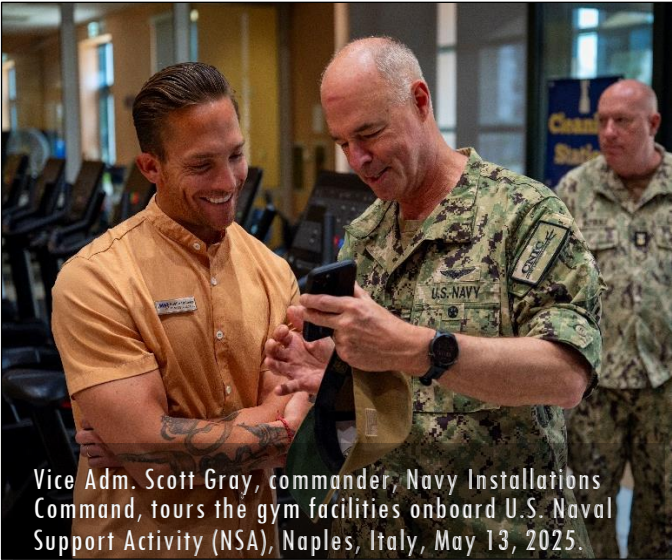
Gray highlighted the Navy's ongoing commitment to investing in its shore facilities and installations, citing some notable accomplishments, such as the establishment of 24-hour fitness centers and upgrades to unaccompanied housing units onboard NSA Naples.

"We've made some positive initial changes, but there's still progress to be made," Gray said. "We will continue

to build on the significant strides already made towards improving quality of service for Sailors and their families."

Accompanied by NSA Naples Commanding Officer Capt. John Randazzo and Fleet and Family Readiness staff, the CNIC commander also toured key facilities that supports quality of life, including the unaccompanied housing units, fitness center, bowling alley, and liberty centers.

"Vice Adm. Gray's engagement with our crew coupled with his focus on quality-of-life initiatives, like the barrack upgrades, clearly demonstrates a commitment to the wellbeing of our personnel and their families," said Randazzo. "These improvements are essential to maintaining readiness and morale, which directly support the fleet and ensures mission success."

Bulk Trash Pickup

Support site residents have the convenience of scheduling bulk trash pick-up to remove larger items such as couches, mattresses, large boxes, electronics, etc. This service is designed to simplify waste disposal and help maintain a cleaner more organized neighborhood. To take advantage of this service, please follow these easy steps:

1. Schedule Your Pickup

Contact the help desk at +39 081- 811- 4285/4286 or DSN 629-4285/4286, or submit a request on our maintenance QR code. Bulk trash pick-ups are typically conducted on Mondays and Fridays. Providing any special instructions- such as the need for extra assistance or the presence of hazardous materials-at the time of scheduling will help ensure a smooth service.

2. Prepare Your Items

Place your bulk trash items in a clearly accessible area inside your home. Do not block sidewalks, common areas or doors.

Important: Bulk items must not be placed inside trash bins or within the trash pad enclosures on support site.

3. Separate Recyclables

Please separate recyclable materials from non- recyclable materials from non-recyclables before your bulk trash appointment, this supports our commitment to sustainability and environmentally responsible waste disposal.

Economy Residents

If you live in the economy and have bulky items you are wanting to discard, please contact your landlord directly for guidance, as each city has its own bulk waste collection procedures and schedules.

Mosquito and Ant Prevention

Remember, they don’t fly far from where they breed, so if you’re experiencing mosquito bites, chances are they’re breeding nearby. In addition to eliminating standing water, you can also take steps like keeping your mosquito screens in working condition and wearing insect repellent when outdoors.

Alongside mosquito prevention, it is equally important to take measures to prevent ants. In your home, seal cracks and crevices where they can enter, keep food sealed in airtight containers, and clean up spills and crumbs promptly. Regularly inspect your home for signs of infestation and address any issues promptly to keep your living space pest-free. By staying vigilant and implementing these prevention measures, you can enjoy a comfortable living space.

Tobacco Use on Support Site

Tobacco use is not permitted inside your apartment or on balconies. Smoking indoors or on balconies poses serious health risks, including second hand smoke exposure to neighbors increased risk of fire, and long-term damage to the property. To protect the health and safety of all residents, tobacco use is only allowed in designated tobacco use areas located on Support Site. We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining a clean, healthy, and safe environment for everyone in the community.



Unaccompanied Housing Bits

Check-Ins

Sponsors are required to reserve a room 30 days in advance. They must provide a copy of the incoming member’s orders, flight itinerary, and DOD ID at least 14 days before arrival. If your flight is delayed and you arrive after hours please contact the UH Duty Manager at +39 338-946-2227.

Check-Outs

For Check-outs, please stop by the UH front desk and schedule a pre inspection 14 days before your estimated departure. Final inspections are conducted on the day of departure and an E6 or above must be present in uniform.



Unaccompanied Guest and Visitor Policy

****NO PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE IS AUTHORIZED IN THE UH****

Residents are encouraged to invite guests, provided they do not interfere with good order or inconvenience other residents. Each resident is authorized to have up to five guests, with a maximum of five guests per unit at any given time. Guests must be accompanied by the host resident at all times, who is responsible for their behavior.

The authorized visiting hours for guests are:
Sunday-Thursday: 1200 to 2200
Friday-Saturday: 1200 to 0000

Overnight stays by guests are not permitted. Visitors include personnel in the unit for official duties such as command representatives, security, maintenance, cleaning, and inspection workers.

- Single or Unaccompanied service member living in Unaccompanied Housing
- E6 –E9. Exceptional E-4 and E-5 may be eligible with special approval.
- One year remaining on orders

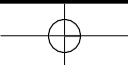

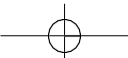

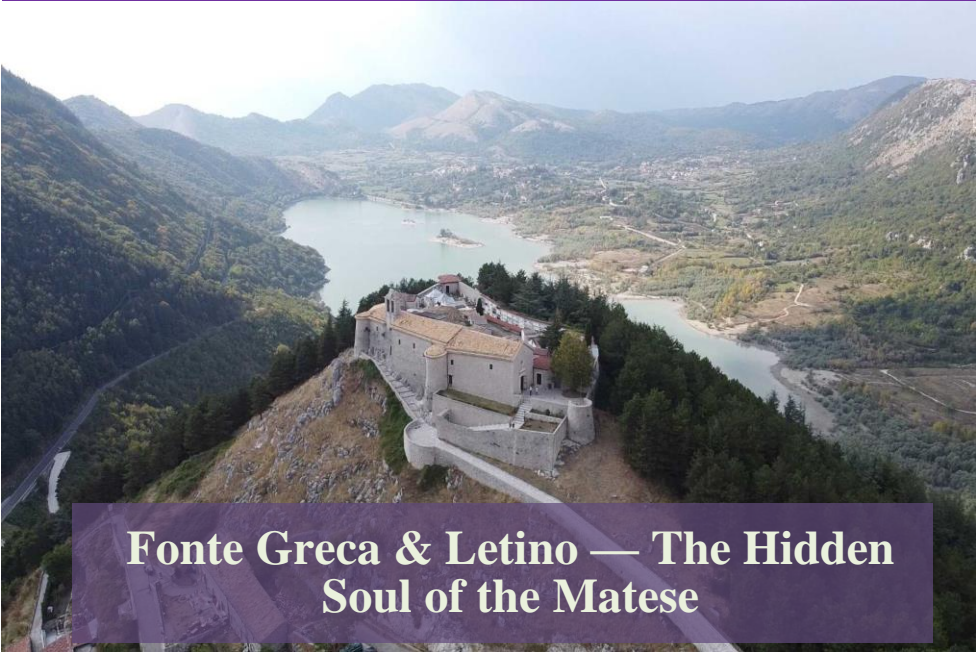

Fonte Greca & Letino — The Hidden Soul of the Matese

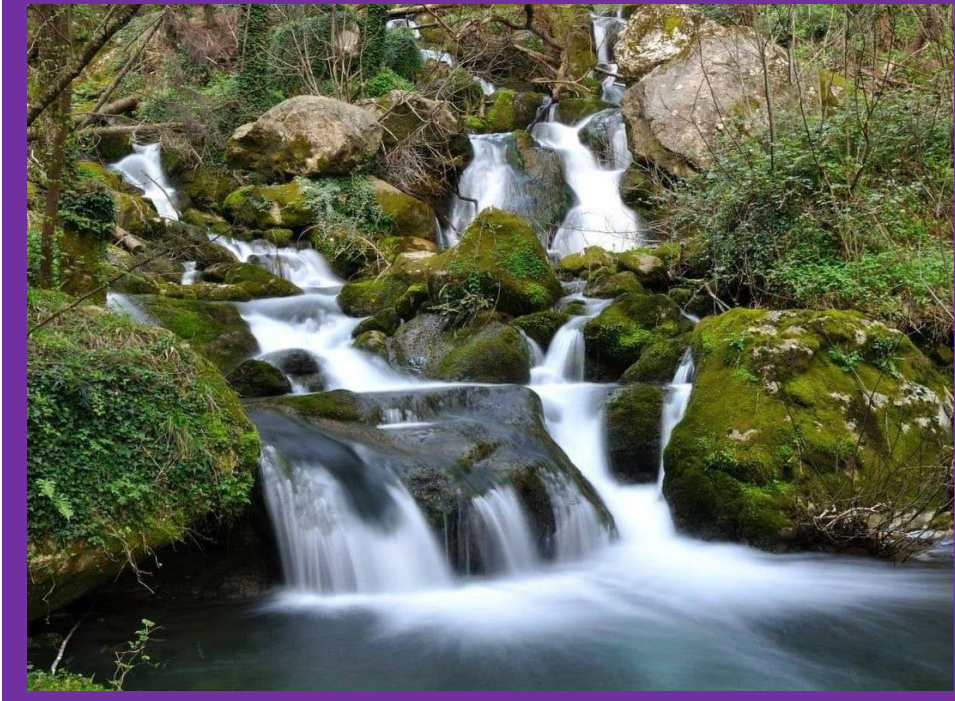

If you’re craving an escape into pure, authentic, fresh mountain charm, look no further than Fonte Greca and Letino — two tiny jewels nestled deep in the Matese mountains. Fonte Greca, a tiny hamlet near Capriati al Volturno, is famous for its crystal-clear springs that locals swear have healing powers. Bring a bottle — the water here is so pure it tastes like the mountain itself.

Climbing up to Letino feels like stepping into a medieval postcard. Perched at over 1000 meters, this stone village offers breathtaking views over the Matese lakes and untouched landscapes. 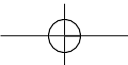

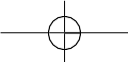

ATTENTION: PCSing from Italy? Legal Clearance Required!

Tenant Commands are encouraged to add "RLSO Legal Clearance Checkout" in their respective Command Checkout Sheet to ensure all personnel meet this important requirement.

Before departing Italy on PCS orders, all personnel must complete the following checkout procedures:

Upcoming Demolition of B443 at Capodichino: Three Things to Know

The demolition of Building B443 is scheduled to begin around May 2025. B443 is the former barracks; the long structure located behind the Mobile Bar. This demo project will necessitate some changes that all tenants should be aware of and plan for accordingly.

Mobile Bar Relocation - Enjoy Uninterrupted Service!

Where does the Commissary get its meat products?

Shoppers are amazed to learn that the USDA-approved Natural and Choice beef we sell in the commissaries in Europe and the Middle East are shipped here from the U.S. Even more surprising, is that the retail cuts of beef are fresh, never frozen. This is accomplished through the use of vacuum packaging.

What are the advantages of vacuum packaging?

► Because oxygen is removed, the shelf life of vacuum-packaged red meat increases from a matter of days to at least two weeks.

► Vacuum packaging allows natural enzymes to act as a natural tenderizer and enhances quality/palatability of beef.

► Without the vacuum technology, most locations would have only frozen meat products.

VACUUM SEALED FOR FRESHNESS!



Beef gets its red color from exposure to oxygen. In our vacuum packing process, we remove over 99% of the oxygen from the package. The lack of oxygen turns the meat a darker color but the meat will return back to the usual red-color once the package is opened and is, once again, exposed to oxygen.

The vacuum package does not allow for any air in or out. This can cause naturally occurring lactic acid to build up inside the package. Shortly after opening the package, the initial off-odor will dissipate. This process does not affect the quality of the meat or taste and acts as a natural meat tenderizer.

The Central Meat Processing Plant’s state-of-the-art facility features highly efficient meat processing and vacuum machines, metal detectors and X-ray machines, a flash freezer, and high-tech cleaning systems. USDA Beef is cut, ground, packaged, vacuum sealed, and shipped from Kaiserslautern Cold Storage to our overseas locations. Fresh pork is sourced locally from German locations and processed under the same strict guidelines. Commissaries receive shipments an average of every two to three days, depending on the size and sales volume of the location.

Just as you can go to a stateside commissary and place a special order for pork or beef, you can do the same here in Europe. You can simply request a special order from the commissary at the meat department or front-end department by filling out a special-order form if you are looking for a large quantity or a special cut.

Special order lead times vary depending on the request but a majority can be filled within days. Large quantity requests may take up to eight weeks. Whole pigs require a 10-day lead time. Check with your commissary for details.

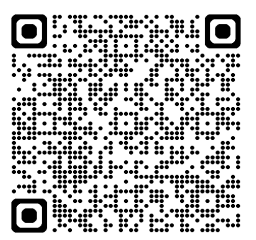

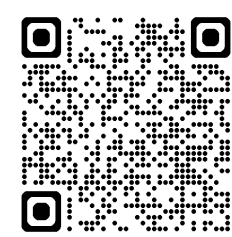
