Second Modification to Appendix B, Daytime and Overnight Access to Makua Military Reservation ("MMR") for Cultural Access

The Parties mutually consent that Appendix B, Section 8 ("Activities While Present on Makua Military Reservation"), Subsection C ("Limitations on Activities"), Item 8, subparagraph 8.b, as modified by the First Modification to Appendix B, Daytime and Overnight Access to Makua Military Reservation ("MMR") for Cultural Access (dated December 18, 2008), is further modified as follows:

"b. In the cut grass areas (i) mauka of Range Control bisected by the centerline road and bounded by the drainage area to the north and by the north firebreak road to the east and by the centerline road to the south; (ii) approximately 10m (33 feet) around the Mākua ahu; (iii) at the south firebreak/centerline road junction; and (iv) to the south of the centerline road and leading to the petroglyph rock (Feature 11) at site 5926, including, but not limited to, the roped access path along the eastern and southern edge of the cut grass area mauka of Range Control and to the south of the centerline road that leads from the Mākua ahu to the petroglyph rock (depicted in yellow on Enclosure "A" hereto)"

Activities permitted without shoes, pursuant to the First Modification to Appendix B, Daytime and Overnight Access to Makua Military Reservation ("MMR") for Cultural Access, remain in effect.
