CFAY FFSC to Hold Career Fair Friday

Commander Fleet Activities Yokosuka (CFAY) Fleet and Family Support Center (FFSC) is scheduled to hold a Career Fair Friday, June 13 outside the Community Readiness Center starting at 10 a.m.

In case of poor weather, the event is scheduled to move indoors.

12 organizations and staff from two Navy College campuses, are expected to attend.

Brittany Hart, the event's organizer and a CFAY FFSC Certified Professional Resume Writer, said she anticipates over 200 community members in attendance.

"Our experts will be on-site to offer on-the-spot resume reviews and provide immediate feedback," Hart said.

"After providing resume feedback, we encourage applicants to utilize our resource space upstairs; edit, print, and distribute resumes to employers – all in the same day!"

The Career Fair provides participants resources to find available job openings throughout CFAY and information for those who are looking to start their careers but may not know where to start.

"We also host workshops and classes that focus on more details," Hart said.

CFAY FFSC employment workshops fall under the Family Employment Readiness Program, or FERP. FERP's workshops include Effective Resume Writing for both Federal and civilian resumes and Marketing Me "a class that goes over how to better present yourself on social media platforms like LinkedIn," Hart said.

Additionally, the Employee Overview class connects job seekers with non-federal agencies and local Japanese businesses looking to hire community members right outside the base gates.

For those considering self-employment, CFAY FFSC also provides a quarterly Home-Based Business (HBB) workshop. Work and Family Life consultants assist prospective entrepreneurs through the installation's processes to receive proper authorization to operate on base. Representatives from CFAY Legal, CFAY Navy Housing, Yokosuka Navy Exchange, and the Naval Supply Systems Fleet Logistics Center Yokosuka post office staff discuss how to navigate their portions of the process so "you can be confident that you have the resources needed to succeed," Hart said.

Odawara Castle Hydrangea and Iris Festival

The grounds of Odawara Castle are sprinkled with more than 10,000 irises and 2,500 hydrangeas. They contrast beautifully with the brilliant red bridge in Odawara Castle Ruins Park. The flowers will be lit from sunset (around 7 p.m.) till 8:30 p.m. On the weekend during the festival, food trucks and stalls will open in front of Hanashobu Square.

CONSTRUCTION AND CLOSURES

- Yokosuka:** Carney Gate closure on June 19. Due to maintenance, all vehicular traffic will be secured from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Carney Gate inbound lane closure until June 30. Night time inbound traffic closure from 8 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Outbound traffic access, pedestrian traffic will not be affected. Gate open for all traffic from 5 a.m.
 - Nimitz Boulevard partial closure until July 31. Single lane alternating traffic. Flagmen will be posted. Will restore and release the site on daily basis by 4 p.m. for full 2-way traffic.
 - C Street full closure from June 16 to Sept. 25. The Yokopon bus will be re-routed down Leahy street, stops will remain the same. Pedestrian routes will be open on either side of the project.
 - Sanban Tower Parking full and partial closure until June 13 due to installation of fire service water line. L Street will be partially closed with road guards. L Street will then be fully closed from June 14 or 21 depending on weather. During L Street full closure, traffic will be directed around work area. Both lanes open at end of work day.
 - Gridley Tunnel full road closure. Closure period: Until July 31, Aug. 1 to July 31, 2028. First closure is for temporary high voltage power bypass. Second closure is for permanent high voltage power repairs. The second closure is only for vehicular traffic. Tunnel will be open for pedestrian and

bicycle traffic.

- Full road closure next to building J-10 until June 30. Sinkhole appeared in the middle of the road due to Damaged Sewer Pipe. No impact to Water Systems.
- Carney Gate water line replacement. Construction period until Nov. 26. Expect detours and periodic closures for waterline replacement construction. Two-way traffic to be maintained. Most of the work will occur overnight.
- Howard Street partial closure until Aug. 6. Five parking spots will be taken for the work. Pedestrian walkway will be set up around work area. Only one lane southbound will be affected, turning into a small merge. Exiting parking area onto Howard from Fleet Rec will not be affected.
- Nimitz Boulevard and Gridley Lane partial road closure. Closure period from Sept. 20 to Nov. 26, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Two-way traffic will be maintained with flagmen.
- Vandegrift Lane full road closure until October.
- The parking lot immediately in front of ATG is secured through 2027 in support of the NSST Shiphandling Trainer construction. Additionally, half of the 12-hour parking lot is also secured to support NSST construction material laydown and management.
- Ikego:** Yasakayato Street will be partially closed from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., until Dec. 25. Installation of communication and electrical lines. Flagmen will be posted on both sides to allow two-way traffic.
- Ikego CDC parking lot partial closure until Sept. 30. 14 additional parking spots and Five parallel spots will be closed for the new CDC construction area.
- A Government of Japan Contractor will perform excavation work on Shisagi Street until Aug. 31, 2025. Working hours will be between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Excavation site will be controlled as one-way alternating traffic control road during the daytime work. After daily working hours, road should be re-opened.
