- NAVY HOSPITAL CORPS LEGENDS -HMCM WILLIAM R. CHARETTE



- Master Chief William R. Charette (1932-2012) enlisted in the Navy in January 1951. He served 26 years in the hospital corps.
- Awarded the Medal of Honor for
 heroic actions at the Battle of
 Outpost Vegas in the Korean War
 (1953).
- Chosen to select the remains of U.S. World War II servicemen who would be placed in the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier at Arlington National Cemetery (1958).
- Spent 15 years as an Independent
 Duty Corpsman (IDC). Served aboard submarines Quillback (SSN 424),
 Triton (SSN 586), and Daniel Webster (SSBN 626).
- Namesake of Charette Health Care Center at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, Virginia, and USS William R. Charette (DDG 130).
