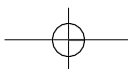


JFC Naples personnel provide counter-IED training in Kuwait

Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change will ONLY affect tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.

The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

Your Questions Answered

What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?

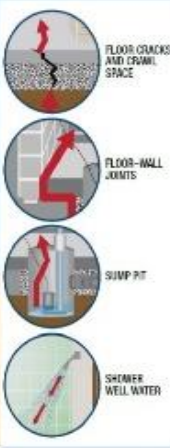
No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

Radon Awareness: How Radon Enters Homes

On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.

Radon can enter your home in many ways:

- Cracks in solid floors
- Construction joints
- Cracks in walls
- Gaps in suspended floors
- Gaps around service pipes
- Cavities inside walls
- The water supply

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense. The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units. RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).

Naples Public Health Evaluation

In-Focus: Water Quality in Naples

Drinking Water On-Base

One of Naples Public Health Evaluation’s enduring processes is water safety which seeks to ensure that drinking water at all NSA Naples installations is tested and monitored routinely to ensure the water is fit for human consumption. The drinking water is tested in accordance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Italian and Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) monitoring requirements on a daily, monthly, quarterly, and annual basis to ensure compliance with standards and be able to declare the water is fit for human consumption.

For instance, in 2024, NSA Naples collected 496 drinking water samples and performed over 6,300 tests in three categories: Chemical, more than 3,700 tests looking for over 180 chemical parameters; Bacteriological, more than 700 tests looking for over 5 Microbiological parameters; and Field Measurements, more than 1,800 tests looking for six field parameters. The tests looked specifically for 191 contaminants in five major groups: microbial contaminants; pesticides and herbicides; inorganic contaminants; organic chemical contaminants, and radioactive contaminants.

The health and well-being of all personnel and families in Naples is the base’s top priority. Routine testing ensures compliance with drinking water standards that are required to declare the water as fit for human consumption. The base is committed to keeping the military family fully informed through timely dissemination of credible information with complete transparency.

Water Sources, Testing, Treatment

The drinking water Consumer Confidence Reports (CCR) outlines all the water sources, testing and treatment process for NSA Naples installations: Capodichino, Support Site, SATCOM Lago Patria, Carney Park, and Gaeta Olde Mill Inn. The CCR is an annual on-base water quality report that a water system is required to provide every year to its customers. This is just like any public water system in the United States. The CCR helps people make informed choices about the water they drink. Drinking Water Off-Base

Unlike on-base, the water quality cannot be verified at each off-base location or residence. As a precautionary measure, all personnel who live off-base are provided with bottled water for consumption. Bottled water is provided through housing lease provisions for all personnel living off-base. What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area’s waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

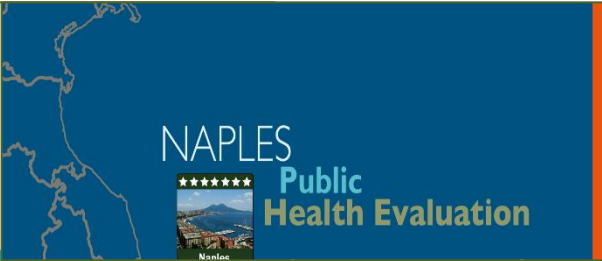

Fact Sheet: Water Consumption for Off-Base Housing



If you rent a property in the economy, it is important to know about **POTABLE WATER**. The rental unit must be supplied with city water. **It is also extremely forbidden to supply the property with well water.** The penalty will be the immediate termination of the contract.

The landlord will provide potable water **every month** and must obtain receipts from the tenant.

The landlord will choose how to supply the water: either with bottled water or installing a water cooler system. In both cases, the company must be one of the NSA Naples-approved service sources, please see below:

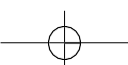
- Acqua Minerale San Benedetto S.p.A
- Acque Minerali d’ Italia S.p.A
- Culligan Vicenza AAFES Water Plant
- Gran Guizza S.p.A San Pellegrino S.p.A
- Acqua Vera San Pellegrino S.p.A
- Levissima Plant Spumador S.p.A



The landlord will provide the necessary amount of bottled water and/or containers of water for the cooler according to family composition, as indicated in the orders, **four liters per day per person as per NSA Naples guidelines. Bottled Waters should be used for drinking/ cooking purposes.**

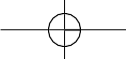

Fireworks Safety

Happy Fourth of July! As we celebrate this year, please keep in mind that fireworks are not allowed on base. Only sparklers are permitted, they must remain in your hand at all times. For your safety, always light sparklers one at a time, keep a bucket of water nearby to douse used sparklers, and never allow children to handle them without close supervision. Enjoy a safe and joyous holiday!

What is Direct Assignment?

Accompanied service members ranked E1-O6 are required to live in military family housing. For a smoother process, take advantage of the HEAT application system before arriving at NSA Naples.

- This allows you to pre-complete your housing application. Please make sure to check in within 3 days of arrival!
- Take advantage of the direct move-in program. Your Command sponsor can start the door-to-door move for you 10 days prior to your arrival. This allows you to move into your apartment without needing TLA.
- Please check in at housing either through Area Orientation or email the office upon arrival to schedule an appointment.

Housing Early Assistance Tool (HEAT)

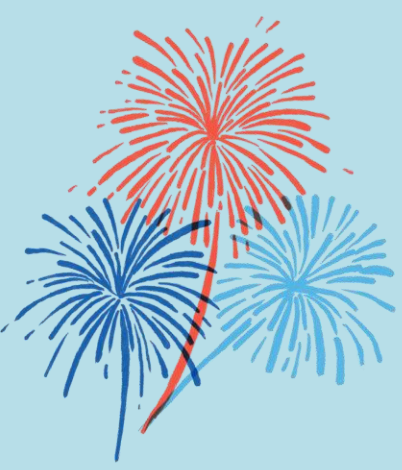
The Housing Early Assistance Tool (HEAT) assists Service Members and their families in applying for housing Navy wide. HEAT allows Service Members and their families to get the housing application process started at one or more Navy installations online before or after they receive their permanent change of station orders. HEAT is available to any Service Member at all Navy installations. HEAT creates an easy user experience to connect with your destination. Spouses can use the application as well, needing only minimal information about their Service Member. A housing referral professional will be in touch within 2 business days.

Direct Move-In Program

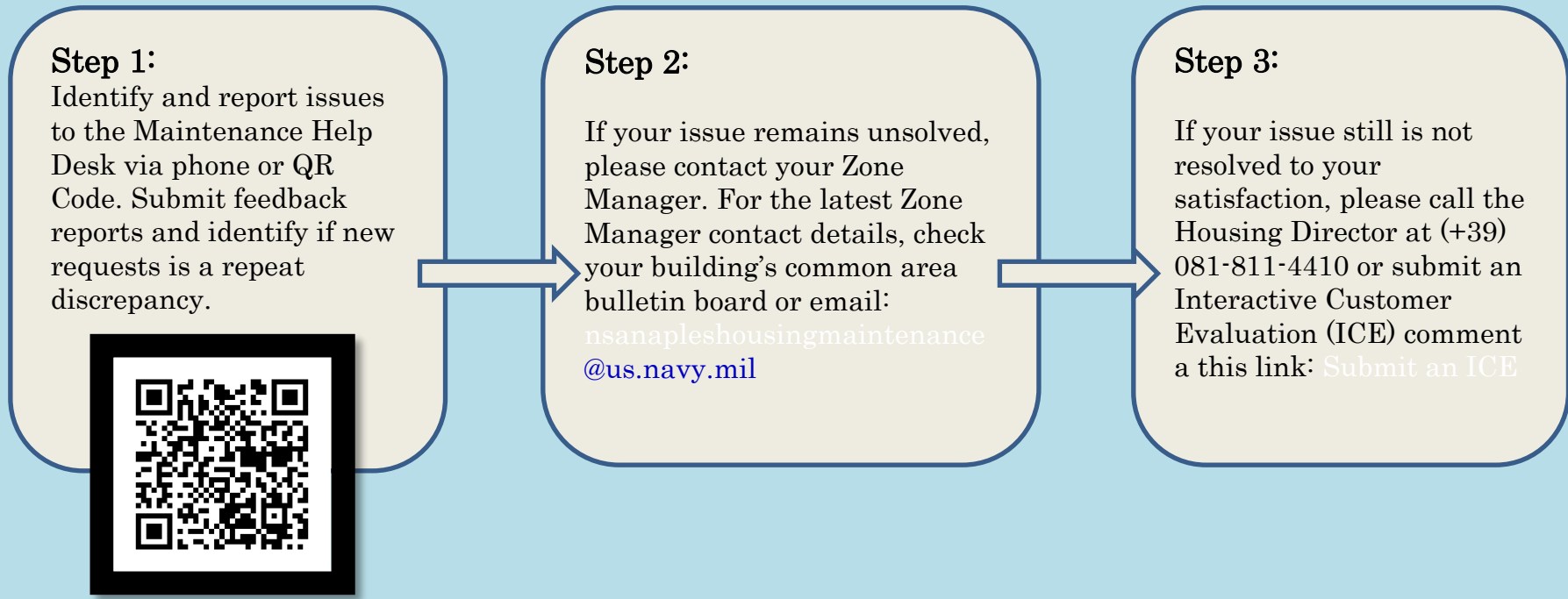

Mold Prevention

1. **Prioritize Ventilation:** Cement walls don’t breathe the same way natural materials like wood do, so it’s critical to help air circulate. Open your windows daily—even just for 10–15 minutes—and use exhaust fans in bathrooms and kitchens. Cross-ventilation works wonders.
2. **Use a Dehumidifier:** Italian summers and rainy winters can spike indoor humidity. A dehumidifier helps keep levels below 60%, which discourages mold. Bonus: it makes your home feel cooler in summer and cozier in winter.
3. **Watch for Cold Spots:** Mold loves condensation. If certain corners or exterior walls feel noticeably cooler, it might be worth insulating those areas or rearranging furniture to allow better airflow.
4. **Don’t Hang Dry Laundry Indoors (if possible):** It’s tempting to hang clothes indoors during wet seasons, but this pumps extra moisture into the air. If you must dry inside, do it near a window or dehumidifier.
5. **Address Leaks Quickly:** Check your plumbing and rooftop for drips or leaks—especially if you’re building is older. Even a small seep behind the wall can feed mold colonies out of sight.

For On-Base Residents with Fully Electric Vehicles

We've heard your concerns regarding the challenges of owning fully electric vehicles under the current housing policy. We appreciate your feedback and are excited to announce that we are updating this policy to better address your needs. For those that have previously submitted an exception to policy request related to charging vehicles on on-base property, the Housing team will be in touch soon to discuss the option of relocating to the economy housing. We are dedicated to supporting our residents throughout this transition and encourage you to reach out to us directly at naples_housing@us.navy.mil with any questions.

- Required Documents to submit Exception to Policy:
1. Proof of PCS with vehicle from the Vehicle Proccrsing Center
 2. Proof of vehicle specifications, including full Electric Vehicle specifications. Partial electric vehicles do not fit this criteria.
 3. Proof of registration with MVRO or a signed memo stating intentions to register and maintain ownership of the vehicle throughout the duration of the tour.

Loaner Furniture

If you're PCSing to or from NSA Naples and waiting on your household goods, don't worry- the Housing Office is here to help with temporary furnishings through our Loaner Furniture Program. This service is available to both incoming and outgoing military personnel and DoD Civilians, providing essential support during your transition.

However, please note: Due to high demand this PCS season, our stockpile is running low. Items are available on a fist come first serve basis, so we encourage you to reach out as early as possible to ensure availability.

Unaccompanied Housing Bits

Limited Availability for E5+ UH Exception Requests: What You Need to Know

For E5 and above service members requesting to reside in Unaccompanied Housing (UH), please be aware that this exception-to-policy program is offered only when space is available. Due to housing limitations, we are unable to accommodate all requests, and priority is always given to those who are required to live in UH per policy.

We strongly encourage you to plan accordingly—especially if your dependents are departing ahead of you and you intend to begin withdrawing BAH for your state of residence. Approval of your request is never guaranteed, and last-minute changes may not be possible if units are unavailable.

Additionally, please note: If you are approved to move into UH and a service member below E5 later requires a room, you may be required to vacate UH to meet that priority housing obligation. While we understand the flexibility this arrangement provides, we want to ensure expectations are clear to help you make informed housing plans. If you have further questions or need guidance, please connect with your housing office or Command Sponsor.



Check-Ins

Sponsors are required to reserve a room 30 days in advance. They must provide a copy of the incoming member's orders, flight itinerary, and DOD ID at least 14 days before arrival. If your flight is delayed and you arrive after hours please contact the UH Duty Manager at (+39) 338-946-2227.

Check-Outs

For Check-outs, please stop by the UH front desk and schedule a pre inspection 14 days before your estimated departure. Final inspections are conducted on the day of departure and an E6 or above must be present in uniform.

MUST BE:

- Single or Unaccompanied service member living in Unaccompanied Housing
- E6 —E9. Exceptional E-4 and E-5 may be eligible with special approval.
- One year remaining on orders

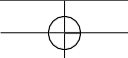

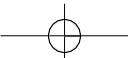

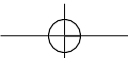

Tenant Commands are encouraged to add “RLSO Legal Clearance Checkout” in their respective Command Checkout Sheet to ensure all personnel meet this important requirement.

Before departing Italy on PCS orders, all personnel must complete the following checkout procedures:

DoD Civilians, Military with Dependents, and Contractors: Check out in-person with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office AND return your Sojourner's Permit. Checking out with legal and returning your Sojourner's Permits ensures compliance with Italian immigration law and maintains a positive relationship with Italy.

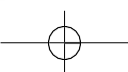

Where does the Commissary get its meat products?

Shoppers are amazed to learn that the USDA-approved Natural and Choice beef we sell in the commissaries in Europe and the Middle East are shipped here from the U.S. Even more surprising, is that the retail cuts of beef are fresh, never frozen. This is accomplished through the use of vacuum packaging.

What are the advantages of vacuum packaging?

- ▶ Because oxygen is removed, the shelf life of vacuum-packaged red meat increases from a matter of days to at least two weeks.
- ▶ Vacuum packaging allows natural enzymes to act as a natural tenderizer and enhances quality/palatability of beef.
- ▶ Without the vacuum technology, most locations would have only frozen meat products.



VACUUM SEALED FOR FRESHNESS!

Beef gets its red color from exposure to oxygen. In our vacuum packing process, we remove over 99% of the oxygen from the package. The lack of oxygen turns the meat a darker color but the meat will return back to the usual red-color once the package is opened and is, once again, exposed to oxygen.

The vacuum package does not allow for any air in or out. This can cause naturally occurring lactic acid to build up inside the package. Shortly after opening the package, the initial off-odor will dissipate.

This process does not affect the quality of the meat or taste and acts as a natural meat tenderizer.

The Central Meat Processing Plant’s state-of-the-art facility features highly efficient meat processing and vacuum machines, metal detectors and X-ray machines, a flash freezer, and high-tech cleaning systems. USDA Beef is cut, ground, packaged, vacuum sealed, and shipped from Kaiserslautern Cold Storage to our overseas locations. Fresh pork is sourced locally from German locations and processed under the same strict guidelines. Commissaries receive shipments an average of every two to three days, depending on the size and sales volume of the location.

Just as you can go to a stateside commissary and place a special order for pork or beef, you can do the same here in Europe. You can simply request a special order from the commissary at the meat department or front-end department by filling out a special-order form if you are looking for a large quantity or a special cut.

Special order lead times vary depending on the request but a majority can be filled within days. Large quantity requests may take up to eight weeks. Whole pigs require a 10-day lead time. Check with your commissary for details.

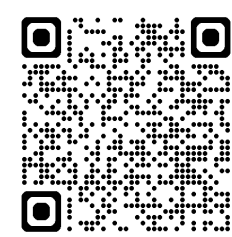

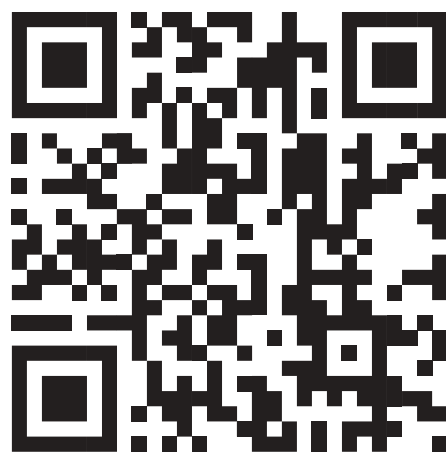
