



The on-base shuttle is the best way to navigate the different facilities on base. The on-base shuttle stops are the black and white-framed bus stops located all over base.

The on-base shuttle operates from Monday to Friday, with the exceptions of Holidays, starting from 0600 to 1855.

There are two routes the bus will travel, named the West Route and East Route respectively.

Keep in mind: The shuttle changes between between Schedule 'A' and Schedule 'B' depending on the time of the year.

Keep in mind: the medical shuttle has its own stop located outside Cinema 77. Additionally, the airport shuttle shares a few stops with the on-base shuttle.

If your flight is late or you are unable to get through security/customs before a shuttle departs, then you will need to wait for the next shuttle or contact your sponsor.

This situation applies even if you are on the shuttle manifest.

Shuttle passenger reservations are mandatory and must be received no later than 1400 the day prior to travel.

Flight arrivals and departures scheduled for the weekend or holiday(s) will make shuttle reservations by 1400 OF the last working day.

Shuttle Drivers will not actively search for arriving passengers to ensure they make it to the shuttle.

It is the responsibility of the traveler to be at the pick-up locations

Airports shuttles are not authorized to transport pets! If you are traveling with pets, make the proper arrangements prior to travel!

AIRPORT SHUTTLE CONTINUED

Airport shuttle schedules are subject to change, make sure you are following the most up-to-date schedule for accurate times!

YOU are ultimately responsible for keeping track of the airport shuttle schedule times. if you are unsure of the times, contact the transportation office.

The final departure time will be the last on-base stop before the shuttle leaves for both Haneda and Narita Airport.

To make a reservation for this shuttle, contact the Air Terminal via email at M-AT-NAF-BUSGS@US.NAVY.MIL or call the air terminal at DSN 264-3118
If the shuttle capacity is maxed out, personnel on official travel orders will have priority seating.

Reservations must be made in person or by email if on official travel.

Making a reservation will guarantee a seat will be provided for you by allowing NAVFACFE PWD to properly size the quantity of shuttle(s) needed to meet the AM/PM shuttle requirement.

In the event a traveler does not make the proper reservation (e.g. arrives at an airport without any notification) then the shuttle will accommodate travel to and from, but passengers with reservations will be given priority for shuttle seating. If there are not enough seats available, then the unannounced travelers will need to wait for the next shuttle or make alternative arrangements with their sponsor.
