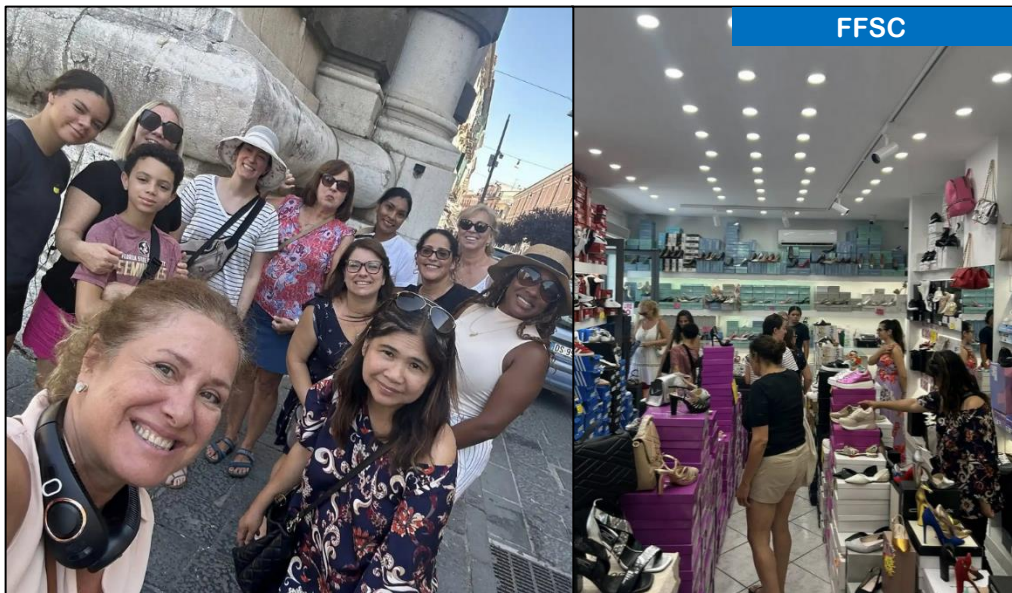




# News in Brief: Around the Installation



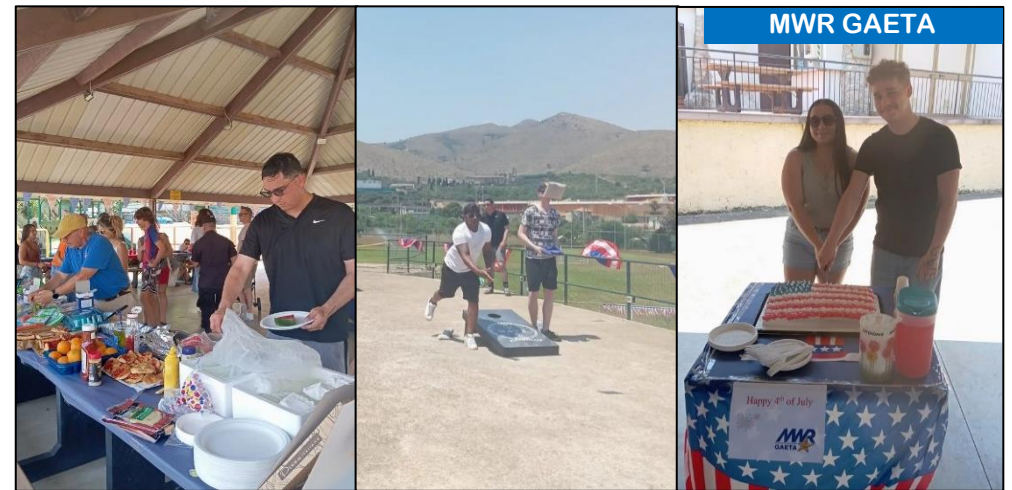

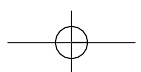

# Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

*This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.*

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change **ONLY** affects tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.

The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

## Your Questions Answered

**What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?**

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

**Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?**

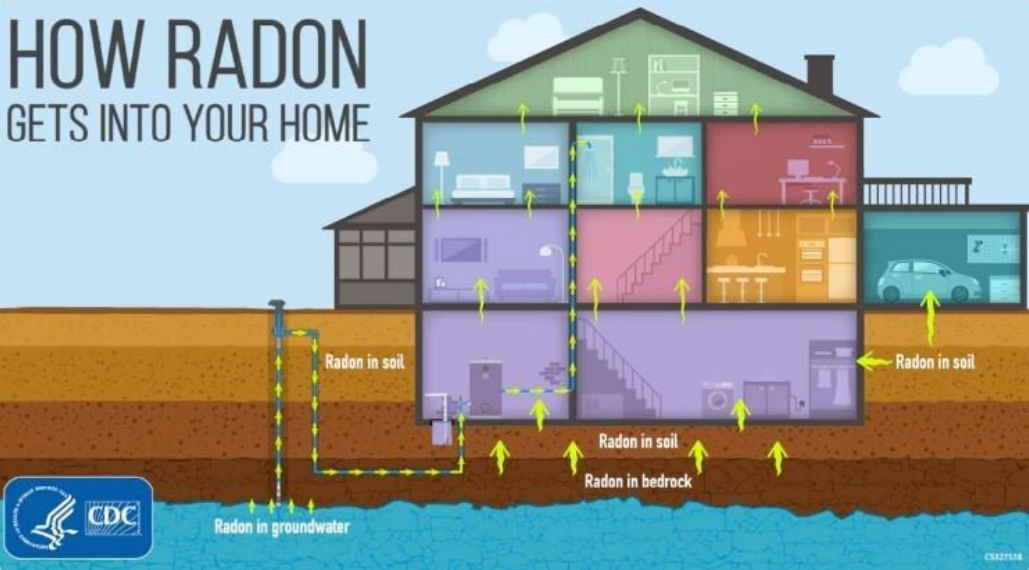
Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

**Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?**

No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

## Radon Awareness: How Radon Enters Homes

*On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.*

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

Radon can build up in the air in any home or building, whether it has a basement, is sealed or drafty, or is new or old. Take action this month to reduce the risks of radon in your home by opening windows and using fans to circulate air. This increases airflow and mitigates the buildup of radon.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense.

The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

**While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units.**

**RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).**

## PATRIOT EXPRESS ROUTE CLOSURES

STARTING OCTOBER 1, 2025



Effective October 1, 2025, Patriot Express (Rotator) flights to and from NSA Naples will be discontinued. The U.S. Transportation Command has determined, following a comprehensive study, that commercial flights offer a more cost-effective alternative. After this date, Permanent Change of Station (PCS) travel will utilize government-procured commercial transportation.

For DoD personnel and their families, prudent official travel planning in and out of the Naples area is paramount. Understanding travel requirements and the available options are key in travel planning. Working with your command travel office (Admin) and your chain of command can help set expectations and manage your travel needs efficiently.

# Naples Public Health Evaluation

## In-Focus: Food Safety in Naples

### Food Inspection On-Base

One of Naples Public Health Evaluation’s enduring processes is food safety, which seeks to ensure that food sold at the Commissary on U.S. Naval Support Activity, Naples Support Site is safe to eat and undergoes a rigorous process by the U.S. Army Veterinary Command (VETCOM) who serve as the local food inspectors before entering the store to be sold. The Commissary has labeled the fresh produce to inform shoppers of the area from which the produce is grown. Much of the produce in the Commissary is from Germany and Northern Italy.

### Continuous Food Safety Monitoring

Food provided on base is monitored on an ongoing basis. The U.S. Naval Hospital Naples Preventive Medicine routinely inspects all dining facilities on base to ensure that food is properly stored, maintained, and prepared. In accordance with Department of Defense Directive 6400.4, VETCOM ensures inspectors are stationed in the Commissary and consistently monitor food products; all food products are from VETCOM-approved sources that have been inspected; buying from approved sources is required for all meat, dairy, eggs, prepared vegetables and bottled water (fresh produce is exempt in Western Europe); proper facility sanitation; personal hygiene practices of food service workers; and education of food service managers and employees about food safety.

### Food Inspections Off-Base

The U.S. Government does not inspect restaurants or supermarkets off-base. Italy has a system in place to inspect Italian food facilities, markets, and suppliers. However, the health and well-being of all personnel and families in Naples is the base’s top priority. VETCOM inspects Italian food manufacturing facilities producing food that is supplied to U.S. military installations.

### Food Safety Tips

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services provides valuable sanitary practices that can apply wherever you live in the world:

- Wash fresh fruits and vegetables thoroughly with potable water prior to eating or cooking.
- Immune-compromised people should consume only cooked fruits and vegetables.
- Use separate cutting boards, plates and utensils for uncooked and cooked meats to avoid cross-contamination.
- Use a food thermometer to make sure meat is cooked to a safe temperature.
- Refrigerate hot or cold leftover food within two hours of being served. Keep leftovers for three to four days when properly refrigerated.

### What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

### What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

## Your Health: Facts for Families in Naples

### About: Food On and Off-Base

*The U.S. Navy is committed to ensuring our families are safe while serving our country at home or overseas. The following information is provided as part of a wide-ranging effort to understand the health risks of our personnel and families living in Naples, Italy. A comprehensive Public Health Evaluation was conducted to assess potential short and long-term health risks associated with living in the Naples area (see left panel). In line with our commitment to continually share important health information, we encourage you to review the following information.*

In 2007, numerous reports of high dioxin levels and other chemicals in air, water, and soil created a concern amongst the U.S. Navy community that foods grown in the Campania region could be contaminated. Articles in newspapers and in some Italian scientific journals alleged links between adverse health effects and the toxic waste dumps in the Campania region. These articles implicated locally grown vegetables, fruits, and mozzarella di bufala as possibly contaminated foods.

As part of the Navy’s overall efforts to be protective of the health of U.S. military and civilian personnel and their families in Naples, the Navy and U.S. Army Veterinary Command (VETCOM) conducted an investigation of foods produced in the Campania region and sold in the Naples Gricignano D’Aversa Navy Commissary (Commissary). The food study was performed in February 2008.

VETCOM is the Department of Defense executive agent for food safety and quality assurance and is responsible for providing direct assistance to all DOD agencies requiring support with respect to food safety and food defense.

*Although there are multiple layers of health protection already in place for U.S. personnel purchasing food items at the Commissary, the presumed higher potential for environmental contaminants to be present in the Campania region led the Naples Public Health Evaluation team to conduct a food study. The study went beyond routine inspections of food products by performing various laboratory analyses, which are normally not mandated by VETCOM. Foods grown locally, particularly fresh fruits and vegetables, received a closer look.*

Using the above criteria, an assessment of the Commissary was conducted. Products that met the food study criteria and were thus evaluated in the study included:

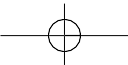

NAPLES, Italy—The U.S. Ambassador to Italy and San Marino Tilman J. Fertitta and Consul General in Naples Ms. Tracy Roberts-Pounds met with U.S. Naval Forces Europe-Africa (NAVEUR-NAVAF) and U.S. 6th Fleet (C6F) leadership at the NAVEUR-NAVAF and C6F headquarters, onboard U.S. Naval Support Activity (NSA) Naples, July 9, 2025.

The Ambassador and his spouse, Mrs. Lauren Ware Fertitta, along with the U.S. Naples Consulate Political and Economic Chief Mr. Joseph Bagga-Taves and Public Affairs Officer Ms. Erica Marrero, met with Vice Adm. J.T. Anderson, commander of C6F, Ms. Juliet Beyler, executive director of NAVEUR-NAVAF, and Capt. John Randazzo, commanding officer of NSA Naples.

“It was great seeing all the leadership and [service members] that work here, and how well they do their job to make the U.S. Navy the greatest Navy in the world,” said Ambassador Fertitta. “There are so many

things I want to accomplish as Ambassador from the United States to Italy... But one of the things I enjoy the most is getting out and visiting our bases. It was great to see how many [service members] live here in Italy and support our great nation, along with the Italians – and how we support all of NATO together.”

The Ambassador’s discussions centered on the U.S. Navy footprint and role in Italy with a focus on continued relationship-building and collaboration with the Italian government. Included in those discussions was an understanding of Navy force laydown and missions throughout Europe & Africa, as well as an overview of the service members and families in Italy.

Additionally, Mrs. Lauren Ware Fertitta embarked on a separate agenda to gain insight into the daily operations, mission, and support services offered at NSA Naples. She met with John Lenz, NSA Naples fleet and family readiness director, to tour base facilities to gain a deeper understanding of how the base supports U.S. personnel and their families overseas, while reinforcing the strong connection between the diplomatic and military

communities abroad.

### Pet Policy Reminders

On this edition of pet policy reminder, let’s talk about leashing. To protect the safety and comfort of everyone on base:

- Pets taken outside of your home or offices are restricted from playgrounds and must be kept on a leash and under the direct positive control of a capable handler at all times.
- Pets cannot be tied off to any facility, porch, fence, or stationary/non-stationary object while the handler is taking part in another event.
- Pets may be off-leash in designated pet run areas but must be supervised by a capable handler.

If you have an appointment scheduled for delivery, pick-up, or replacement, expect a courtesy phone call the day prior, providing a time frame.

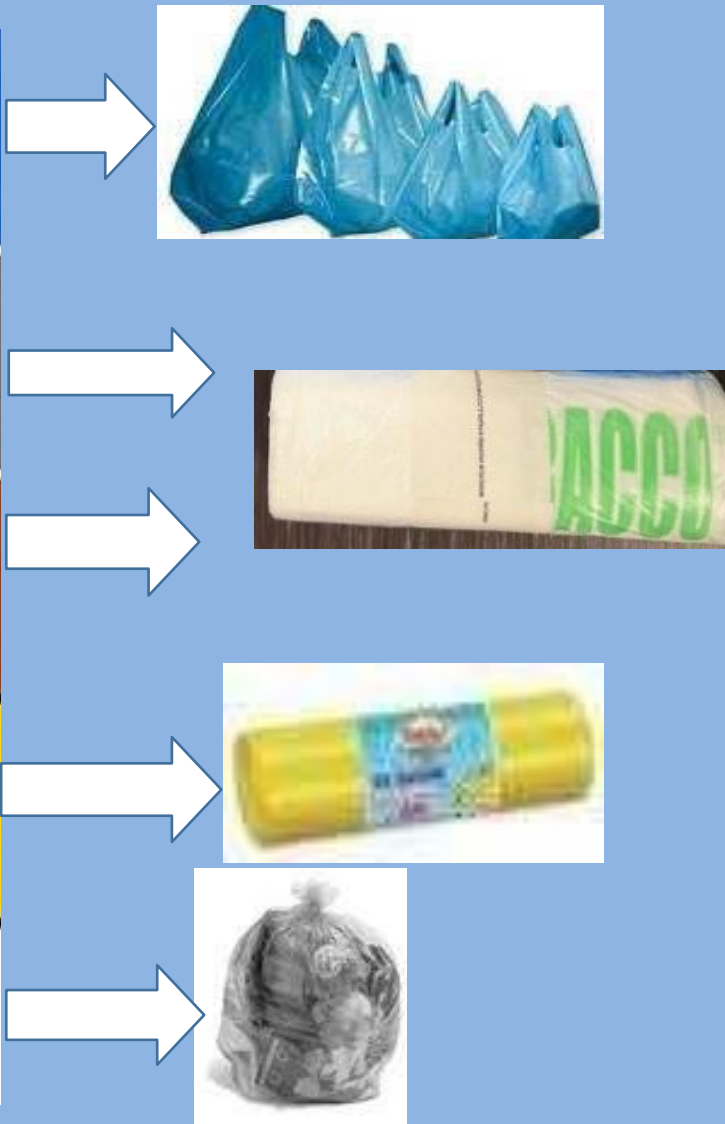

## Support Site Waste Management

Please separate your trash properly to facilitate efficient waste management. Matching the bag color to the type of trash ensures it can be processed accordingly.

<b>Organic</b> Organico		Kitchen waste, food, egg shells, coffee grounds, pet waste, bread, fruit, fish bones, paper towels and tissues, gardening waste

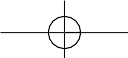

**ATTENTION: PCSing from Italy? Legal Clearance Required!**

Tenant Commands are encouraged to add "RLSO Legal Clearance Checkout" in their respective Command Checkout Sheet to ensure all personnel meet this important requirement.

Before departing Italy on PCS orders, all personnel must complete the following checkout procedures:

**All Military Personnel:** Check out with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Offices:

1. Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (SJA), NSA Naples: Checkout in person. You must have completed your check out with MVRO before coming to legal. Contact Ms. Tiziana Orso [Tiziana.orso.ln@us.navy.mil](mailto:Tiziana.orso.ln@us.navy.mil) if you have questions. Located on the first deck, Admin II, NSA Naples, Capodichino.

**DoD Civilians, Military with Dependents, and Contractors:** Check out in-person with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office AND return your Sojourner's Permit. Where does the Commissary get its meat products?

Shoppers are amazed to learn that the USDA-approved Natural and Choice beef we sell in the commissaries in Europe and the Middle East are shipped here from the U.S. Even more surprising, is that the retail cuts of beef are fresh, never frozen. This is accomplished through the use of vacuum packaging.

What are the advantages of vacuum packaging?

- ▶ Because oxygen is removed, the shelf life of vacuum-packaged red meat increases from a matter of days to at least two weeks.
- ▶ Vacuum packaging allows natural enzymes to act as a natural tenderizer and enhances quality/palatability of beef.
- ▶ Without the vacuum technology, most locations would have only frozen meat products.



VACUUM SEALED FOR FRESHNESS!

Beef gets its red color from exposure to oxygen. In our vacuum packing process, we remove over 99% of the oxygen from the package. The lack of oxygen turns the meat a darker color but the meat will return back to the usual red-color once the package is opened and is, once again, exposed to oxygen.

The vacuum package does not allow for any air in or out. This can cause naturally occurring lactic acid to build up inside the package. Shortly after opening the package, the initial off-odor will dissipate.

This process does not affect the quality of the meat or taste and acts as a natural meat tenderizer.

The Central Meat Processing Plant's state-of-the-art facility features highly efficient meat processing and vacuum machines, metal detectors and X-ray machines, a flash freezer, and high-tech cleaning systems. USDA Beef is cut, ground, packaged, vacuum sealed, and shipped from Kaiserslautern Cold Storage to our overseas locations. Fresh pork is sourced locally from German locations and processed under the same strict guidelines. Commissaries receive shipments an average of every two to three days, depending on the size and sales volume of the location.

Just as you can go to a stateside commissary and place a special order for pork or beef, you can do the same here in Europe. You can simply request a special order from the commissary at the meat department or front-end department by filling out a special-order form if you are looking for a large quantity or a special cut.

Special order lead times vary depending on the request but a majority can be filled within days. Large quantity requests may take up to eight weeks. Whole pigs require a 10-day lead time. Check with your commissary for details.

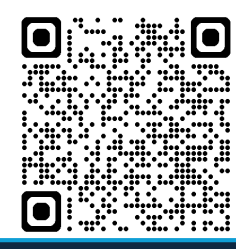
