Army pilots program for expanded meal entitlement use

FORT HOOD, Texas - The Army is conducting a limited user assessment test for the Flexible Eating and Expanded Dining, or FEED, initiative, Aug. 11-25 at Fort Hood intended to give Soldiers more options with their meal entitlements. FEED will allow Soldiers to use their meal entitlements outside of traditional Army-operated dining facilities for the first time. During the pilot, 200 Soldiers from the 61st Quartermaster Battalion can swipe their Common Access Card at select Army and Air Force Exchange Services vendors.
