Healthcare Administrators (HCAs)
have been a foundational part of the
Medical Service Corps since Aug. 4,
1947. HCAs represented 56% of the
Medical Service Corps plankowners
in 1947.

Prior to the establishment of

Medical Service Corps, hospital
corps officers and warrant officer
pharmacists typically served in the
roles of HCAs.

85% of Medical Service Corps chiefs
/ directors have been HCAs. They
include current director, Rear Adm.
Matthew Case and Rear Adm. Lewis
Angelo, the first MSC flag officer.

The Medical Service Corps
Healthcare Administrator specialty
comprises 9 subspecialties
including patient administration,
medical logistics, financial
management, and plans, operations
& medical intelligence (POMI).
