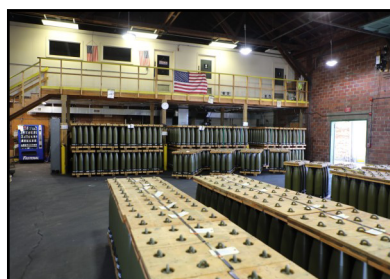
Army housing tenant survey informs Army action plans

SDDC pioneers Army adoption of PFAS-free firefighting gear

SCOTT AIR FORCE BASE, Ill. – The Military Surface Deployment and Distribution Command's 596th Transportation Brigade marked a historic milestone in firefighter safety and health protection by being the first Army unit to fully transition to PFAS-free bunker gear. Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances, commonly known as PFAS or "forever chemicals," have long been used in firefighting turnout gear due to their water- and heat-resistant properties. Recognizing the danger, SDDC leaders initiated a transition to PFAS-free structural firefighting gear at Military Ocean Terminals Sunny Point, North Carolina, and Concord, California.

Contracting support of mobilization force generation bases

FORT STEWART, Ga. – While Soldiers prepare to deploy and logistics teams coordinate movement, a vital force works behind the scenes to ensure mission success: the contracting professionals of the 904th Contracting Battalion and U.S. Army Mission and Installation Contracting Command office at Fort Stewart.
