Off-Base Housing:

Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change ONLY affects tenant personnel residing offbase that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples **Housing Service Center (HSC)** prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.

The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

Your Questions Answered

What if the landlord refuses to return the

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?

No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

Radon Awareness: 5 Things you Need to Know

On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water

How will I know if there is radon in my house? Can I smell it?

No, radon is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. The only way to detect radon is through testing.

How can I test my home if I live in a government owned/controlled unit?

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested. If you ever receive notification from the base that your home or office space has elevated levels of radon above the EPA and Navy action level (4 picocuries per liter or higher), or have health concerns about exposure to radon, please contact your medical provider.

How can I test my home if I live off-base on the economy?

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense. The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

What are the health impacts of radon?

Although radon exposure is the second-leading environmental cause of lung cancer death (after tobacco smoke), the benefit of screening for lung cancer has not been established. Currently, no effective, community-wide medical screening tests are recommended for the medical prevention or early diagnosis and treatment of radon-induced lung cancer. The U.S. Preventive Task Force Services does now recommend annual low-dose chest CT scanning in asymptomatic adults aged 50-80 who have a long smoking history regardless of any radon

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled

RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).



Effective October 1, 2025, Patriot Express (Rotator) flights to and from NSA Naples will be discontinued. The U.S. Transportation Command has determined, following a comprehensive study, that commercial flights offer a more cost-effective alternative. After this date, Permanent Change of Station (PCS) travel will utilize governmentprocured commercial transportation.

For DoD personnel and their families, prudent official travel planning in and out of the Naples area is paramount. Understanding travel requirements and the available options are key in travel planning. Working with your command travel office (Admin) and your chain of command can help set expectations and manage your travel needs efficiently.

In-Focus: Air Quality in Naples

Checking Air Quality Outdoor

The website hyperlink below provides real-time data on Naples' Air Quality Index (AQI) to help residents understand pollution levels and potential health implications. AQI is a measure of air pollution on a scale where higher numbers indicate poorer air quality. The AQI levels are divided into categories: Good (0-50), Moderate (51-100), Poor (101-200), Unhealthy (201-300), Severe (301-400), and Hazardous (401-500).

The dashboard displays AQI readings across various locations in Naples, showing areas with higher pollution. Additional insights like health recommendations (e.g., wearing masks, using air purifiers) and historical AQI trends are also included, helping residents make informed decisions about outdoor activities. This is not an endorsement of this website, but an effort to keep our community here in Naples informed on the environmental conditions where we live.

Air Quality in Naples – Sources

Vehicle emissions are among the primary contributors to Naples' air pollution. The city's dense traffic and reliance on cars and motorbikes result in high levels of NO_2 and other harmful pollutants that affect air quality, especially during peak travel times.

In addition, less frequent, natural events, like wildfires in Naples, contribute to air pollution and environmental damage.

Addressing these issues requires coordinated efforts between local authorities, industries, and the community to reduce pollution and to mitigate its long-term environmental impacts. It is also important to note the U.S. Naval Hospital Naples does not test or monitor the outdoor air quality across the region.

What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.



Carney Park Pool Gets Modern Upgrade, **Reopens for Naples Families**

> encompasses archaeological areas like Pompei and Ercolano. All places rich in art, culture and charm, absolutely not to be missed.


Sunday at the Museum involves not only metropolitan Naples but the whole of Campania, with many other important artistic and cultural sites featured in the initiative. A clear example is the Campi Flegrei Archaeological Museum in the Castle of Baia, one of the flagships of the Bacoli area. Not only Naples, Salerno also answers the call of Domenica al Museo. In fact, among the various sites, access to the Paestum

Archaeological Park will be free every first Sundays of the month.

The scheme will run on the following dates: September 7th, October 5th, November 2nd, and December 7th. To avoid crowds, try to plan to visit the museums early in the day, pick two or three that interest you the most, and are easily accessible by public transportation or within walking distance from each other.

The beauty of this initiative lies in the diverse range of artworks and historical artifacts, from ancient Roman relics to modern art pieces.

30 Day Notice to Terminate Base Housing

It is important to know that if you are leaving base housing for any reason, including PCS you are required to give 30 day notice and you must contact the assignment office to schedule an appointment to do an intent to vacate.

1st Appointment at Housing Service center

- The Assignment office is located at the Support Site Facility Building 2072 and is open Monday through Friday, from 7:45: a.m. Until 3:45p.m. Contact the office at DSN 629-4930 to schedule your first appointment.
- Bring a copy of your PCS orders to this first appointment. You will complete an "Intent to Vacate" notice and schedule your preliminary and final inspections. The Assignment Counselor will arrange for loaner furniture to be delivered and picked up. These appointments are by appointment only. Housing is unable to assist on a walk in basis.

2nd Appointment at your Apartment

- During the pre-inspection of your home, the Housing representative will inform you of what will be expected at the final checkout, as well as take notes of needed repairs. During the pre-inspection, be sure to ask any questions you may have concerning items that have been lost or damaged. This inspection will take approximately 60 minutes.
- Please make arrangements to keep this pre-inspection appointment. Missing the appointment will slow up the vacating process.

3rd Appointment at your Apartment

- You must have a final inspection of your home in order to complete your requirements for vacating government quarters before PCSing. To complete the final inspection it is important to have all personal property removed prior to your scheduled appointment.
- At the final inspection a Housing representative will examine the residence in the following areas: condition and cleanliness of quarters; and inventory, condition and cleanliness of government equipment, appliances and loaner furniture. During the final inspection, you will sign a memorandum indicating the date that you passed your final inspection and vacated quarters.
- Following your final inspection you will need to report to the Assignment Office for your final BAH and signature of the check-out sheet.

Bulk Trash Service

Bulk waste is not permitted on or around any dumpsters or trash enclosures-including those at the NEX and DODEA facilities.

Residents can schedule a pick-ups for large items like furniture, old mattresses, electronics and other bulky waste.

Room Inspections

Room inspections are conducted by the resident's command, RAs, and/ or UH staff. Residents are responsible for the cleanliness of their assigned room, bathroom, common areas, and the passageway directly outside their room. Some of the standards used to determine cleanliness:

- 1. The bed is neatly made.
- 2. Floors are clean.
- 3. Carpeted areas and rugs are vacuumed
- 4. No gear adrift.
- 5. Dusted and polished furniture.
- 6. All food is stored in sealed containers.
- 7. Trash cans are clean and empty.


Summer in Campania is a kaleidoscope of colors, sounds, and crowds. Beaches are packed, villages come alive with festivals, and even the smallest piazzas echo with laughter, music, and the scent of grilled food. But come September, something magical happens — the region exhales.

The tourists disappear, the air cools down, and Campania reveals its quieter, more authentic soul. For those stationed here in Gricignano or nearby, September is actually one of the best months to explore. This is when the Amalfi Coast becomes walkable again, when you can visit a vineyard and actually talk to the winemaker, when local artisans have time to share their stories, and when the light over the countryside feels golden, softer — almost nostalgic. Looking for a peaceful weekend trip? Head to Sant'Agata de' Goti, a stunning medieval village perched on a cliff, just under an hour from base.


With its narrow alleys, ancient churches, and panoramic views, it's the kind of place that feels like a time capsule — and in September, it's yours to explore without the summer rush. Or visit the Campi Flegrei area — Pozzuoli, Baia, and Cuma — where volcanic landscapes meet ancient Roman ruins, natural hot springs, and sleepy fishing harbors. The sea is still warm, but the crowds are gone. It's history and nature at your fingertips. And if you're up for something more rustic, take a drive inland to explore the Matese Mountains.

There you'll find cool forests, lakes, and shepherd villages where time really does move slower. Try the local cheeses, maybe even watch them being made. In these areas, September is also the season of grape harvest — la vendemmia — and if you're lucky, you might stumble into a celebration. What's beautiful about this time of year is not just the change in weather — it's the shift in rhythm. You're not rushing to check places off a list. You're wandering. Pausing. Noticing the details. So this September, I invite you to do something different: pick a town on the map you've never heard of. Ask a local where they go on weekends. Follow the smell of bread from a village bakery. You might not find a five-star review — but you'll find a story.

And those are the best kind.



Tenant Commands are encouraged to add "RLSO Legal Clearance Checkout" in their respective Command Checkout Sheet to ensure all personnel meet this important requirement.

Before departing Italy on PCS orders, all personnel must complete the following checkout procedures:

All Military Personnel: Check out with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Offices:

- 1. Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (SJA), NSA Naples: Checkout in person. You must have completed your check out with MVRO before coming to legal. Contact Ms. Tiziana Orso Tiziana.orso.ln@us.navy.mil if you have questions. Located on the first deck, Admin II, NSA
- 2. Foreign Criminal Jurisdiction Department: You can checkout via email. Contact Mr. Gianluca Marino at marino.gianluca.ln@us.navy.mil

DoD Civilians, Military with Dependents, and Contractors: Check out in-person with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office AND return your Sojourner's Permit. Failure to return the permit will prevent checkout authorization. Located on the first deck, Admin II, Room 1074, NSA Naples, Capodichino.

On average 3,300 children are injured with 8 fatalities, each year in the U.S. from window falls.






Safety starts at home

Teach children about window safety, ensure window fall protection devices are installed correctly and always engaged.

Familiarize yourself with available resources



Window safety devices only work when properly install and engaged. Ensuring they're engaged is a simple step that can prevent tragedy. If you find any broken or missing devices in military housing, contact Navy Housing immediately. If off base contact your landlord directly or purchase and install in your own home.





Windows are not playgrounds

Teach children that windows are not safe to play near or lean against. Explain the potential danger in a way they understand. "Windows are for looking, not touching."



Window screens are designed to keep insects out, not to prevent falls. Teach children to not push on or lean against window screens.



Check twice and watch always

Make a habit out of checking windows during your daily routine. When you open or close the curtains, before you turn the lights off, etc. Most importantly keep toys and furniture away from windows to prevent climbing.

Designate safe play areas

from windows. Never leave open windows unsupervised, especially when children are present.

Outage of Smoking Area near Mobile Bar


The Smoking Area/Gazebo located near the Mobile Bar will remain closed until project completion, anticipated summer 2026.



Where does the Commissary get its meat products?

PROUDLY PREPARED AND PACKAGED BY COMMISSARY STAFF IN

OUR VERY OWN EUROPE-BASED MEAT PROCESSING PLANT

Shoppers are amazed to learn that the USDA-approved Natural and Choice beef we sell in the commissaries in Europe and the Middle East are shipped here from the U.S. Even more surprising, is that the retail cuts of beef are fresh, never frozen. This is accomplished through the use of vacuum packaging.

What are the advantages of vacuum packaging?

- Because oxygen is removed, the shelf life of vacuum-packaged red meat increases from a matter of days to at least two weeks.
- Vacuum packaging allows natural enzymes to act as a natural tenderizer and enhances quality/palatability of beef.
- Without the vacuum technology, most locations would have only frozen meat products.

Beef gets its red color from exposure to oxygen. In our vacuum packing process, we remove over 99% of the oxygen from the package. The lack of oxygen turns the meat a darker color but the meat will return back to the usual red-color once the package is opened and is, once again, exposed to oxygen.

The vacuum package does not allow for any air in or out. This can cause naturally occurring lactic acid to build up inside the package. Shortly after opening the package, the initial off-odor will dissipate.

This process does not affect the quality of the meat or taste and acts as a natural meat tenderizer.

The Central Meat Processing Plant's state-of-the-art facility features highly efficient meat processing and vacuum machines. metal detectors and X-ray machines, a flash freezer, and hightech cleaning systems. USDA Beef is cut, ground, packaged, vacuum sealed, and shipped from Kaiserslautern Cold Storage to our overseas locations. Fresh pork is sourced locally from German locations and processed under the same strict guidelines. Commissaries receive shipments an average of every two to three days, depending on the size and sales volume of the location.

Just as you can go to a stateside commissary and place a special order for pork or beef, you can do the same here in Europe. You can simply request a special order from the commissary at the meat department or front-end department by filling out a specialorder form if you are looking for a large quantity or a special cut.

Special order lead times vary depending on the request but a majority can be filled within days. Large quantity requests may take up to eight weeks. Whole pigs require a 10-day lead time. Check with your commissary for details.























