Honoring Our Nation's Fallen: 9/11 Boot Memorial 2025

Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam volunteers placed more than 9,000 combat boots on Ford Island's Luke Field last week to honor fallen service members who made the ultimate sacrifice since Sept. 11, 2001. Each boot includes a photo of the fallen hero, their name, branch, and the date and location of their passing. The poignant tributes tell the stories of individuals who once stood in service to our nation — in combat, in garrison, and in non-combat roles.

The USS America (LHA 6) arrived at Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam on Monday. America is operating in the U.S. 3rd Fleet area of operations. U.S. 3rd Fleet leads naval forces in the Indo-Pacific and provides the training necessary to execute the U.S. Navy's role across the full spectrum of military operations. U.S. 3rd Fleet works with allies and partners to advance freedom of navigation and overflight, and other principles that underpin security for the Indo-Pacific region.

This Week in History: September 15, 1938

Hickam Field is officially activated on Sept. 15, 1938. The new airfield served as an important point in the defensive triangle between Hawaii, Alaska, and the Panama Canal. The air base was attacked on Dec. 7, 1941, and served as an aviation hub for U.S. forces in the Pacific throughout World War II. Hickam Air Force Base merged with the naval base at Pearl Harbor in October 2010 becoming Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam.
