NSA Naples Retrieves Radon Detectors After Year of Testing

NAPLES, Italy — As part of the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), U.S. Naval Support Activity (NSA) Naples, Italy, began retrieving radon detectors on Sep. 22, 2025, following a year-long test to determine indoor radon gas concentrations.

Radon is a colorless, odorless gas that occurs naturally from rocks and soils. It is present in outdoor air but may collect in basements or ground level spaces.

A team of contractors from Nicklaus Engineer, Inc began collecting the radon detectors from Navy facilities located on-base. Radon detectors have been placed in basements and ground-level indoor spaces inhabited at least four hours daily.

The radon detectors, called alpha-track detectors, were placed in August 2024. Indoor environments are commonly studied to determine whether radon is present at high concentrations.

Long-term exposure to radon gas at high concentrations can potentially impact health over time. Testing is the only way to determine indoor radon concentrations.

“If we find an issue in any of our spaces, we will work to correct it as soon as possible,” said John Ladd, NSA Naples environmental director. “Elevated indoor radon levels may easily be mitigated by adjusting ventilation to spaces or upgrading building foundations.”

Results from the study are not expected to be available until February 2026. NSA Naples will publish the results.

Non-Residential Navy facilities in NSA Naples were last tested in 2013-2015, but since 2015, base infrastructure has changed and new buildings that have been built. Residential buildings at NSA Naples were lasted tested in 2022-2023.

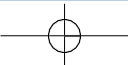
NSA Naples Welcomes Battalion Fire Chief

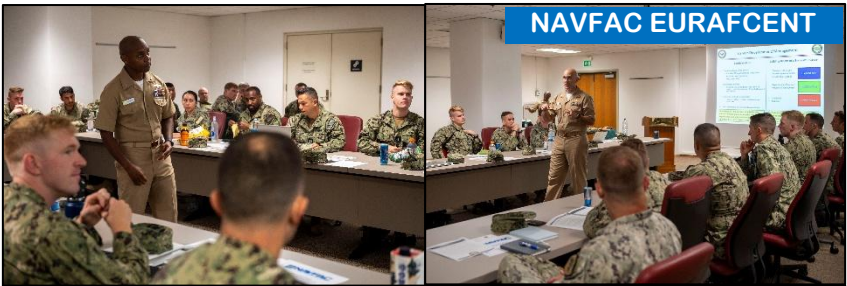

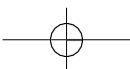

Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change **ONLY** affects tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.

The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

Your Questions Answered

What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?

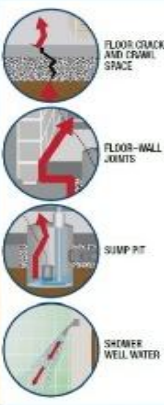
No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

Radon Awareness: How Radon Enters Homes

On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.

Radon can enter your home in many ways:

- Cracks in solid floors
- Construction joints
- Cracks in walls
- Gaps in suspended floors
- Gaps around service pipes
- Cavities inside walls
- The water supply

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense. The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units. RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).

NSA Naples Child and Youth Program Supports NAS Sigonella After Fire



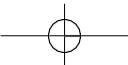
NSA Naples Child and Youth Program (CYP) recently rallied to assist the Naval Air Station Sigonella Child Development Center (CDC) after a fire severely disrupted the facility's operations.

In the days following the incident, Naples CYP collected and shipped educational toys, art supplies, furniture and other essential items to help restore the center's ability to care for and educate children of military families stationed at Sigonella.

The effort was aimed at ensuring children could return as quickly as possible to a safe and enriching environment.

Naples CYP Director, Catherine Szymanski Prestonise said "The swift response highlights the close-knit nature of the military childcare community, where programs across installations often step in to support one another during crises."

Thanks to the donated supplies, Sigonella's CDC was able to resume normal operations, allowing children to return to learning in a fully equipped setting.

In-Focus: Water Quality in Naples

Drinking Water On-Base

One of Naples Public Health Evaluation’s enduring processes is water safety which seeks to ensure that drinking water at all NSA Naples installations is tested and monitored routinely to ensure the water is fit for human consumption. The drinking water is tested in accordance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Italian and Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) monitoring requirements on a daily, monthly, quarterly, and annual basis to ensure compliance with standards and be able to declare the water is fit for human consumption.

For instance, in 2024, NSA Naples collected 496 drinking water samples and performed over 6,300 tests in three categories: Chemical, more than 3,700 tests looking for over 180 chemical parameters; Bacteriological, more than 700 tests looking for over 5 Microbiological parameters; and Field Measurements, more than 1,800 tests looking for six field parameters. The tests looked specifically for 191 contaminants in five major groups: microbial contaminants; pesticides and herbicides; inorganic contaminants; organic chemical contaminants, and radioactive contaminants.

The health and well-being of all personnel and families in Naples is the base’s top priority. Routine testing ensures compliance with drinking water standards that are required to declare the water as fit for human consumption. The base is committed to keeping the military family fully informed through timely dissemination of credible information with complete transparency.

Water Sources, Testing, Treatment

The drinking water Consumer Confidence Reports (CCR) outlines all the water sources, testing and treatment process for NSA Naples installations: Capodichino, Support Site, SATCOM Lago Patria, Carney Park, and Gaeta Olde Mill Inn. The CCR is an annual on-base water quality report that a water system is required to provide every year to its customers. This is just like any public water system in the United States. The CCR helps people make informed choices about the water they drink. Drinking Water Off-Base

Unlike on-base, the water quality cannot be verified at each off-base location or residence. As a precautionary measure, all personnel who live off-base are provided with bottled water for consumption. Bottled water is provided through housing lease provisions for all personnel living off-base. What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area’s waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

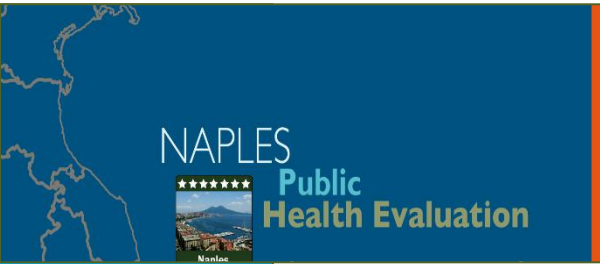

Fact Sheet: Water Consumption for Off-Base Housing



If you rent a property in the economy, it is important to know about POTABLE WATER. The rental unit must be supplied with city water. **It is also extremely forbidden to supply the property with well water.** The penalty will be the immediate termination of the contract.

The landlord will provide potable water **every month** and must obtain receipts from the tenant.

The landlord will choose how to supply the water: either with bottled water or installing a water cooler system. In both cases, the company must be one of the NSA Naples-approved service sources, please see below:

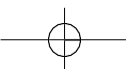
- Acqua Minerale San Benedetto S.p.A
- Acque Minerali d’ Italia S.p.A
- Culligan Vicenza AAFES Water Plant
- Gran Guizza S.p.A San Pellegrino S.p.A
- Acqua Vera San Pellegrino S.p.A
- Levissima Plant Spumador S.p.A



The landlord will provide the necessary amount of bottled water and/or containers of water for the cooler according to family composition, as indicated in the orders, **four liters per day per person as per NSA Naples guidelines. Bottled Waters should be used for drinking/ cooking purposes.**

Unauthorized Businesses on Support Site

Per *NAVSUPPACT Naples Instruction 1740.4A*, operating any form of in-home business from government quarters is strictly prohibited. This includes activities such as selling goods, providing services, or conducting commercial transactions from your assigned residence. While many families look for ways to supplement their income, conducting business from within government housing poses security, safety, and community concerns. It can also conflict with host-nation agreements and military regulations.

What This Means for Residents:

- * Running a business of any kind from your quarters is not authorized.
- * Violating this policy may result in loss of housing privileges and termination of government quarters.
- * This rule applies regardless of whether the business is in-person (e.g., childcare, hair services, food sales) or online but using your residence as a business on base.

Room Inspections

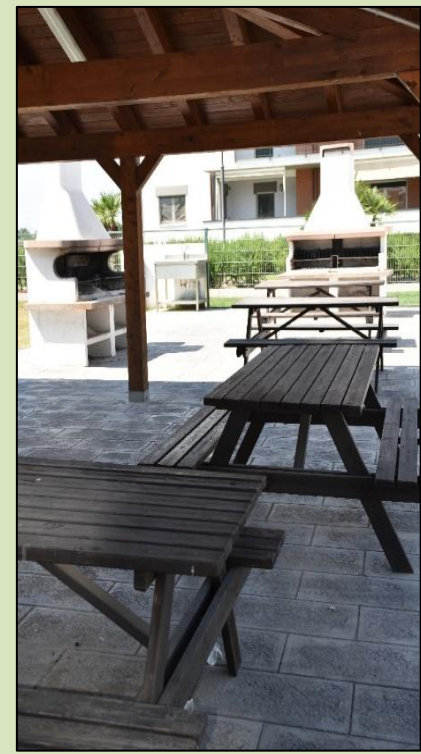
Room inspections are conducted by the resident's command, RAs, and/ or UH staff. Residents are responsible for the cleanliness of their assigned room, bathroom, common areas, and the passageway directly outside their room. Some of the standards used to determine cleanliness:

1. The bed is neatly made.
2. Floors are clean.
3. Carpeted areas and rugs are vacuumed
4. No gear adrift.
5. Dusted and polished furniture.
6. All food is stored in sealed containers.
7. Trash cans are clean and empty.

Local Lens: Harvest Time: Experience the Italian Vendemmia

October in Italy means more than cooler days and falling leaves – it’s the season of the vendemmia, the grape harvest that has shaped Italian life for centuries. In Campania, vineyards burst with activity as families, farmers, and friends gather to pick grapes and celebrate the land’s bounty.

For those living in Naples, Avellino, Gricignano or nearby, this is a perfect moment to step into a tradition that blends work, festivity, and community spirit. Just a short drive away, you’ll find the vineyards of Falerno del Massico, where Romans once praised the wine; the rolling hills of Irpinia, home to bold reds and crisp whites; and the Asprinio vines around Aversa, famous for their dramatic tall trees that require ladders to harvest.

Many wineries in these areas welcome visitors during harvest time. Some offer “vendemmia experiences,” where you can join locals in the fields, scissors in hand, to cut bunches of grapes straight from the vine. Others organize open days with tastings, music, and long tables filled with regional food. It’s not only about wine—it’s about sharing a piece of Italian life.

Joining a vendemmia is surprisingly hands-on and family-friendly. Children can help collect grapes, while adults might sample fresh mosto (grape juice before fermentation) or enjoy a glass of last year’s vintage as the sun sets over the vineyards. The atmosphere is festive, filled with laughter, clinking glasses, and the scent of earth and fruit.

Just remember, reserve in advance, as spaces are limited. Wear comfortable shoes and clothes that can handle a bit of dirt. Bring your camera: the golden vines and baskets brimming with grapes make unforgettable memories.

In Italy, wine is never just a drink—it’s a story of tradition, community, and celebration. Experiencing the vendemmia is a way to taste that story, one grape at a time.

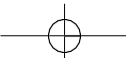

Grant Program for Military Members

Tenant Commands are encouraged to add "RLSO Legal Clearance Checkout" in their respective Command Checkout Sheet to ensure all personnel meet this important requirement.

Before departing Italy on PCS orders, all personnel must complete the following checkout procedures:

All Military Personnel: Check out with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Offices:

1. Office of the Staff Judge Advocate (SJA), NSA Naples: Checkout in person. You must have completed your check out with MVRO before coming to legal. Contact Ms. Tiziana Orso Tiziana.orso.ln@us.navy.mil if you have questions. Located on the first deck, Admin II, NSA Naples, Capodichino.
2. Foreign Criminal Jurisdiction Department: You can checkout via email. Contact Mr. Gianluca Marino at marino.gianluca.ln@us.navy.mil

DoD Civilians, Military with Dependents, and Contractors: Check out in-person with the RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance Office AND return your Sojourner's Permit. Failure to return the permit will prevent checkout authorization. Located on the first deck, Admin II, Room 1074, NSA Naples, Capodichino. Contact napleslegalassistance@us.navy.mil or +39 (081) 568-4576 with questions.

Checking out with legal and returning your Sojourner's Permits ensures compliance with Italian immigration law and maintains a positive relationship with Italy.
