We couldn’t be more thankful for our community partners and volunteers who showed out and provided resource tables, valuable information, first aid, hydration, snacks, and wellness support to participants!



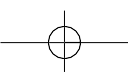
**Ambassador of the Republic of Korea visited JFC Naples**

# Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

*This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.*

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

This change **ONLY** affects tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.

Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.

The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

## Your Questions Answered

**What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?**

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

**Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?**

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.

**Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?**

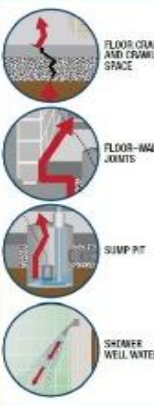
No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

## Radon Awareness: How Radon Enters Homes

*On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.*

Radon can enter your home in many ways:

- Cracks in solid floors
- Construction joints
- Cracks in walls
- Gaps in suspended floors
- Gaps around service pipes
- Cavities inside walls
- The water supply

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense. The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

**While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units. RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).**

# Naples Public Health Evaluation

## In-Focus: Food Safety in Naples

### Food Inspection On-Base

One of Naples Public Health Evaluation’s enduring processes is food safety, which seeks to ensure that food sold at the Commissary on U.S. Naval Support Activity, Naples Support Site is safe to eat and undergoes a rigorous process by the U.S. Army Veterinary Command (VETCOM) who serve as the local food inspectors before entering the store to be sold. The Commissary has labeled the fresh produce to inform shoppers of the area from which the produce is grown. Much of the produce in the Commissary is from Germany and Northern Italy.

### Continuous Food Safety Monitoring

Food provided on base is monitored on an ongoing basis. The U.S. Naval Hospital Naples Preventive Medicine routinely inspects all dining facilities on base to ensure that food is properly stored, maintained, and prepared. In accordance with Department of Defense Directive 6400.4, VETCOM ensures inspectors are stationed in the Commissary and consistently monitor food products; all food products are from VETCOM-approved sources that have been inspected; buying from approved sources is required for all meat, dairy, eggs, prepared vegetables and bottled water (fresh produce is exempt in Western Europe); proper facility sanitation; personal hygiene practices of food service workers; and education of food service managers and employees about food safety.

### Food Inspections Off-Base

The U.S. Government does not inspect restaurants or supermarkets off-base. Italy has a system in place to inspect Italian food facilities, markets, and suppliers. However, the health and well-being of all personnel and families in Naples is the base’s top priority. VETCOM inspects Italian food manufacturing facilities producing food that is supplied to U.S. military installations.

### Food Safety Tips

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services provides valuable sanitary practices that can apply wherever you live in the world:

- Wash fresh fruits and vegetables thoroughly with potable water prior to eating or cooking.
- Immune-compromised people should consume only cooked fruits and vegetables.
- Use separate cutting boards, plates and utensils for uncooked and cooked meats to avoid cross-contamination.
- Use a food thermometer to make sure meat is cooked to a safe temperature.
- Refrigerate hot or cold leftover food within two hours of being served. Keep leftovers for three to four days when properly refrigerated.

### What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

### What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

## Your Health: Facts for Families in Naples

### About: Food On and Off-Base

*The U.S. Navy is committed to ensuring our families are safe while serving our country at home or overseas. The following information is provided as part of a wide-ranging effort to understand the health risks of our personnel and families living in Naples, Italy. A comprehensive Public Health Evaluation was conducted to assess potential short and long-term health risks associated with living in the Naples area (see left panel). In line with our commitment to continually share important health information, we encourage you to review the following information.*

In 2007, numerous reports of high dioxin levels and other chemicals in air, water, and soil created a concern amongst the U.S. Navy community that foods grown in the Campania region could be contaminated. Articles in newspapers and in some Italian scientific journals alleged links between adverse health effects and the toxic waste dumps in the Campania region. These articles implicated locally grown vegetables, fruits, and mozzarella di bufala as possibly contaminated foods.

As part of the Navy’s overall efforts to be protective of the health of U.S. military and civilian personnel and their families in Naples, the Navy and U.S. Army Veterinary Command (VETCOM) conducted an investigation of foods produced in the Campania region and sold in the Naples Gricignano D’Aversa Navy Commissary (Commissary). The food study was performed in February 2008.

VETCOM is the Department of Defense executive agent for food safety and quality assurance and is responsible for providing direct assistance to all DOD agencies requiring support with respect to food safety and food defense.

*Although there are multiple layers of health protection already in place for U.S. personnel purchasing food items at the Commissary, the presumed higher potential for environmental contaminants to be present in the Campania region led the Naples Public Health Evaluation team to conduct a food study. The study went beyond routine inspections of food products by performing various laboratory analyses, which are normally not mandated by VETCOM. Foods grown locally, particularly fresh fruits and vegetables, received a closer look.*

Using the above criteria, an assessment of the Commissary was conducted. Products that met the food study criteria and were thus evaluated in the study included:

- Artichokes
- Celery
- Spinach
- Cabbage
- Chicken
- Carrots
- Mushrooms

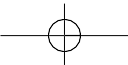

# Housing Bits

### Bulk Trash Pick-Up

Support Site residents have the convenience of scheduling bulk trash pick-ups to remove larger items, such as discarded holiday decorations, worn-out furniture, and other bulky materials that accumulate. This service aims to simplify the process of waste disposal and contribute to a cleaner, more organized neighborhood.

To take advantage of this service, simply follow these steps:

1. **Schedule Your Pick-Up:** Please contact the trouble desk at (+39) 081-811-4285/4286 DSN: 629-4285/4286 or visit submit a request via our QR code.

Bulk waste is not permitted on or around dumpsters or trash enclosures-including those at the NEX and DODEA facilities. If you are PCSing and unable to get an appointment in time please communicate with your zone manager for further instructions.

### Mold & Mildew

- 1. **Prioritize Ventilation:** Cement walls don’t breathe the same way natural materials like wood do, so it’s critical to help air circulate. Open your windows daily—even just for 10–15 minutes—and use exhaust fans in bathrooms and kitchens. Cross-ventilation works wonders.
- 2. **Use a Dehumidifier:** Italian summers and rainy winters can spike indoor humidity. A dehumidifier helps keep levels below 60%, which discourages mold. Bonus: it makes your home feel cooler in summer and cozier in winter. If you reside on support site and would like a dehumidifier these can be picked up at the Teverola warehouse for use.
- 3. **Watch for Cold Spots:** Mold loves condensation. If certain corners or exterior walls feel noticeably cooler, it might be worth insulating those areas or rearranging furniture to allow better airflow.
- 4. **Don’t Hang Dry Laundry Indoors (if possible):** It’s tempting to hang clothes indoors during wet seasons, but this pumps extra moisture into the air. If you must dry inside, do it near a window or dehumidifier.
- 5. **Address Leaks Quickly:** Check your plumbing and rooftop for drips or leaks—especially if you’re building is older. Even a small seep behind the wall can feed mold colonies out of sight. If you live on support site and notice a leak please contact housing maintenance immediately.

### Direct Move in Program

NSA Naples Housing offers a direct move-in program that allows you to avoid TLA and move directly into a Military Family Housing (MFH) unit upon your arrival. To take advantage of this program, you will be required to submit an advanced housing application package and have your sponsor contact the Family Housing Assignment Office two weeks prior to your arrival. Your sponsor will coordinate your assignment, schedule/accept the delivery of loaner furniture and pick up your keys. Note that this program can only be offered when quarters are available in your wait list category.

### Housing Early Assistance Tool (HEAT)

The Housing Early Assistance Tool (HEAT) assists Service Members and their families in applying for housing Navy wide. HEAT allows Service Members and their families to get the housing application process started at one or more Navy installations online before or after they receive their permanent change of station orders. HEAT is available to any Service Member at all Navy installations. HEAT creates an easy user experience to connect with your destination. Spouses can use the application as well, needing only minimal information about their Service Member. A housing referral professional will be in touch within 2 business days.

## Unnacompanied Housing Bits

### Room Inspections

Room inspections are conducted by the resident’s command, RAs, and/ or UH staff. Residents are responsible for the cleanliness of their assigned room, bathroom, common areas, and the passageway directly outside their room. Some of the standards used to determine cleanliness:

- 1. The bed is neatly made.
- 2. Floors are clean.
- 3. Carpeted areas and rugs are vacuumed
- 4. No gear adrift.
- 5. Dusted and polished furniture.
- 6. All food is stored in sealed containers.
- 7. Trash cans are clean and empty.

To reserve the BBQ pit, please contact the UH front desk to check availability and schedule your preferred time. Reservations are made on a first come, first-served basis, so we encourage you to book early to secure your spot. Please ensure the BBQ pit is cleaned and all trash is disposed of after use to keep the area enjoyable for everyone!



### Trouble Call Escalation

If you have already submitted a trouble ticket and it has not yet been handled or resolved, please stop by the UH front desk-we want to assist you! Our team will work with you to escalate the trouble call and ensure it gets the attention it needs. Additionally, if you feel you need further support please contact your building manager so we can work together to resolve.

- Follow-Up Work: Additional repairs, if needed, will resume no later than the next working day as an urgent call.

Put live trees in a safe area of the room, away from any source of heat. Keep the tree in a container of water with sand, or moist earth. Live trees should be watered daily. Do not place trees near an entrance/exit or doors or stairwells. Decorations must be removed by 10 January. Trees should be removed soon after the holidays. Use only approved electrical not worn or frayed. Dispose trash dumpsters.

### Fall Preventative Maintenance Schedule

We want to remind you of the importance of being home or ensuring your furry friends are safely tucked away in kennels on the scheduled PMI day.

Our maintenance team will be conducting a PMI on the listed dates. They must enter all the homes listed. Scheduled maintenance helps keep our community in top-notch condition, ensuring your homes are comfortable and running smoothly. By completing these routine checks, we can address any potential issues before they become major headaches. Remember, your cooperation is invaluable in maintaining the quality of life we all enjoy here. It is a collective effort that keeps our community thriving.

Theater is about more than words—it’s music, movement, emotion, and atmosphere.

Even if you don’t catch every phrase, you’ll still experience the magic of the performance, just as locals do. From ballet in Naples, to classic theater in Caserta, to family stories in Capua, November evenings in Campania are filled with performances that locals cherish. Whether you’re drawn to timeless tradition or simply want to share a night out with friends, the theater is where locals gather to celebrate culture, community, and the joy of storytelling.

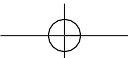

## OCONUS Emergency Travel Assistance Grant

## LEGAL CORNER

### UPDATE ON THE ELECTRONIC SOJOURNER'S PERMIT PROCESS IN ITALY!

**ATTENTION:** All current Sojourner's permit holders and first-time applicants to include GS Civilians, DoD Contractors, and all dependents, may be affected by a new processing procedure. **Note: Active-duty Service members do not require a Sojourner's Permit**, but please review this information carefully, as it may affect your dependents.

The U.S. State Sending Office met with the Italian Ministry of Interior Directorate of Immigration and the Italian Border Police to discuss the implementation of the new electronic Sojourner's Permit (*permesso di soggiorno elettronico*). Topics discussed included the new requirements that accompany the electronic Sojourner's Permit process and potential appropriate locations for the application processing.

### What Does This Mean for Our Naples Community?

At this time, the Immigration offices of Naples and Caserta have suspended all processing of renewals and first-time applications for U.S. personnel until further guidance is received from the Italian Ministry of Interior. These offices are preparing for a significant increase in workload over the coming months, as they will be required to process:

1. New applications and renewals
2. Applications to convert all existing paper Sojourner's Permits into electronic cards.

### What Do You Need To Do Now?

RLSO EURAFCENT Legal Assistance office is still collecting first-time and renewal applications.

1. If you have recently submitted your paperwork for a first-time application or a renewal application, you do not need to take further action now. We will notify you via email on the next steps, according to instructions from the Immigration office.
2. If you already have a current paper Sojourner's Permit, you do not need to take further action now. You will be contacted by our office when it is time to begin the process to convert it into an electronic permit, according to instructions from the Immigration office.
3. If you have a paper Sojourner's Permit that expires between now and December, you must book an appointment through [napleslegalassistance@us.navy.mil](mailto:napleslegalassistance@us.navy.mil) for a renewal request appointment. Our specialist will collect the required paperwork for the application, but **you** will hold onto your paper permit until processing is reinitiated at the appropriate Immigration office.
