Retired NFL players Seneca Wallace and Prince Amukamara will be touring with Armed Forces Entertainment (AFE) for Service Showdown, a special event series in celebration of the 2025 Army-Navy college football game. The tour features meet-and-greet opportunities with the players and includes three events from December 6–9, 2025, in Guantanamo Bay.

NFL quarterback Seneca Wallace played for multiple teams, including the Seattle Seahawks, Cleveland Browns and Green Bay Packers. After being drafted by the Seahawks in 2003, he threw 4,808 passing yards, 31 touchdowns, and 18 interceptions in his career, with an overall passer rating of 81.3 percent. He also had 293 career rushing yards and is known for being a versatile and mobile quarterback who helped lead his teams to important victories during his decade-long career.

Prince Amukamara left his mark on the NFL as a cornerback, with a career playing for multiple teams, including the New York Giants, Jacksonville Jaguars and Chicago Bears. After winning the Super Bowl during his rookie season with the Giants, he went on to achieve 477 career tackles, 10 interceptions, six forced fumbles and two defensive touchdowns, contributing to a notable decade-long career in the league.
