

## Naples Area Security Working Group Convenes to Foster Local Law Enforcement Collaboration

The Naples Area Security Working Group (NASWG) recently gathered onboard U.S. Naval Support Activity (NSA) Naples to explore opportunities for strengthening partnerships with local law enforcement agencies and other security entities in the Naples area.

This quarterly meeting brought together a diverse group of security experts, including representatives from Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (EURAFCENT), NSA Naples, the U.S. Consulate Naples, NCIS, and several Italian law enforcement agencies including the Carabinieri.

"NASWG is an enduring collaborative approach to reduce property crimes of opportunity for Naval Support Activity and supported commands, Joint Forces Command Naples, and U.S. Consulate community members," said Lt. Cmdr. Dary Sampy, NASWG chair and NSA Naples security officer.

The working group collects reported crime data and perform trend analysis to create products which will educate and inform the community on crime statistics and prevention techniques.

The NASWG is a key component of the Naples Area Security Committee (NASC). The NASC plays a vital role in promoting a safer community through education, awareness, information sharing, and policy development. The NASC is comprised of two main bodies: the Naples Area Executive Steering Council (ESC) and the NASWG. The ESC, which includes senior leaders from the U.S. Consulate in Naples, NAVEURAF, Allied Joint Force Command, and NSA Naples, provides strategic guidance on policy development.

One of the NASWG's flagship initiatives is the quarterly Naples Area Crime Trend Report. This report provides valuable insights into crime trends and patterns in the Naples area, enabling community members to stay informed and aware of their surroundings. By regularly monitoring and analyzing crime data,

the NASWG helps to ensure that community members, prospective personnel and families can make informed decisions about their safety and security.

The group encourages community members to take safety precautions, such as not leaving valuables visible in homes or vehicles and always locking windows and doors, especially at night or when away.


## News in Brief: Around the Installation

# Off-Base Housing: Security Deposits Transitioning to Electronic Payments

*This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.*

At the direction of higher headquarters, Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT), NSA Naples is transitioning to electronic fund transfer (EFT) for off-base housing security deposit to ensure that our personnel living off-base can expect the same processes and standards they would experience at all other DoD bases across the world.

If you're stationed in the Naples area, residing off-base, and paid your security deposit in cash, it will be returned to you electronically and you will pay it back to your landlord electronically. The housing office will contact you to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.

This higher headquarter directed security deposit policy change aligns NSA Naples with all other DoD bases across the world and will enable our personnel to experience the convenience of electronic payments.

Electronic payment removes a layer of bureaucracy allowing tenants to receive their security deposit directly from the landlord instead of going through NSA Naples housing office. Quick and easy.

Furthermore, electronic payment is more convenient than taking a trip to the ATM to get cash and more secure than carrying cash around. Going electronic will also reduce and/or eliminate the potential for cash drain at installation ATMs.

In the modern era, electronic payments are the preferred method of monetary transactions for every other overseas station and keeps an electronic transaction history, vice dependence on paper payment receipts.

**This change ONLY affects tenant personnel residing off-base that have executed private lease agreements through the NSA Naples Housing Service Center (HSC) prior to 10 June 2024.**

**Personnel PCSing out of Italy by December 2025 will be grandfathered in and not be affected by this new policy.**

**The housing office will contact all concerned to sign two acknowledgement forms and a lease amendment to complete the process and go electronic.**

## Your Questions Answered

**What if the landlord refuses to return the deposit?**

A landlord who fails to return the deposit to a tenant would be subject to immediate removal from the NSA Naples housing program. It is an extremely rare occurrence to see a landlord who fails to return a security deposit back to tenant here in Naples. Per the lease agreement, and in rare instances where security deposit dispute between tenant and landlord cannot be resolved through informal meeting with the housing office, either party will have all remedies available to them under the law. As a DoD personnel, if you are not getting the legal help you need, you should always engage your chain of command to escalate the issue through appropriate channels.

**Will the security deposit be returned in Euros?**

Deposits are electronically returned in Euros if you provide account information that includes an IBAN number linked to a Euro bank account. If a tenant has a U.S. bank account, they will receive the money in dollars. Most personnel that own a community bank account have reported that it makes security deposit, rent, and bill payments to Italian landlords much easier. Other personnel are known to use the wire transfer service known as Wise. As for the exchange rate, this fluctuates on a daily basis and each tenant may realize a positive or negative difference between transactions depending on when the transaction occurs.


**Is it my responsibility to inform my landlord about this policy change?**

No. The housing service center will explain the policy change to each landlord.

## Radon Awareness: How Radon Enters Homes

*On-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are in compliance with the Navy Radon Management Program.*

### HOW RADON GETS INTO YOUR HOME

Radon is a naturally occurring, radioactive gas that is odorless, colorless, and tasteless. Radon gas is released from rocks and soil and can move to air, groundwater, and surface water. It is normally found at very low levels in outdoor air and can be found in water used for cooking and drinking.

Radon can build up in the air in any home or building, whether it has a basement, is sealed or drafty, or is new or old. Take action this month to reduce the risks of radon in your home by opening windows and using fans to circulate air. This increases airflow and mitigates the buildup of radon.

In compliance with the Navy Radon Assessment and Mitigation Program (NAVRAMP), NSA Naples on-base residential and non-residential units, including off-base Government leased units are either tested or mitigated or currently being tested.

Personnel that live off-base have entered into a private contract with their landlord, therefore limiting the scope with which the U.S. government may intervene or have control over said contract. However, DoD personnel living off-base can work with their landlord to test for and mitigate radon, if desired, at their own expense.

The lessee may work with the lessor to address any identified issues, as outlined in Section 19 of the NSA Naples housing lease.

While NSA Naples has a known overall potential for elevated radon levels, classifying the installation as a Radon Potential Category (RPC) 1 according to the NAVRAMP, the installation is complying with NAVRAMP testing and mitigation policies at government owned/controlled units.

RPC1 is simply the level assigned when even one unit or building is found on the installation with a radon level over the minimum threshold of 4.0 picocuries per liter (pCi/L).

## Demolition of B443 at Capodichino: What You Need to Know

The demolition of Building B443 began May 2025. B443 is the former barracks; the long structure located behind the Mobile Bar. This demo project will necessitate some changes that all tenants should be aware of and plan for accordingly.

### Mobile Bar

To ensure continued service during the B443 demolition, the Mobile Bar is temporarily relocated to a new spot near B447. For reference, B447 is located opposite the C4I entrance area. Don't worry, the Mobile Bar will remain open until the new location is ready!

### BBQ Pit is In-Service

The BBQ pit near Building B447 is in-service and no further impacts to this location are anticipated.

### Pedestrian Traffic Detour

For your safety during the B443 demolition project, a pedestrian detour will remain in place until project completion, anticipated summer 2026. Please follow posted detour signs and exercise caution while navigating the area.

## In-Focus: Air Quality in Naples

### Checking Air Quality Outdoor

The website hyperlink below provides real-time data on Naples' Air Quality Index (AQI) to help residents understand pollution levels and potential health implications. AQI is a measure of air pollution on a scale where higher numbers indicate poorer air quality. The AQI levels are divided into categories: Good (0-50), Moderate (51-100), Poor (101-200), Unhealthy (201-300), Severe (301-400), and Hazardous (401-500).

The dashboard displays AQI readings across various locations in Naples, showing areas with higher pollution. Additional insights like health recommendations (e.g., wearing masks, using air purifiers) and historical AQI trends are also included, helping residents make informed decisions about outdoor activities. This is not an endorsement of this website, but an effort to keep our community here in Naples informed on the environmental conditions where we live.

### Air Quality in Naples – Sources

Vehicle emissions are among the primary contributors to Naples' air pollution. The city's dense traffic and reliance on cars and motorbikes result in high levels of NO<sub>2</sub> and other harmful pollutants that affect air quality, especially during peak travel times.

In addition, less frequent, natural events, like wildfires in Naples, contribute to air pollution and environmental damage.

Addressing these issues requires coordinated efforts between local authorities, industries, and the community to reduce pollution and to mitigate its long-term environmental impacts. It is also important to note the U.S. Naval Hospital Naples does not test or monitor the outdoor air quality across the region.

### What Is Naples Public Health Evaluation (NPHE)?

The Naples Public Health Evaluation is a comprehensive study of the health risks associated with potential exposure to chemicals in the environment resulting from the area's waste disposal practices. The Campania region of Italy has experienced numerous challenges associated with trash collection, open burning of uncollected trash and illegal waste disposal practices. In response to health concerns expressed by U.S. Navy personnel in 2007, the Commander, Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central (CNREURAFCENT) contacted the Navy and Marine Corps Force Health Protection Command (NMCFHPC) to conduct a comprehensive public health evaluation to assess the potential health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Naples area. The NPHE was conducted from January 2008 to June 2011.

### What did the Navy learn from NPHE?

Through the Public Health Evaluation, the Navy has been able to identify and address public health risks for U.S. personnel living in the Campania region. The Navy established new health-protective policies and took immediate action to protect the health of U.S. personnel and their families. **Many of these health-protective policies remain in place, as enduring processes, to ensure continued health protection beyond the life of the study.**

The U.S. Navy conducted a Public Health Evaluation from 2008-2011 to assess potential health risks for Navy personnel and their families while living in Naples, Italy. In line with our commitment to continually share important health information, we are providing the following information related to the Public Health Evaluation. #### Introduction

ARPAC, or Agenzia Regionale per la Protezione Ambientale della Campania, is the environmental protection agency for the Campania region. The U.S. Navy worked with ARPAC throughout the Naples Public Health Evaluation (Naples PHE) to share information and testing results. This fact sheet provides information on how to navigate ARPAC's website to access the ambient air quality data the Italian agency has collected.



# Happy Holidays: Travel, Enjoy, but Safely

From late November to mid-January, when families gather, parties are scheduled and travel spikes, safety should be top of mind. Following this tried-and-true advice will ensure your family remains safe and injury-free throughout the season.

## Decorate Safely

Decorating is one of the best ways to get in a holiday mood, but emergency departments see thousands of injuries involving holiday decorating every season. When decorating follow these tips from the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission:

- Keep potentially poisonous plants like mistletoe, holly berries, Jerusalem cherry and amaryllis away from children.
- If using an artificial tree, check that it is labeled "fire resistant"
- If using a live tree, cut off about 2 inches of the trunk to expose fresh wood for better water absorption, remember to water it, and remove it from your home when it is dry.
- Place your tree at least 3 feet away from fireplaces, radiators and other heat sources, making certain not to block doorways.
- Avoid placing breakable ornaments or ones with small, detachable parts on lower tree branches where small children can reach.
- Only use indoor lights indoors and outdoor lights outdoors, and choose the right ladder for the task when hanging lights.
- Replace light sets that have broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections.
- Follow the package directions on the number of light sets that can be plugged into one socket.
- Never nail, tack or stress wiring when hanging lights, and keep plugs off the ground away from puddles and snow.
- Turn off all lights and decorations when you go to bed or leave the house.

## Turkey Fryers

Be alert to the dangers if you're thinking of celebrating the holidays by frying a turkey. The Consumer Product Safety Commission reports there have been hundreds turkey-fryer related fires, burns or other injuries, and millions of dollars in property loss from these incidents.

The Naples Security Office discourages the use of turkey fryers at home and urges those who prefer fried turkey to seek out professional establishments or consider using an oil-less turkey fryer. If you must fry your own turkey, follow all U.S. Fire Administration turkey fryer guideline.

## Food Poisoning Is "No Joke"

Keep your holidays happy by handling food safely. The foodsafety.gov website from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services provides some valuable holiday food safety tips:

- Wash your hands frequently when handling food.
- Keep raw meat away from fresh produce.
- Use separate cutting boards, plates and utensils for uncooked and cooked meats to avoid cross-contamination.
- Use a food thermometer to make sure meat is cooked to a safe temperature.
- Refrigerate hot or cold leftover food within two hours of being served.
- When storing turkey, cut the leftovers in small pieces so they will chill quickly.
- Thanksgiving leftovers are safe for three to four days when properly refrigerated.

## Watch Out for Fire-Starters!

Candles and Fireplaces Use of candles and fireplaces, combined with an increase in the amount of combustible, seasonal decorations in many homes during the holidays, means more risk for fire. The National Fire Protection Association reports on average candles cause 46% of fires annually in December.

- Place candles where they cannot be knocked down or blown over, and out of reach of children.
- Keep matches and lighters up high and out of reach of children in a locked cabinet.
- Use flameless rather than lighted candles near flammable objects.
- Don't burn trees, wreaths or wrapping paper in the fireplace.
- Use a screen on the fireplace at all times when a fire is burning.
- Never leave candles or fireplaces burning unattended or when you are asleep.
- Check and clean the chimney and fireplace area at least once a year.

## Traveling for the Holidays? Be Prepared!

If you're traveling this year, be sure your vehicle is in good running condition, get plenty of rest and be prepared for any emergency.

Traveling by car during the holidays has the highest fatality rate of any major form of transportation based on fatalities per passenger mile. Hundreds of people die every year in crashes on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, according to Injury Facts. Alcohol impairment is involved in about a third of these fatalities.

## It's Better to Give Safely

Gifts and toys should inspire joy, not cause injuries. Thousands of children are seriously injured in toy-related incidents every year. Avoid safety hazards while gifting with these tips from the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission:

- Toys are age-rated for safety, not for children's intellect and physical ability, so be sure to choose toys in the correct age range.
- Choose toys for children under 3 that do not have small parts which could be choking hazards.
- For children under 10, avoid toys that must be plugged into an electrical outlet.
- Be cautious about toys that have button batteries or magnets, which can be harmful or fatal if swallowed.
- When giving scooters and other riding toys, give the gift of appropriate safety gear, too; helmets should be worn at all times and they should be sized to fit.



## Renters Insurance

For your protection, it is highly recommended that you obtain private personal property insurance, especially for high-valued items, even if you live in government quarters. Depending on the policy, some may even cover your household goods while they are in transit. Additionally, some may cover spoiled food during loss of power. Having the coverage can provide peace of mind and financial security, safeguarding your belongings.

## Holiday Decorations

For Christmas Trees, put live trees in a safe area of the room, away from any source of heat. Keep the tree in a container of water with sand, or moist earth. Live trees should be watered daily. Do not place trees near an entrance/exit, doors, or stairwells. Decorations must be removed by 10 January. Trees should be removed soon after the holidays. Use only approved electrical not worn or frayed lighting. Dispose of live trees at trash pads.





#### Tips for Preventing Mold in Your Home

- Ventilation: Keep windows open when weather permits to allow fresh air circulation. Use exhaust fans in kitchens and bathrooms.
- Moisture Control: Please use the issued dehumidifiers.
- Air Vents: Dust and lightly clean vents regularly to maintain airflow and reduce buildup.
- Humidity Levels: If possible, keep indoor humidity below 60%. Dehumidifiers can help in damp areas.
- Cleaning Practices: Regularly clean surfaces with mild household cleaners, especially in kitchens and bathrooms.
- Appliances: Ensure washing machines and dishwashers are properly vented and maintained to prevent leaks.

Christmas in Campania doesn't just mean staying with families indoors. It means discovering a different kind of beauty — quieter streets, glowing lights, mountain air, and small towns dressed for the season. While summer here is loud and sunlit, December belongs to those who know how to slow down.

Locals trade beach walks for evening strolls under fairy lights, steaming cups of chocolate in hand. In Caserta, Via Mazzini shines softly, while the royal palace becomes a silent backdrop to the city's winter rhythm. Drive a little further, and you'll find yourself in Limatola, where the medieval castle turns into one of the most charming Christmas villages in Italy — part market, part fairytale, filled with music and handmade crafts.

Head inland toward the Matese mountains, and winter changes mood again. The air is sharper, the streets quieter, and the smell of fireplaces lingers as you cross the tiny villages of Guardiaregia, Cusano Mutri, or Letino. Because in the South, winter isn't a pause — it's another way to fall in love with the place.

## Where does the Commissary get its meat products?

Shoppers are amazed to learn that the USDA-approved Natural and Choice beef we sell in the commissaries in Europe and the Middle East are shipped here from the U.S. Even more surprising, is that the retail cuts of beef are fresh, never frozen. This is accomplished through the use of vacuum packaging.

## What are the advantages of vacuum packaging?

- ▶ Because oxygen is removed, the shelf life of vacuum-packaged red meat increases from a matter of days to at least two weeks.
- ▶ Vacuum packaging allows natural enzymes to act as a natural tenderizer and enhances quality/palatability of beef.
- ▶ Without the vacuum technology, most locations would have only frozen meat products.

Beef gets its red color from exposure to oxygen. In our vacuum packing process, we remove over 99% of the oxygen from the package. The lack of oxygen turns the meat a darker color but the meat will return back to the usual red-color once the package is opened and is, once again, exposed to oxygen.

The vacuum package does not allow for any air in or out. This can cause naturally occurring lactic acid to build up inside the package. Shortly after opening the package, the initial off-odor will dissipate.

This process does not affect the quality of the meat or taste and acts as a natural meat tenderizer.

The Central Meat Processing Plant's state-of-the-art facility features highly efficient meat processing and vacuum machines, metal detectors and X-ray machines, a flash freezer, and high-tech cleaning systems. USDA Beef is cut, ground, packaged, vacuum sealed, and shipped from Kaiserslautern Cold Storage to our overseas locations. Fresh pork is sourced locally from German locations and processed under the same strict guidelines. Commissaries receive shipments an average of every two to three days, depending on the size and sales volume of the location.

FOR YOUR SINGLE-SERVING OR PARTY-PLANNING MENUS



Just as you can go to a stateside commissary and place a special order for pork or beef, you can do the same here in Europe. You can simply request a special order from the commissary at the meat department or front-end department by filling out a special-order form if you are looking for a large quantity or a special cut.

Special order lead times vary depending on the request but a majority can be filled within days. Large quantity requests may take up to eight weeks. Whole pigs require a 10-day lead time. Check with your commissary for details.






