
Open house topics include:

- Tank Closure Plan Supplement 4, which was released earlier this summer and focuses on the overall closure strategy, pipeline removal and tank verification plan updates, physical tank modifications, historical equipment connections to the Red Hill underground storage tank system, and post-closure monitoring
- Navy-Aiea Halawa Shaft Reactivation
- Pipeline Removal Process
- Environmental Monitoring and Remediation

Attendees can learn about key activities including pigging (pipe cleaning) operations through facility pipelines, the Navy's plan to reactivate the Navy Aiea-Halawa Shaft, and other operational milestones.
