The mission of Navy Closure Task Force-Red Hill (NCTF-RH) is to execute the permanent decommissioning of the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility (RHBFSF) safely and expeditiously, and continue long-term environmental remediation in coordination with State and Federal regulators in order to protect public health and the environment.

FACT CHECK: There is no evidence of groundwater contaminant migration from Red Hill. The Navy continues to drill new groundwater monitoring wells and is completing another year of highly frequent groundwater monitoring at and around the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility and have not detected any fuel-related contaminants away from Red Hill.

CNO Visits Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility

On Nov. 21, Chief of Naval Operations Adm. Daryl Caudle, visited the Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility to discuss the status of degassing and closure operations and receive an update on ongoing environmental monitoring operations and efforts to expand the granular activated carbon filtration systems.

Earlier that day in a media interview, Caudle emphasized a focus on the people and the land stating, "Hawaii is so important to the United States Navy, but so is the culture and tradition and respecting the people here, and I think that's founded on transparency and trust."



JBPHH Drinking Water System Routine Flushing Not Related to Red Hill

In October, the Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam Public Works/Utilities team began routine water flushing maintenance on the drinking water system in line with industry standard. The process will continue at various locations throughout the system until Fall 2026.

Flushing of water lines is essential to remove sediments that may have built up over time. During this time, water quality is still maintained and there is no degradation. This is part of an ongoing effort to provide quality water and to ensure the integrity of the water system.
